NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Highlights of the second weekend of ACC action included No. 20 NC State's three-game series sweep at No. 9 Clemson ... Wolfpack shortstop Will Wilson hit .500 versus the Tigers with a pair of home runs in Sunday's 5-4 win in the finale, including a tie-breaking solo shot for what proved to be the game-winner in the top of the eighth ... Sophomore Michael Bienlien helped key a strong effort by NC State's pitching staff by working five shutout innings in the Wolfpack's 4-0 victory in Friday night's opener ... NC State earned its first-ever sweep in Clemson and its first sweep against the Tigers since 1997 in Raleigh ... The Wolfpack outscored Clemson, 15-5, during the series and only allowed three extra-base hits (all in Sunday's third game).

NC State was the only visiting team to post an ACC series win over the weekend ... North Carolina registered the only other series sweep, taking three from Pitt in Chapel Hill to tie Duke for first place in the early Coastal Division standings ... Other series winners were Wake Forest versus No. 11 Louisville, Duke versus Miami, No. 7 Florida State versus Notre Dame, Georgia Tech versus Virginia Tech, and No. 21 Virginia versus Boston College.

North Carolina outscored the Panthers 32-5 to record its first home-opening ACC series sweep since 2011. After dropping its first two ACC games of the season, the Tar Heels have won four straight league contests ... Senior second baseman Zack Gahagan hit .545 in the three games versus Pitt with a home run and six RBI, five of which came in the 15-3 win in the series opener ... Sophomore pitcher Austin Bergner worked eight scoreless innings in Saturday's 4-0 shutout of the Panthers, allowing three hits and two walks while striking out a career-high 12 opposing batters.

Wake Forest clinched a series win over a top-15 ACC foe for the second-straight weekend with its 6-4 win over the Cardinals on Sunday ... The Demon Deacons, who had taken two of three from then-No. 3 Florida State one week earlier, posted their 10th ACC series win in their last 12 weekends dating back to 2017 ... Johnny Aiello blasted a first-inning grand slam and Colin Peluse pitched into the eighth inning to lead Sunday's win ... The series win was Wake Forest's first in four tries against Louisville. Head coach Tom Walter now has series wins over every ACC foe during his tenure.

Virginia scored three runs in the bottom of the 10th inning on Sunday for its series-clinching 10-9 win over Boston College ... Charlie Cody's sacrifice fly plated the winning run for the Cavaliers ... Cody has been at the plate for two of the four walk-off victories for Virginia this season ... The game was the third extra inning contest of the season for Virginia and took four hours and 53 minutes to complete, tied for the fourth longest in program history ... The game-winning rally in the 10th was the second deficit Virginia had to overcome in the contest ... Boston College built a 6-3 lead by scoring six-straight runs between fourth and sixth innings.

Boston College will open its new field on Tuesday afternoon as the Eagles host Northeastern in the first ever game at Brighton Baseball Field.

Now with 1,960 career wins, Florida State's Mike Martin needs just 16 more to become the winningest coach in college baseball history. He currently only trails the late Augie Garrido (1,975 wins) ... The Seminoles host No. 21 UCF for a two-game midweek series Tuesday and Wednesday.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Wilson turned in a stellar week at the plate to lead No. 20 NC State to a perfect 5-0 week, highlighted by the program's first-ever three-game sweep at No. 9 Clemson. In the five games, he hit .545 with 12 hits, seven runs and five runs driven in, and had five extra-base hits with a slugging percentage of .955 and an on-base percentage of .600. He recorded more than one hit in each game of the week and extended a streak of reaching base safely to 36 consecutive games.

The sophomore shortstop from Kings Mountain, North Carolina, finished the series against the Tigers with a .500 batting average and tallied a series-high six hits. On Sunday, Wilson recorded his first career multi-home run game, giving NC State a 1-0 lead with a solo shot in the first and a go-ahead homer in the eighth that proved the difference in a 5-4 Wolfpack win.

Roberts recorded a career-high 13 strikeouts in 8.1 innings pitched – the longest outing of his career – in Wake Forest's 2-1 win over No. 11 Louisville on Friday. The junior from Midlothian, Virginia, has struck out 10-or-more batters in four straight outings after starting the year with a nine-strikeout effort. He leads the ACC in strikeouts and innings pitched after serving as a reliever his first two seasons.
