NOTING ACC BASEBALL

The second weekend of conference play again features seven ACC series ... No. 9 Clemson, the only team to emerge 3-0 in ACC play following opening weekend, welcomes high-scoring and No. 20-ranked NC State ... Other three-game series include Boston College at No. 21 Virginia, Miami at No. 23 Duke, Notre Dame at No. 7 Florida State, Virginia Tech at Georgia Tech, Pitt at North Carolina, and No. 11 Louisville at Wake Forest. Seven ACC teams are ranked this week in a national poll, including four that hold spots in the top 10 in one.

NC State's Brett Kinneman was named National Player of the Month for February, announced by the NCBWA ... Kinneman, a native of York, Pa., hit .487 (19-for-39) over nine games in February, slugging seven homers and driving in 23 runs. He scored 11 runs, had a double and a pair of triples, stealing a pair of bases and sporting a .533 on-base percentage. On the year, Kinneman has hit .408 in 18 games, with 10 homers and 31 RBI, sporting a .934 slugging and a .489 on-base percentage ... The junior outfielder was named ACC Baseball Player of the Week for two of the first three weeks of the season.

Kinneman has continued to rank among the ACC leaders heading into the weekend, ranking third among league hitters with a .408 batting average and leading in both home runs and RBI ... Boston College's Chris Galland, who has struck out only twice this season in 44 plate appearances, leads all ACC hitters with a .514 average and is tied for the lead in stolen bases with 10.

Miami snapped the nation's longest winning streak with a 4-3 win over No. 21 UCF Wednesday night in Orlando ... Freshman Daniel Federman (1-1) tossed five strong innings for the Hurricanes, who ended a stretch of 13 straight victories by the Knights ... Miami received a sparkling effort from its bullpen, which allowed no runs over the game's final three innings to seal the win.

Clemson (16-1) will carry the conference's longest current winning streak of eight game into its series against NC State (15-3) ... Junior Grayson Byrd hit his second, third and fourth career home runs in The Tigers' 5-0 win over Charleston Southern at Doug Kingsmore Stadium on Tuesday night ... Byrd became the 14th player in school history and first since 2010 (John Hinson vs. USC Upstate on April 21) to hit three home runs in a game.

After taking two of three from defending ACC champion Florida State in its league-opening series, Wake Forest will try to make some more noise when it welcomes defending Atlantic Division champion Louisville this weekend ... The Demon Deacons have won nine of their past 11 conference series dating back to 2017 ... Wake Forest remains a youthful squad in 2018, having started six different freshmen position players, while five rookies have seen time on the mound ... Among the position players, 68 starts have been made by freshmen, compared to 38 for sophomores, 47 for juniors and none by seniors.

Duke's will carry a three game winning streak into its series with Miami after sweeping a midweek two-game set from Yale ... The Blue Devils, who have won 14 of their first 17 games, entered the week ranked in six national polls: Baseball America (No. 20), College Baseball News (No. 20), Collegiate Baseball (No. 26), D1Baseball (No. 21), Perfect Game (No. 20) and USA Today Coaches Poll (No. 23).

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Beer led Clemson to a 5-0 record on the week, including a three-game sweep of Georgia Tech, by hitting a home run in each of the three wins over the Yellow Jackets. The junior first baseman and outfielder from Suwanee, Georgia, was 4-for-11 with three homers, four RBI, five runs and a .500 on-base percentage in the series and totaled at least one run and one hit in each of the five games during the week.

Wyatt was 7-for-12 at the plate with a home run, three doubles, one triple and eight RBI as the No. 10 Cardinals went 3-1 last week with a series win over No. 21 North Carolina. Wyatt added seven walks and scored five runs while registering a 1.250 slugging percentage and .737 on-base percentage in the four games. After opening the week with four hits and five RBI in a win over Morehead State, the sophomore first baseman from Louisville, Kentucky, was 2-for-3 with a pivotal three-run double and scored the game-winning run in Louisville's 5-4 series-opening victory against the Tar Heels.

McKendry won the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday to help Miami clinch its opening conference series with visiting Notre Dame. He struck out a career-high 12 batters, marking his second straight double-digit strikeout performance and bringing his team-leading total to 38 across four starts. The sophomore righthander from Pembroke Pines, Florida, allowed just two hits in earning his third straight win.
