SEMINOLES BEGIN PLAY IN 2018 ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS AT GRANDOVER RESORT SEMINOLES LINEUP FOR ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS INCLUDES FIVE OF THE TOP 10 GOLFERS IN SCHOOL HISTORY ACC LINEUP INCLUDES KIM AND MORGANE METTRAUX, JONES, DOHERTY AND SUMNER

FLORIDA STATE BEGINS POSTSEASON PLAY AT ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS

No. 29 Florida State begins postseason play for the 2018 season as it travels to play in the ACC Championships at the Grandover Resort in Greensboro, April 21-23, 2018. It marks the 27th consecutive year the Seminoles will participate in the event. Florida State arrives at the event with the third lowest per round stroke average in the ACC (293.6). The Seminoles have earned five top-5 team finishes and finished in a season-best second place at the Ocean Course Invitational at Kiawah Island during the fall season. Sophomore Amanda Doherty enters the 2018 ACC Championships with the lowest stroke average among her Seminole teammates as she enters the event with a career-low 71.92 stroke average.

FLORIDA STATE PLAYING FOR FIRST TEAM ACC CHAMPIONSHIP

Florida State, which has earned six top-5 team finishes in its last eight appearances in the ACC Women's Golf Championship, finished in second place in the 2017 ACC Championship. Florida State enters the 2018 ACC Championships looking to win the first ACC women's golf championship in school history. The Seminoles have finished as high as second (1992, 1995, 1999 and 2017) and have earned four third place finishes since joining the nation's top conference for women's golf in 1992.

FLORIDA STATE PLAYS HOST TO 2018 NCAA TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL MAY 7-9

Florida State will play host to one of four NCAA Regional Championships as part of the NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championship May 7-9, 2018 at the Don Veller Seminole Golf Club in Tallahassee. The participating teams will be announced at 5:30 p.m. on April 29 live on the Golf Channel. It will mark the second time the Seminole women have hosted a regional; they also hosted the 2014 NCAA Regional at Southwood.

SEMINOLES' ACC LINEUP AND FSU CAREER RANK

Florida State's ACC Championship lineup – seniors Kim Metraux, Morgane Metraux and Kayla Jones, sophomore Amanda Doherty and freshman Kathleen Sumner – consists of five of the top 10 golfers (statistically) in school history. Matilda Castren (2014-17), who played in four ACC Championships during her career at Florida State, is the Seminoles' all-time leader with a 72.52 stroke average in 126 career rounds.

SEMINOLES BEST ROUND OF YEAR IS AMONG FSU'S TOP 10

Florida State's best round of the year – a 10 under par score of 278 in the first round of the Evans Derby Experience – is tied for the sixth best single round team score in school history. It also marked the first time in school history each of the Seminoles five golfers (Morgane Metraux, 68; Kim Metraux, 69; Kayla Jones, 70, Amanda Doherty, 71, Kathleen Sumner, 71) have finished below par in a given round in school history. The Seminoles' 10 under par score marked the sixth time in school history they had finished in double figures under par.

AMANDA DOHERTY'S RANKINGS

Sophomore Amanda Doherty enters the 2018 ACC Championship ranked as one of the top golfers in school history. Her career scoring average of 73.28 (4,397 strokes in 60 rounds during 21 tournaments) is ranked as the third lowest career scoring average in school history. Doherty's career-low 71.92 stroke average as a sophomore (1,798 strokes in 25 rounds during nine tournaments) is the second best single season career average in school history. The all-time school career record at Florida State is held by Matilda Castren (72.52, 2014-17) as is the all-time single season record (71.83 in 2014).

SEMINOLES' DOHERTY PLAYING BEST GOLF...

...Amanda Doherty enters the 2018 ACC Championships at a cumulative total of 2 strokes under par in five events during the spring season;

...Amanda Doherty has finished three of her five events this spring under par (minus 8 at the Florida State Match-Up, minus 3 at the Clemson Invitational and minus 1 at the Brickyard Collegiate);

...Amanda Doherty is 4 strokes under par in her last two events entering the 2018 ACC Championships. She finished the Clemson Invitational (minus 3) and the Brickyard Collegiate (minus 1) both under par;

...Amanda Doherty has finished five of her nine events as a sophomore below par and is a cumulative total of ONLY two strokes over par for the fall 2017 and spring 2018 seasons.

DOHERTY HAS CUT MORE THAN TWO STROKES FROM HER AVERAGE

Sophomore Amanda Doherty enters the 2018 ACC Championship with a career-low and team-best 71.92 stroke average. She has cut 2.34 strokes per round off of her scoring average as a sophomore when compared to her freshman season.

METRAUX ENTERS ACC TOURNAMENT WITH TOP TWO ALL-TIME SCORES

Senior Morgane Metraux enters the 2018 ACC Championship with the top two scores for a three round tournament on her resume. Her three round total of 201 at the 2016 Schooner Fall Classic is the best tournament score in school history while her total of 202 in the 2017 Dickson Intercollegiate is the second best three round score in school history.

KIM METRAUX UNDER PAR

Senior Kim Metraux, who will play in her third career ACC Championship this weekend at the Grandover Resort, has finished two of her events this year under par. She finished the Schooner Fall Classic at 1 under par (212, tied for 16th) and finished the Evans Derby Experience at 3 under par (2132, tied for 12th). Metraux has finished eight events under par in her 41-event career.

KIM METREAU'S CONSISTENCY

Senior Kim Metraux has played as one of the most consistent golfers in school history throughout her four-year Florida State career. As a freshman, she averaged 75.57 strokes in 23 rounds. In the three years since her freshman season, she has averaged 73.56 strokes in 33 tournaments (6988 strokes in 95 rounds). Metraux has averaged 73.53 (sophomore season), 73.43 (junior season) and 73.82 (senior season) in each of her last three seasons. She holds three of the top 13 single season scoring averages in school history and is ranked sixth in school history with her 73.95 career average entering the 2018 ACC Championships.

SUMNER'S FRESHMAN SEASON AMONG BEST IN SCHOOL HISTORY

Kathleen Sumner, who has earned two top-10 finishes as a freshman this year (tied for sixth at the Dickson Intercollegiate and tied for seventh at the Brickyard Collegiate) enters her first ACC Championship with a 75.20 stroke average – the seventh best by a freshman in school history. The school record for best average by a freshman is 71.83 by Matilda Castren in 2014. In the Seminoles' lineup this week at Grandover are four players (Amanda Doherty, third; Morgane Metraux, fourth; Kayla Jones, sixth and Kathleen Sumner, seventh) who all ranked in the top 10 for best averages by a freshman in school history.
