NOTING ACC BASEBALL

ACC regular-season conference play hits the halfway mark this weekend with another seven three-game league series Both division leaders are on the road with No. 7 NC State at No. 21 Louisville and No. 12 Duke at Wake Forest ... Other action finds Pitt at Boston College, No. 6 Florida State at Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech at Virginia, No. 9 Clemson at Notre Dame, and North Carolina at Miami ... Duke enters the weekend riding a seven-game winning streak and with wins in 25 of its last 28 games Clemson and UNC have each won five in a row.

Following Friday evening's series opener between Duke and Wake Forest in Winston-Salem, the teams are scheduled to take Saturday off before meeting again on Sunday afternoon and Monday evening ... Monday's 7 p.m. finale will be televised nationally by ESPNU ... The Blue Devils, ranked among the nation's top 15 in four major polls, have scored double-digit runs in each of their last three games, including a combined 24 runs in midweek home wins over Richmond and Campbell.

Virginia Tech will enter its series at rival Virginia with offensive momentum after scoring a season-high 19 runs in Wednesday night's win over visiting Dayton ... JD Mundy delivered a three-run homer in the first inning and finished with a career-high four RBI to key the Hokies ... Nine Virginia Tech players drove in at least one run as the 19-3 win represented the Hokies' highest scoring output since a 24-10 victory at Nevada on Feb. 26, 2017.

Chris Williams, Jordan Greene, Logan Davidson and Grayson Byrd all hit home runs in Clemson's 6-1 victory over visiting No. 24 Coastal Carolina on Tuesday night ... The four homers were the most by Clemson since May 16, 2017, when the Tigers hit four homers the last time Coastal Carolina visited Doug Kingsmore Stadium.

ACC midweek action also included North Carolina's 11-3 win over South Carolina in a neutral site game at Charlotte's BB&T Ballpark ... In its last three games against South Carolina, the Tar Heels now outscored the Gamecocks 46-8 and have scored in double figures in all three wins.

Florida State scored five runs in the first inning of Wednesday night's 6-2 win over Jacksonville, the Seminoles' 13th "big inning" of the season (four or more runs) ... It marked the sixth time FSU has scored five runs in an inning ... FSU's win was head coach Mike Martin's 1,967th of his career. He needs just 9 more to become the winningest coach in college baseball history. He currently only trails the late Augie Garrido (1,975 wins).

Notre Dame's 18 runs versus Chicago State on Tuesday night were its most since scoring 19 in a win over Purdue on February 19, 2011 ... Alex Kerschner finished the game just a home run shy of the cycle, driving in a career-high five runs for the Irish ... Kerschner's three hits equaled a career high and marked his fifth multi-hit game of the season.

Two NC State players – outfielder Brett Kinneman and pitcher Brian Brown – were named to the Perfect Game Midseason All-America team ... Kinneman earned first-team honors, along with Georgia Tech utility player Tristin English ... Brown was named to the second team.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Beer went 8-for-13 (.615) with four homers, 12 RBI, seven runs, a 1.538 slugging percentage, four walks against one strikeout and a .667 on-base percentage to lead Clemson to a perfect 4-0 week. The junior first baseman and outfielder from Suwanee, Georgia, hit a home run in each of the four games, including a three-game sweep of Boston College. On the year, he is batting .284 with 27 runs, three doubles, 10 home runs, 24 RBI, a .441 on-base percentage and a steal in 28 games.

Curry improved to an ACC-best 6-0 on the season with a 6-1 win over Miami on Friday night. The sophomore from Atlanta, Georgia, struck out a career-high 12 batters in 8.0 innings, allowing just one run, one walk, and six singles in his fourth quality start of the season. The win was the first win of the Jackets' sweep of the Canes, their first sweep at home over Miami since 1967. Curry's 12 strikeouts were the most by a Georgia Tech pitcher since Buck Farmer fanned 14 batters in the Opening Day win over Akron on Feb. 15, 2013.
