NOTING ACC BASEBALL

The midway point of the ACC regular season finds NC State holding a one-game lead over Clemson in Atlantic Division ... North Carolina and Duke are tied atop the Coastal Division ... NC State, ranked No. 7 entering last weekend's road series at No. 21 Louisville, took two of three from the Cardinals to hold onto the division lead ... Other weekend series winners included No. 9 Clemson (at Notre Dame), Georgia Tech (versus No. 6 Florida State), North Carolina (at Miami), Pitt (at Boston College) and Virginia versus (Virginia Tech).

NC State earned its first-ever series win against Louisville, as the Cardinals had won the previous three series as conference opponents ... Junior Brett Kinneman drove in four runs in each of the Wolfpack's wins to take over the NCAA lead in RBI with 44 ... Kinneman, who also leads the ACC and ranks among the nation's leaders in home runs with 13, delivered a three-run shot in Sunday's 10-3 win ... His bases-clearing double on Saturday proved the difference in NC State's 9-6 victory.

North Carolina's Michael Busch has driven in 42 runs to sit just behind Kinneman at the No. 2 spot on both the national and conference RBI chart ... Georgia Tech's Tristin English is among a group of eight players nationally who have driven in 40 runs.

Georgia Tech matched its season high for runs scored Sunday afternoon, as the Yellow Jackets rolled past No. 6 FSU, 16-3 to clinch the series win at Russ Chandler Stadium ... It was the second-straight ACC series win for the Jackets, who swept Miami at home last weekend ... Georgia Tech sophomore shortstop Austin Wilhite hit .533 in four game last week against ranked opponents and delivered an inside-the-park home run in Sunday's win ... Wilhite's inside-the-park home run was the first for the Jackets since Coleman Poje raced around the bases versus Savannah State on May 10, 2016, just one day after Matt Gonzalez did it versus Miami on May 9.

Pitching was also a big part of the equation in Georgia Tech's series win ... Sophomore Connor Thomas went the distance in a 2-1 win over the Seminoles on Saturday night ... The left-handed hurler allowed just one run on six hits and one walk, while striking out nine hitters ... Thomas became just the second Yellow Jacket starter to throw a complete game since 2013.

North Carolina took a series at Miami for the first time since May of 2008 ... Reliever Cooper Criswell earned the win Saturday night's series-clinching 9-6 victory with 5.2 innings of three-hit relief in which he struck out 13 batters (of a possible 17 outs) and did not issue a walk while allowing one run.

Other standout pitching performances over the weekend included Virginia senior Derek Casey's three-hitter in a complete-game, 9-0 shutout over Virginia Tech on Friday ... Casey faced just 30 batters and allowed only one Virginia Tech runner to reached second base ... The complete game shutout was the first in ACC play this season ... Casey did not issue a walk and upped his season strikeout total to 70, second highest in the ACC... The quality start was his fourth of the season and his second in ACC play.

Wake Forest junior third baseman Johnny Aiello delivered a seven-RBI performance in Friday night's 10-2 win over No. 10 Duke ... The effort included his second grand slam home run of the season ... Aiello's seven RBIs are a career high and the most by a Demon Deacon this season.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Wilhite led the Jackets offensively for the week, hitting a team-best .533 (8-for-15). Wilhite had one home run, a double, five RBI and three runs scored with a .800 slugging percentage and .562 on-base percentage as Georgia Tech picked up the series win over No. 6 Florida State. After going 1-for-3 with a walk at No. 17 Georgia on Tuesday night, the sophomore shortstop from Buford, Georgia, went 2-for-4 on Friday night, 2-for-4 with a run scored in Saturday's win over FSU, before posting a career-high five RBI with an inside-the-park home run, a double, and two runs score in the Jackets' 16-3 victory over the Seminoles on Sunday.

Thomas went the distance in a complete game win over No. 6 Florida State on Saturday. The sophomore left-hander from Omega, Georgia, allowed just one run on six hits and one walk, while striking out nine batters. He held the Seminoles to a .194 average and threw a career-high 116 pitches in the win. The outing was the longest of his career, and his nine strikeouts tied for the second most in his career behind his 10 last Saturday in a win over Miami. Thomas became just the second Yellow Jacket starter to throw a complete game since 2013, joining current teammate Jake Lee, who went the distance in a 5-3 win at Duke last year.

Casey faced just 30 batters in a three-hit, complete game shutout on Friday in a 9-0 win over rival Virginia Tech. In the win, Casey allowed only one Hokie runner to reach second base to compile the first complete game shutout in ACC play this season. The senior from Mechanicsville, Virginia, did not issue a walk and tallied seven strikeouts to increase his season total to 70, the second most in the conference. The quality start was his fourth of the season and second in ACC play.
