NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Six ACC teams are ranked this week in at least one national ranking ... NC State is ranked as high as No. 2 in three different polls, while Duke is a unanimous top 10 team ranked as high as No. 3, and North Carolina is as high as No. 8. Clemson, Florida State, and Louisville also hold top 20 rankings.

UNC and NC State are slated to meet in a non-conference game at Durham Bulls Athletic Park – which will be the site of the 2018 ACC Baseball Championship on May 22-27 – this Tuesday night in a nationally televised contest (6:30 p.m., ESPN) ... The Wolfpack will play host to the Tar Heels in what is shaping up as a key ACC series April 27-29. Other key midweek games include No. 11 East Carolina at No. 8 Duke, Louisville versus No. 9 Kentucky, No. 15 Clemson at No. 19 Georgia, and No. 10 Indiana at Notre Dame.

Duke not only earned its first series victory over Florida State in Tallahassee since 1994 but also reached 30 wins for the fifth straight year, joining No. 1 Florida as the first two teams in Division I to reach that mark this season ... Junior outfielder Jimmy Herron, who hit .438 in four games last week, hit a key solo home run in Saturday night's 6-5 win over the Seminoles and also delivered the 50th double of his career ... Herron is the first-ever Blue Devil to post 50 career doubles and 50 career stolen bases.

NC State posted its ninth consecutive ACC series win and rallied to take two of three from Notre Dame after dropping Friday night's opener by a 12-8 score ... For the fourth consecutive weekend, NC State rallied to win a series after dropping the opener, the first time in program history that a Wolfpack team has accomplished that feat ... The nine-ACC series winning streak dates back to last

season and is the longest active streak in the conference ... The Wolfpack is the only team that has not lost an ACC series this season ... Will Wilson drove in four runs to lead NC State to a 13-5 win over the Irish in the series finale on Saturday evening ... That followed a pitching gem by senior Brian Brown in the first game of Saturday's twin bill ... Brown limited Notre Dame to one earned run while scattering eight hits and striking out eight in a nine-inning, complete-game performance.

Miami rallied back from an eight-run, ninth-inning deficit to claim a 12-11 win over Clemson in 12 innings in last Friday night's series opener ... The Hurricanes completed the program's biggest comeback since former head coach Ron Fraser's squad came back from 10 down in the ninth to beat Tampa in May of 1992, in Fraser's last season ... Ironically, the final score of that game was also 12-11 ... Sophomore hurler Evan McKendry clinched the series on Saturday with a complete-game, six-hitter as Miami posted a 6-1 win.

Wake Forest allowed just one run in its three-game series sweep of Boston College ... It marked the fewest number of runs the Demon Deacons have ever allowed in a three-game ACC set ... It was also Wake Forest's first series road sweep since 2014 ... With 3-0 and 2-0 wins in last Friday night's doubleheader, the Deacons earned shutouts back-to-back games for the first time since 1997 ... Griffin Roberts and Morgan McSweeney combined to throw 14 shutout innings with 22 strikeouts, while Rayne Supple earned saves in both contests.

Pitt has now won three consecutive ACC series for the first time after taking two of three from Georgia Tech ... The Panthers joined the ACC prior to the 2014 season.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Wilson helped lead NC State to a 3-1 record last week, hitting .316 with eight RBI, six runs and three home runs. Defensively, he had nine assists and seven putouts without an error. The sophomore shortstop from Kings Mountain, North Carolina, had his second career multi-homer game in the series finale against Notre Dame to clinch the series, the ninth straight series win in conference play for the Wolfpack. He also homered in Wednesday's game at UNCW, as his three-run blast extended the Wolfpack's lead from 3-1 to 6-1. Wilson now has 10 home runs for the season, which is tied for third in the ACC, and six of them have come against conference opponents, tying for the most by an individual in conference play.

Roberts struck out 11 batters and only allowed one hit and one walk in 8.0 innings in a 3-0 win at Boston College on Friday. The junior from Midlothian, Virginia has struck out at least eight batters in all nine of his starts this year, and has punched out at least 10 batters six times. Roberts leads the ACC and ranks second nationally with 90 strikeouts on the season.
