NOTING ACC BASEBALL

The second half of the ACC baseball regular finds NC State holding a one-game lead over Clemson in Atlantic Division, while Duke and North Carolina are tied for the Coastal Division lead.

In addition to its 11-4 record in ACC play, NC State will carry a 26-6 overall mark into its three-game weekend series against the Fighting Irish. The Wolfpack improved to 8-0 in midweek games with Wednesday night's 8-3 win at UNC Wilmington ... NC State is ranked as high as No. 2 this week in several national polls and leads five ACC teams with a No. 6 ranking in the latest USA Today's Coaches Poll ... Clemson is at No. 8 and Florida State at No. 10, followed by Duke at No. 12 and North Carolina at No. 22.

Duke heads to Florida State for a matchup of top-15 teams and its second consecutive ACC road series ... After Wake Forest handed the Blue Devils a series-clinching loss Monday evening, Duke responded with a 5-0 shutout victory over Davidson in midweek action ... The series loss to Wake Forest was only Duke's second of the season and its first since it traveled to Vanderbilt opening weekend (February 16-18) ... Florida State seeks to rebound from last weekend's series loss to Georgia Tech and a midweek loss to No. 1 Florida ... With 1,968 career victories, Seminoles head coach Mike Martin needs just eight more to become the winningest coach in college baseball history. He currently only trails the late Augie Garrido (1,975 wins).

The National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) released its monthly award winners for March on Tuesday, with Clemson slugger Seth Beer named the National Player of the Month ... A native of Suwanee, Georgia, Beer is coming off a March where he hit .294 (20-for-68) with eight homers, 20 RBI and a .662 slugging percentage ... In 2018, Beer has hit .283 (32-for-113) with five doubles, 10 homers and 25 RBI, owning 28 walks and just 15 strikeouts ... The NCBWA National Player of the Month has been an ACC player both months so far this season, with NC State's Brett Kinneman winning the award for February.

Kinneman and Beer were also among 40 players nationally named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List ... They were joined by Georgia Tech's Joey Bart, NC State's Brian Brown, North Carolina's Michael Busch, Florida State's Drew Mendoza and Wake Forest's Griffin Roberts ... Semifinalists for the award, which goes to the top amateur baseball player in the country, will be announced on May 21 ... On June 6, USA Baseball will announce the finalists, and voting for the winner will begin that same day ... The 41st Golden Spikes Award will be presented on June 28 in Los Angeles.

Conference baseball student-athletes are taking part in the ACC's Spring Sportsmanship Week initiative, which began on Monday and continues through Sunday ... At all ACC home competitions during Spring Sportsmanship Week, every league team will showcase its continued dedication to sportsmanship by participating in a pregame handshake ... In addition to the teams' efforts, the conference and member schools will highlight the initiative to fans through releases, social media platforms and official websites ... Updates on ACC Sportsmanship Week will be posted on theACC.com, on the league's Facebook, Twitter and Instagram accounts, and using #ACCSportsmanship.

ACC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Wilhite led the Jackets offensively for the week, hitting a team-best .533 (8-for-15). Wilhite had one home run, a double, five RBI and three runs scored with a .800 slugging percentage and .562 on-base percentage as Georgia Tech picked up the series win over No. 6 Florida State. After going 1-for-3 with a walk at No. 17 Georgia on Tuesday night, the sophomore shortstop from Buford, Georgia, went 2-for-4 on Friday night, 2-for-4 with a run scored in Saturday's win over FSU, before posting a career-high five RBI with an inside-the-park home run, a double, and two runs score in the Jackets' 16-3 victory over the Seminoles on Sunday.

Thomas went the distance in a complete game win over No. 6 Florida State on Saturday. The sophomore left-hander from Omega, Georgia, allowed just one run on six hits and one walk, while striking out nine batters. He held the Seminoles to a .194 average and threw a career-high 116 pitches in the win. The outing was the longest of his career, and his nine strikeouts tied for the second most in his career behind his 10 last Saturday in a win over Miami. Thomas became just the second Yellow Jacket starter to throw a complete game since 2013, joining current teammate Jake Lee, who went the distance in a 5-3 win at Duke last year.

Casey faced just 30 batters in a three-hit, complete game shutout on Friday in a 9-0 win over rival Virginia Tech. In the win, Casey allowed only one Hokie runner to reach second base to compile the first complete game shutout in ACC play this season. The senior from Mechanicsville, Virginia, did not issue a walk and tallied seven strikeouts to increase his season total to 70, the second most in the conference. The quality start was his fourth of the season and second in ACC play.
