**Quoting Head Coach Amy Bond**

"I would certainly classify the 2017-2018 season a success. We used the fall to access where we were as a team, spent the off season fine tuning, and spent the spring working our way up to the post season.

"We were injury plagued most of the year, but got everyone healthy right before the ACC Championships. We peaked during the post season just as we hoped which gave us a lot of confidence heading into NCAA Regionals and NCAA Finals.

"This was a resilient group who had a season filled with some disappointing finishes, but fought through them to finish 12th at the National Championship. I am proud of their fight and willingness to never give up. The season was a success because they believed in themselves, their teammates, and were determined to be the best team they could be."

**SEMINOLES CONTINUE TO MAKE THEIR MARK ON THE NATIONAL SCENE**

Florida State continued to make its presence known nationally as it enjoyed another sensational year during the 2017-18 fall and spring seasons. Under the direction of eighth-year Head Coach Amy Bond, Florida State finished tied for 12<sup>th</sup> at the NCAA Championship Finals (the second best NCAA finish in school history) marking the first time in school history the Seminoles have earned three straight top-20 national finishes. The Seminoles finished second in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional (tied for the best regional finish in school history), finished second in the ACC Championship (tied for the best ACC Championship finish in school history) and earned seven top-5 team finishes in 11 events. Florida State finished the season ranked No. 19 nationally by GolfWeek and No. 20 nationally by GolfStat. Senior Morgane Metraux earned All-American Honors for the second year from the Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA) while Metraux and sophomore Amanda Doherty earned All-NCAA Tallahassee Regional Honors and All-ACC Honors. Morgane Metraux finished in a school-record best tied for 5<sup>th</sup> place in the NCAA National Championship Finals.

**THIRD-CONSECUTIVE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS FINALS APPEARANCE RESULTS IN TOP-12 NATIONAL FINISH**

Senior Morgane Metraux finished in a tie for fifth place in the individual standings, and the Seminole women's golf team finished in a tie for 12<sup>th</sup> place in the team standings in the 2018 NCAA Division I Women's Golf Championship at the Karsten Creek Golf Club at Oklahoma State University. The Seminoles' finished only seven strokes out of eighth place which would have advanced them into match play in the championship for the first time in school history. The tied 12<sup>th</sup> place finish for Florida State at the NCAA Championship Finals is the second best in school history and is the sixth top-15 finish in school history. Seminole Head Coach Amy Bond, who led the Seminoles into the NCAA Championship Finals for the school-record third consecutive season, became the first coach in school history to lead the Seminoles to three consecutive top-20 national finishes. Florida State finished tied for 12<sup>th</sup> in 2018, 15<sup>th</sup> in 2016 and 20<sup>th</sup> in 2017.

**SEMINOLES FINISH SECOND IN NCAA TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP**

Senior Morgane Metraux and sophomore Amanda Doherty both finished in a tie for fourth place in the individual standings, and the Seminole women's golf team finished in second place in the team standings in the 2018 NCAA Division I Women's Golf Tallahassee Regional Championship at the Don Veller Seminole Golf Club. The Seminoles' second place finish advanced them to the NCAA Championship Finals for the school-record third consecutive season. Florida State enjoyed its best round of the season – a 12-under par 276 -- to move up from a tie for third after two rounds and into second place in the final standings. The Seminoles' played the second best round of the day for the second consecutive round. Additionally, the Seminoles' round of 276 is tied for the fourth lowest single round score in school history. In tying the school record for best team finish in an NCAA Regional Championship (second), the Seminoles placed two players (Morgane Metraux and Amanda Doherty, both tied for fourth) in the top five of the individual standings in an NCAA regional for the first time in school history. The individual scores of 206 by Metraux and Doherty are tied for the sixth best in school history and ranks the best in school history in NCAA regional of finals competition.

**FLORIDA STATE FINISHES IN SECOND PLACE AT THE ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Senior Morgane Metraux finished in a tie for third and sophomore Amanda Doherty finished in a tie for fifth in the individual standings, and the Florida State women's golf team finished in second place in the team standings at the ACC Women's Golf Championships at the Grandover Resort in Greensboro, N.C. The individual finishes for Metraux and Doherty marked the first time in school history the Seminoles had two players finish in the top five of the ACC Championships. Florida State's second place team finish marked the first time in school history the Seminoles finished in the top-two in consecutive seasons after also finishing in second place in 2017.

**METRAUX EARNS ALL-AMERICAN HONORABLE MENTION HONORS FROM THE WGCA**

Senior Morgane Metraux has earned All-American Honorable Mention honors as named by the Women's Golf Coaches Association, marking the second consecutive season she has been named as one of the nation's top golfers. Metraux enjoyed her best season as a Seminole as she carded a career-best 71.69 stroke average – the best single season stroke average in school history. She finished in a tie for third in the individual standings at the ACC Championships, a tie for fourth at the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championships and in a tie for fifth in the NCAA Championship Finals. Metraux's tied for fifth place finish in the NCAA Championship Finals is the best national finish in school history.

**MORGANE METRAUX, DOHERTY EARN GOLF WEEK ALL-AMERICAN HONORS**

Senior Morgane Metraux and sophomore Amanda Doherty, who helped lead the Seminole women's golf team to a 12<sup>th</sup> place finish in the 2018 NCAA Championship Finals, earned All-American Honorable Mention honors from GolfWeek for their outstanding performances during the 2018 season. Metraux (71.69 stroke average) and Doherty (72.09) enjoyed the best seasons of their careers as they helped the Seminoles finish in the top 20 of the NCAA Championships for the school-record third consecutive season.

**MORGANE METRAUX, DOHERTY EARN ALL-REGION HONORS**

With their tied for fourth place finishes in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Golf Championships, senior Morgane Metraux and sophomore Amanda Doherty both earned All-Region honors. Metraux earned the honors for the second time in her illustrious Seminoles career after earning the honor in 2015 when she finished in a tie for 10<sup>th</sup> place at the NCAA San Antonio Regional Championships

**FLORIDA STATE'S FINAL NATIONAL RANKINGS**

Florida State finished the 2017-18 season ranked within the nation's top-20 in both national polls – 19<sup>th</sup> by GolfWeek and 20<sup>th</sup> by GolfStat. Senior Morgane Metraux finished her career ranked as the No. 32 individual in both polls while Amanda Doherty closed her sophomore season ranked No. 46 by GolfWeek and No. 58 by Golfstat.

**FLORIDA STATE RANKED SECOND IN THE ACC IN STROKE AVERAGE**

Florida State finished the 2017-18 season with a 291.8 stroke average in 32 rounds – the second lowest stroke average in the ACC and the second lowest in school history.

**FLORIDA STATE'S TEAM FINISHES**

Florida State earned three runner-up team finishes in 2017-18 (second of 15 at the Ocean Course Invitational; second of 12 at the ACC Championships and second of 18 in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional). The Seminoles were one of only four teams in the ACC with at least three team finishes of second place or better. The list includes Florida State, Duke (seven finishes of second place or better), Louisville (four finishes of second place or better) and Miami (three finishes of second place or better).

**SEMINOLES POST TOP STROKE AVERAGES**

Florida State finished one of the best statistical seasons in program history as it posted the second best team stroke average in school history (291.8) and had three players (Morgane Metraux, 1<sup>st</sup>; Amanda Doherty, 4<sup>th</sup>; and Kim Metraux, 14<sup>th</sup>) finish with stroke averages that ranked among the top 15 in school history for a single season.

**NOTING FLORIDA STATE'S TEAM SCORE IN THE TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL**

Florida State's 25 under par score of 839 in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional ranks as the third best overall score and second best score vs. par in a three round tournament in school history. The Seminoles' near school-record finish in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship marked the fifth time in school history they had finished 20 or more strokes under par in a three round tournament.

**SEMINOLES RANKED SECOND IN ACC WITH LOW ROUND SCORES**

Florida State, which carded a 12 under par round of 276 in the third round of the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship, scored three of the 10 lowest team rounds in the ACC during the 2017-18 fall and spring seasons. The Seminoles recorded four team rounds under par with three coming during the 2018 spring season. Florida State carded three of the lowest 10 rounds and is second only to Duke in that statistical category. Duke carded four of the lowest 10 team rounds in the ACC this season.

**FLORIDA STATE'S BEST ROUND AT THE NCAA TALLAHASSEE REGIONAL**

Florida State finished the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship with a 12 under par round of 276 – tied for the fourth best single round team score in school history. The Seminoles best round in school history (14 under par 270) came in the first round of the Schooner Fall Classic on Sept. 25, 2016.

**PAIR OF SEMINOLES IN THE ACC'S TOP SEVEN FOR STROKE AVERAGE**

Florida State's Morgane Metraux (fourth, 71.69) and Amanda Doherty (seventh, 72.09) both finished the 2017-18 season ranked among the top seven individuals for stroke average in the ACC in 2018. The Seminoles, Duke and Wake Forest had two players each in the top seven of the individual stroke leaders in the ACC.

**DOHERTY AMONG ACC LEADERS FOR TOP-FIVE AND TOP-10 FINISHES**

Sophomore Amanda Doherty finished the season ranked third in the ACC with a career-high four top-five finishes (Florida State Match-Up, 2; Brickyard Collegiate, T2; NCAA Tallahassee Regional, T4 and ACC Championship, T5). The ACC leader for top-five individual finishes was Jennifer Kupcho of Wake Forest with six. Kupcho won the individual NCAA Championship. Doherty finished sixth in the ACC with a career-high five top-10 finishes (Florida State Match-Up, 2; Brickyard Collegiate, T2; NCAA Tallahassee Regional, T4; ACC Championship T5 and in the Ocean Course Invitational, T10).

**AMONG THE SEMINOLES' SCORES IN THE 60'S**

Led by All-ACC selection Amanda Doherty and Morgane Metraux, every member of the Seminoles' lineup in the 2018 NCAA Championship Finals carded at least one round in the 60's in 2018.

**DOHERTY MADE A LIVING IN THE 60'S AS A SOPHOMORE**

Sophomore All-ACC selection Amanda Doherty finished tied for the team lead with six rounds carded in the 60's during the fall 2017 and spring 2018 seasons. She carded two rounds in the 60's during the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championships (69 in the first round and a career-low 66 in the second round) and has carded at least one round in the 60's in four of her 11 events this season. Doherty carded multiple rounds in the 60's in the Florida State Match-Up and the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship.

**AMANDA DOHERTY'S RANKINGS**

Sophomore Amanda Doherty finished the 2018 season ranked as one of the top golfers in school history. Her career scoring average of 73.71 (5,122 strokes in 70 rounds during 24 tournaments) is ranked as the third lowest career scoring average in school history. Doherty's career-low 72.09 stroke

average as a sophomore (2,523 strokes in 35 rounds during 12 tournaments) is the fourth best single season average in school history.

#### NOTING FLORIDA STATE'S AMANDA DOHERTY...

...Amanda Doherty finished five of her eight events this spring at even or under par (minus 8 at the Florida State Match-Up, minus 3 at the Clemson Invitational, minus 1 at the Brickyard Collegiate, even at the ACC Championships and minus 10 at the NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championships);

...Amanda Doherty finished six of her 11 events as a sophomore below par and is a cumulative total of six strokes over par for the fall 2017 and spring 2018 seasons.

#### DOHERTY CUT MORE THAN TWO STROKES FROM HER AVERAGE

Sophomore Amanda Doherty finished the 2017-18 season with a career-low and team-best 72.09 stroke average. She cut 2.17 strokes per round off of her scoring average as a sophomore when compared to her freshman season.

#### METRAUX ENTERS NCAA TOURNAMENT WITH TOP TWO ALL-TIME SCORES

Senior Morgane Metraux finished her four-year career with the top two scores for a three round tournament on her Florida State resume. Her three round total of 201 at the 2016 Schooner Fall Classic is the best tournament score in school history while her total of 202 in the 2017 Dickson Intercollegiate is the second best three round score in school history. Metraux's 206 total and minus 10 strokes under par total in the 2018 NCAA Tallahassee Regional Championship is ranked as the fifth lowest three round individual tournament score in school history.

#### NOTING MORGANE METRAUX'S SCORE AT THE 2017 DICKSON

Morgane Metraux's 202 score at the 2017 Dickson Intercollegiate (14-under par) is the best score vs. par in school history. It is one of nine scores for a three-round tournament that have been recorded at double digits under par.

#### KIM METRAUX UNDER PAR

Senior Kim Metraux, who played in three career NCAA Championship Finals Tournaments, finished two of her 11 events this year under par. She finished the Schooner Fall Classic at 1 under par (212, tied for 16<sup>th</sup>) and finished the Evans Derby Experience at 3 under par (213, tied for 12<sup>th</sup>). Metraux has finished eight events under par in her 44-event career.

#### KIM METRAUX'S CONSISTENCY

Senior Kim Metraux has played as one of the most consistent golfers in school history throughout her four-year Florida State career. As a freshman, she averaged 75.57 strokes in 23 rounds. In the three years since her freshman season, she has averaged 73.53 strokes in 35 tournaments (7,424 strokes in 101 rounds). Metraux averaged 73.53 (sophomore season), 73.43 (junior season) and 73.53 (senior season) in each of her last three seasons. She holds three of the top 15 single season scoring averages in school history and is ranked fifth in school history with her 73.87 career average.

#### SUMNER'S FRESHMAN SEASON AMONG BEST IN SCHOOL HISTORY

Kathleen Sumner, who earned two top-10 finishes as a freshman in 2017-18 (tied for sixth at the Dickson Intercollegiate and tied for seventh at the Brickyard Collegiate) finished her first collegiate season with a 75.74 stroke average – the sixth best by a freshman in school history. The school record for best average by a freshman is 71.83 by Matilda Castren in 2014. In the Seminoles' lineup during the 2017-18 season were four players (Amanda Doherty, third; Morgane Metraux, fourth; Sumner, fifth, and Kayla Jones, seventh) who all ranked in the top 10 for best averages by a freshman in school history.

#### FLERLAGE CLOSES SEMINOLE CAREER

Senior Lexie Flerlage, who was a member of four NCAA Tournament teams during her career as a Seminole, played in three events during her career in the spring of 2017 (one) and the spring of 2018 (two). She played as an individual in the Florida State Match-Up in the spring of 2017 and played in two events as an individual during the spring of 2018.

#### MANGAN AND SALONEN EARN PLAYING TIME IN 2018

Sophomores Ashley Mangan and Sandra Salonen earned playing time for the first time in their careers in 2018. Mangan played in four events as a sophomore – the Schooner Fall Classic and the Stanford Intercollegiate during the fall of 2017 and the Florida State Match-Up and the Brickyard Collegiate during the spring of 2018 while Salonen played in the Florida State Match-Up, Evans Derby Experience and the Brickyard Collegiate.

#### EIGHT SEMINOLES NAMED TO ACC ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL

For the third consecutive year, every member of the nationally ranked Florida State Women's Golf team has been named to the ACC Academic Honor Roll. The conference released the list of academic honorees with a record number of Seminole student-athletes, including Head Coach Amy Bond's team placing all eight members – the seventh consecutive season at least seven members of the team have been honored for their academic success by the ACC. The eight Seminole women's golfers on the 2018 ACC Academic Honor Roll includes four recent graduates – Lexie Flerlage (Venice, Fla./Real Estate), Kayla Jones (Milton, Ga./Marketing), Kim Metraux

(Lausanne, Switzerland/Management) and Morgane Metraux (Lausanne, Switzerland/Management) – along with sophomores Amanda Doherty (Atlanta, Ga./Sport Management), Ashley Mangan (Clermont, Fla./Finance) and Sandra Salonen (Espoo, Finland/Sport Management) and freshman Kathleen Sumner (Charleston, S.C./Exploratory). Jones and the Metraux sisters tied the program record for ACC Academic Honor Roll appearances with four each.

#### FOUR SEMINOLES NAMED TO ALL ACADEMIC TEAM

Amanda Doherty, Kim Metraux, Morgane Metraux and Kathleen Sumner have been named to the All-ACC Academic Women's Golf team marking the fourth consecutive season at least four Seminoles have been named to the prestigious academic achievement team. The Seminoles led the ACC with four selections as Kim and Morgane Metraux became just the third and fourth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Academic team in each of their four seasons at Florida State. #### FOUR NAMED WGCA ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

A school-record four members of the nationally ranked Florida State Women's Golf Team – Amanda Doherty, Kim Metraux, Morgane Metraux and Kathleen Sumner – have been named 2018 Women's Golf Coaches Association Academic All-Americans. It marks the fifth consecutive season at least one Seminole and sixth time at least three Seminoles have been named to the prestigious academic team. During their careers, Doherty, Kim Metraux, Morgane Metraux and Sumner have been named to the Dean's List (3.5 GPA or better) a total of six times and the President's List (4.0 GPA) a total of 12 times. Kim and Morgane Metraux, both of whom graduated from Florida State in May, became just the second and third players in school history named to the team during each of their four seasons as Seminoles. Both players, who earned their Bachelor's Degrees in Management, joined former Seminole Whitney Brummett as the only four-time selections as WGCA Academic All-Americans. Doherty (Sport Management), who has been named to the President's List in three of her first four semesters at Florida State, became just the third student-athlete at Florida State to be named to the WGCA All-American Scholar Team as a freshman and sophomore. Sumner (Exploratory) is only the fourth freshman in school history to be named a WGCA Academic All-American.
