### ELITE INDIVIDUAL CAMP

This camp is designed for both beginners and more experienced players looking to work on all their volleyball skills. This camp caters to all volleyball positions. Players will be grouped by position to work on specific skills, as well as placed on a team, according to age and skill level to practice playing in a team format. Residents will stay in the dorms during camp. Commuters will go home after the last session at night.

### REGISTRATION:

Registration can be completed online by credit card or by mail via cash or check. To register online visit <https://campscui.active.com/orgs/ChrisPooleVolleyballCamp>. To register by mail- detach the registration form connected to this brochure, fill out completely, and mail to the address below with payment. All remaining balances will be due at check-in before first camp session attended. Please make sure you list a valid email address in order to receive additional camp information.

### CHECK-IN:

All commuter and resident campers will check-in at Tully Gymnasium. 139 Chieftan Way, Tallahassee, FL 32306  
Residents will receive their dorm keys at Dorman Hall after check-in at Tully Gym.

### RESIDENT HOUSING:

Resident campers will stay in quads at Dorman Hall. If camper does not request a roommate they will be grouped together by age. There will be two campers per room and two rooms will share a bathroom. Overnight housing July 9th and 10th will be available for players attending multiple camps and breakfast will be included between camps. There will be at least one camp counselor in the dorms with campers at all times.

### MEALS:

Resident campers will receive all meals. Commuters will receive all meals, except breakfast. If you have a food allergy or special diet, please make the staff aware before arriving at camp. Campers staying overnight on the 9th or 10th will receive breakfast the following morning.

### TRAVELING CAMPERS:

The TLH airport is located 15 minutes from campus. Campers are responsible for arranging their transportation to and from the airport. FSU staff members can transport campers upon request for a cost of \$10 one-way.

### CANCELLATION POLICY:

Refund requests must be received 2 weeks prior to the start of each camp in order to receive full deposit refund. After the first day of each camp begins no refunds will be given, except in the event of an extenuating circumstance.
