NOTING ACC BASEBALL

The opening weekend of ACC play included series sweeps by Clemson and NC State, and the 2,000th career coaching win for Florida State head coach Mike Martin ... Martin became the first NCAA head coach to register 2,000 wins in any sport when the Seminoles turned back Virginia Tech, 5-2, in the rubber game of the teams' league series opener ... In front of a crowd of 5,506 in Tallahassee anxious to witness the milestone victory, Drew Mendoza broke a 2-2 tie with an RBI single in the seventh inning, and J.C. Flowers sealed the win with an eighth inning home run and his second save of the year.

NC State took three straight games from Pitt – including a 4-3 win in the series opener and a 6-5 victory in Sunday's finale – to move to 15-0 on the year, 3-0 in ACC play ... This year's team now holds the record for the best start to a season in school history and is one of two remaining unbeaten teams in NCAA Division I baseball, along with Arizona State ... NC State's 15-game winning streak is also the program's longest since 2013, when the 2013 squad also won 15 consecutive games ... NC State is 7-0 thus far in one-run games this season.

Clemson also got off to a 3-0 start in ACC play with its first three-game series sweep of North Carolina since 1977 ... UNC entered the series at 12-1 and ranked as high as No. 3 nationally ... The Tigers' sweep included a pair of one-run walk-off wins, including a 5-4 win in Sunday's finale on Logan Davidson's two-out, two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth ... Clemson had also trailed by a run in the bottom of the ninth of Friday's series opener before pulling out the win with a pair of runs, the second and decisive of which scored on a balk.

Seven ACC teams remain ranked in at least one major weekly poll, with Florida State and NC State ranked 1-2 nationally by Collegiate Baseball ... ACC teams have 20 midweek non-conference games slated, including several matchups of ranked teams (Florida State at Florida, Duke at East Carolina on Tuesday, Ole Miss at Louisville, Coastal Carolina at Clemson on Wednesday).

ACC Player & Pitcher of the Week - March 11

Miami's Freddy Zamora has been recognized as the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week, while Virginia Tech's Chris Gerard earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

Zamora was dominant at the plate in keying the Hurricanes to a 3-1 week and a 2-1 start to ACC play. After helping Miami beat Appalachian State on Wednesday, Zamora had three hits, including two doubles, in the series opener against Georgia Tech on Friday. The sophomore shortstop hit a walk-off two-run homer on Saturday night that capped another three-hit night and evened the series with Georgia Tech. On Sunday, he tied the game with a two-run shot in the first inning that sparked a 9-6 Miami win over the Yellow Jackets and secured a series victory.

Virginia Tech's Gerard took a no-hitter into the seventh inning and struck out 10 batters en route to his first win on the mound as the Hokies one-hit top-ranked (Collegiate Baseball) Florida State on Saturday and handed the Seminoles their first loss of the season, 6-0.

Gerard tossed a season-high 7.0 innings and struck out the side in the third while recording a season-high in strikeouts as well. Gerard walked two batters in the second inning before retiring 13 straight, including perfect innings in the third, fourth, fifth and sixth. He walked the leadoff batter in the seventh, then allowed the first (and only hit of the day) to the next batter before retiring the last three to keep the Seminoles off the board.

It marked the longest no-hit bid by a Virginia Tech pitcher in the last 15 years.
