NOTING ACC BASEBALL

ACC teams open league play this weekend, with seven three-game series slated Friday through Sunday ... matchups include North Carolina (ranked as high as No. 3 nationally) at Clemson (ranked as high as No. 20) ... other action includes Pitt at NC State, Duke at Virginia, Notre Dame at Wake Forest Virginia Tech at Florida State, Boston College at Louisville and Georgia Tech at Miami ... Seven ACC teams are ranked this week in at least one of the six major polls, with Florida State ranked No. 1 by Collegiate Baseball ... North Carolinians ranked third in three polls, with NC State as high as fifth (Collegiate Baseball) and Louisville as high as eighth (by D-I Baseball) ... Clemson, Duke and Miami are all ranked in multiple polls as well.

Two ACC teams will enter conference play unbeaten, as NC State (12-0) and Florida State (11-0) each posted wins on Wednesday ... NC State overcame an early seven-run deficit to earn an 11-10 victory in extra innings against NC Central at Historic Durham Athletic Park. The Wolfpack matched its best start to a season in program history at 12-0, first achieved by the 1992 squad ... Florida State overcame a three-run deficit in the first inning to defeat North Florida 4-3. The Seminoles' Mike Martin – already the winningest coach in college baseball history – is now two wins away from 2,000 for his career.

Prior to Friday night's series opener against Georgia Tech, Miami will retire legendary head coach Jim Morris' number 3 in a pregame ceremony at Alex Rodriguez Park at Mark Light Field. Morris, a four-time ACC Coach of the Year, enjoyed successful stints with both the Yellow Jackets and Hurricanes while winning nearly 1,600 career games ... Florida State played errorless baseball for the fourth consecutive game and ninth time this season in the win over North Florida. On the year, FSU has committed just two errors and leads the nation in fielding percentage (.995) ... Prior to opening ACC play at Louisville, Boston College tuned up with a 12-3 win at Kentucky on Wednesday. The win was the first for BC over an SEC team since Feb. 28, 2010 (vs. Missouri) and the first over a team competing as an SEC school at the time of the game since Feb. 21, 2004 (Auburn).

ACC Player of the Week Kyle McCann of Georgia Tech and Co-Pitchers of the Week Reid Detmers of Louisville and Jared Shuster of Wake Forest are among five players selected as National Players of the Week by Collegiate Baseball ... They are joined by pitchers Cole Kmet of Notre Dame and Dan Hammer of Pitt.

ACC Player & Pitcher of the Week - March 4

Georgia Tech junior catcher Kyle McCann has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week for March 4, while Louisville sophomore left-hander Reid Detmers and Wake Forest sophomore left-hander Jared Shuster earned Co-Pitcher of the Week honors.

Weekly honorees for ACC baseball are selected by a vote of a media panel and announced on Mondays throughout the regular season. The ACC weekly honors are the second of the season for both Detmers and Shuster, while McCann was honored for the first time.

Georgia Tech's McCann slugged .947 for the week with three home runs, a double and 10 RBI. The Suwanee, Georgia, native also walked four times while scoring eight runs. McCann keyed Friday night's 12-1 series-opening win over Northwestern with a grand slam and seven RBI. McCann is currently tied for second among ACC players with his six home runs on the season and stands fifth in slugging percentage (.833).

Louisville's Detmers recorded a career-high 14 strikeouts and while allowing one hit in eight innings of the Cardinals' 5-0 shutout win over James Madison. The Chatham, Illinois, native, who worked seven no-hit innings in his previous start against Brown, built his streak of consecutive hitless innings to 14 2/3 before a leadoff single in the eighth against JMU. Detmers has recorded 25 strikeouts in his last two outings.

Wake Forest's Shuster struck out 23 batters over 12 innings while picking up wins in two outings last week (Monday versus Elon and Sunday versus Furman). Against Furman, Shuster (3-0) allowed one hit over seven shutout innings while fanning a career-high 12 batters. Shuster leads all ACC pitchers with 34 strikeouts in 18 innings pitched thus far.
