NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Nine regular-season conference games remain for each ACC team ... Louisville sits atop the Atlantic Division with a 15-6 league mark, two games ahead of second-place NC State ... Georgia Tech and North Carolina share first place in the Coastal Division with 13-8 ACC records ... Six ACC series are set for the upcoming weekend, including four divisional matchups with NC State at Notre Dame and Wake Forest at Florida State (Atlantic), while Virginia travels to North Carolina and Virginia Tech plays at Miami (Coastal) ... Other league action finds Duke at Boston College, and Clemson at Georgia Tech.

With some schools beginning to break for final exams, two non-conference series are also on tap with Presbyterian at Pitt and Alabama A&M at Louisville ... ACC teams went 17-1 in midweek non-league games, including Georgia Tech's second win of the season over No. 4 Georgia and North Carolina's win over Coastal Carolina ... ACC teams now hold a 205-80 record this season in non-conference games (.719).

History was made on several fronts during last weekend's ACC series ... When North Carolina captured Saturday's doubleheader against visiting Boston College with a pair of wins in 11 innings, it marked the first time since UNC began keeping detailed records in 1928 that both ends of a twin bill involving the Tar Heels ran past nine innings ... Duke, meanwhile, won three straight games at Clemson, marking the program's first series win at Clemson since 1993, and the first series road sweep of the Tigers since 1948 ... FSU's Mike Martin, who earlier this season became the first head coach in any NCAA sport to reach 2,000 wins, became the first baseball coach to win 500 ACC games during last weekend's series win over Virginia ... Martin's Seminole teams now hold a 501-233 all-time record in ACC play.

Five ACC teams are among the top 25 on the latest RPI, led by No. 6 Louisville ... The Cardinals are followed by No. 11 Georgia Tech, No. 14 Miami, No. 20 North Carolina and No. 24 NC State ... Duke returned the top 25 this week (Collegiate Baseball) and is one of seven ACC team ranked nationally by at least one publication ... Louisville continues to lead the ACC contingent with a top 10 ranking in each of the six major polls ... Cardinals slugger Logan Wyatt has been named the National Hitter of the Week by both the NCBWA and Perfect Game.

ACC Player & Pitcher of the Week - April 22

Louisville junior first baseman Logan Wyatt is the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week, while Notre Dame sophomore left-hander Tommy Vail has been named the ACC Pitcher of the Week after each played a key role in securing ACC series wins.

ACC baseball weekly honors are determined by a vote of a media panel and are announced each Monday throughout the regular season.

Wyatt hit .550 in a 3-1 week for the Cardinals, which included a win over rival Kentucky and a series win against Miami to remain atop the Atlantic Division standings. The Louisville, Kentucky, native homered three times in the weekend series against the Hurricanes. He also had multiple hits in all four games, including a 4-for-6 day with two home runs in game two of the weekend.

For the week, Wyatt finished 11-for-20 with three home runs, three doubles, 12 RBI and nine runs scored.

Notre Dame's Vail made three appearances for the Fighting Irish during the week, allowing just one hit in 7.2 innings pitched. He struck out 11 batters on the week, including six in a career-high five innings against Northwestern to earn the win.

The Seattle, Washington, native threw 1.2 innings of relief to clinch the series and earn his third save of the season against Pitt.
