NOTING ACC BASEBALL

Welcome to Durham

Atlantic Division champion Louisville and Coastal Division champ Georgia Tech will be the top two seeds for the 2019 ACC Baseball Championship, which gets underway Tuesday at Durham Bulls Athletic Park ... The city of Durham is playing host to the 12-team tournament for the second consecutive year, the seventh time in the last 11 years and the 12th time overall ... Led by the top-seeded Cardinals and No. 2 seed Yellow Jackets, this year's tournament features six teams ranked among the nation's Top 25.

How It Works

The Championship will feature a pool-play format, leading into a four-team, single-elimination bracket to determine the league champion ... Louisville earned the No. 1 overall seed and will head up Pool A. The Cardinals will be joined by eighth-seeded Clemson and 12th-seeded Boston College ... Pool B features No. 2 Georgia Tech, along with No. 7 Duke and No. 11 Notre Dame ... No. 3 NC State is joined in Pool C by No. 6 Florida State and No. 10 Wake Forest, while Pool D features No. 4 Miami, No. 5 North Carolina and No. 9 Virginia ... Each team in the four pools will play one game against each of the other two opponents in its pool Tuesday through Friday (May 21-24) ... The four teams with the best records within their respective pools will advance to Saturday's semifinals, with the winners playing on Sunday in the ACC Championship Game.

ACC Honorees On Display

This week's 12-team ACC Championship will feature each of the league's 2019 individual honorees, which were announced Monday afternoon, as well most members of the 2019 All-ACC Team ... Wake Forest sophomore first baseman Bobby Seymour has been voted the ACC Player of the Year by the league's head coaches, while Louisville sophomore left-hander Reid Detmers earned the nod as ACC Pitcher of the Year ... NC State junior shortstop Will Wilson was selected the ACC Defensive Player of the Year, while North Carolina designated hitter/utility man Aaron Sabato was tabbed as the Freshman of the Year ... Georgia Tech's Danny Hall was recognized by his peers as the ACC Coach of the Year ... The complete All-ACC team is listed on page 3.

Driving Them Home, Mowing Them Down

Seymour, a native of St. John, Indiana, leads the ACC in batting with a .377 average and leads the nation in RBI with 92 ... Seymour's 92 RBI are the most by an NCAA Division I player since Florida State's Buster Posey finished with 93 in 2008 and are just two shy of the Wake Forest season record ... Louisville's Detmers has limited opposing batters to a .170 batting average while striking out an ACC-high 138 in 89.1 innings.

ACC Player & Pitcher of the Week - May 20

Clemson senior Grayson Byrd has been named the ACC Baseball Player of the Week, while Georgia Tech junior lefthander Connor Thomas is Pitcher of the Week.

ACC weekly honors are determined by a vote of a select media panel. Byrd collects the honor for the second time this season, while Thomas also secures his second weekly award of the year.

Byrd hit .389 during a 3-1 week for the Tigers, highlighted by a series win against Wake Forest. He was 7-for-18 with four home runs, 10 RBIs, six runs and a 1.056 slugging percentage. The Milton, Georgia, native hit a home run in each of the four games on the week and has homered in 10 of the last 13 games.

Byrd also did not commit an error in 32 chances in the field. At Coastal Carolina last Tuesday, Byrd was 3-for-6 with a grand slam and six RBIs, then hit three home runs in the Wake Forest series.

On the season, he is hitting .326 with 46 runs, 14 doubles, two triples, 15 homers, 56 RBIs, a .604 slugging percentage, .405 on-base percentage and four steals in 56 games.

Thomas threw his second complete-game shutout of the season last Friday to help Georgia Tech clinch the series and ACC Coastal Division. He bested his previous record of 96 pitches in a shutout, needing only 93 pitches to accomplish the feat against the Pittsburgh Panthers. A native of Omega, Georgia, Thomas struck out nine batters to surpass 200 career strikeouts.
