NOTING ACC BASEBALL

This marks the 14th consecutive year that the ACC has placed at least one team in the College World Series and the ninth time during that time period that multiple conference teams have made the trip to Omaha ... A total of 26 ACC teams – nearly a quarter of the total field – have earned CWS berths since 2006 ... Louisville and Florida State were also the ACC's two CWS representatives in 2017 Florida State will open play Saturday night at 7 p.m. ET versus No. 5 seed Arkansas, while No. 7 Louisville faces No. 2 Vanderbilt on Sunday at 2 p.m. ET.

Return Engagements

Florida State, making its 57th overall trip to the postseason, holds the longest active streak with 42 straight appearances in the NCAA tournament ... This year marks the 13th NCAA Baseball Championship appearance for Louisville ... Florida State is making its 40th consecutive NCAA appearance under legendary head coach Mike Martin, who has announced his retirement following the conclusion of this season ... Martin, the winningest NCAA coach in any sport with 2,028 career victories, has led FSU to a record-tying 17 appearances in the College World Series.

In the Cards

Louisville reached the NCAA Super Regional for the eighth time in its 13 NCAA Championship appearances and has landed its fifth College World Series berth ... The Cardinals presented head coach Dan McDonnell with a milestone victory while advancing through the regional round, as their 11-2 win over Illinois State on June 2 marked the 600th of his career ... McDonnell now owns a 603-238 record in 13 seasons at the Louisville helm.

Florida State will face an SEC opponent for the third straight weekend when it takes on Arkansas Saturday evening. The Seminoles defeated host Georgia twice in winning the Athens Regional and won two Super Regional games at LSU ... Louisville played host to Vanderbilt in midweek action on May 7 of this season, with Vanderbilt coming out on top, 6-2. The Cardinals and Commodores have met in four different postseasons, including the 2014 College World Series. The postseason meetings between the two programs are even at four apiece, with Vanderbilt owning the win in the only meeting in Omaha.

Tar Heels Claim 2019 ACC Baseball Title

DURHAM, N.C. – North Carolina captured its seventh ACC Baseball Championship trophy with a 10-2 win over Georgia Tech in the title game on May 26. The Tar Heel offense came to life, blasting four home runs on the day and amassing 12 hits while four Tar Heel pitchers held the Yellow Jackets to four hits and just one earned run.

Senior Michael Busch was named the tournament MVP for the Tar Heels, who capped a 4-0 tournament run with their victory over the Yellow Jackets in a battle of ranked teams and eventual NCAA Regional hosts.

North Carolina is now 7-5 in ACC Baseball Championship title games, including a 3-1 mark under current head coach Mike Fox (winning in 2007, 2013 and this year; losing in 2017). UNC owns 11 ACC baseball titles overall, winning four times during years in which the regular-season winner as crowned the champion (1960, 1964, 1966 and 1969).

Three of UNC's ACC Baseball Championship titles have come in the city of Durham (1984, 2013 and 2019).

ACC BASEBALL BY THE NUMBERS

2 – The ACC owns two College World Series championships – Wake Forest in 1955 and Virginia in 2015. Miami claimed four CWS titles prior to joining the ACC, bringing the total won by current ACC membership to six.

3 – Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

4 – Four active ACC coaches – Florida State's Mike Martin, North Carolina's Mike Fox, Georgia Tech's Danny Hall and NC State's Elliott Avent – have surpassed 1,000 wins for their careers.

5 – No. 7 Louisville entered the NCAA tournament as a national seed for the fifth time in program history (No. 7 in 2010, No. 3 in 2015, No. 2 in 2016 and No. 7 in 2017) ... The Cardinals join Florida as the only two programs to be national seeds four times since 2015.

7 – The ACC has won seven national championships in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball since 2015. That is the most of any conference, and the next closest conference has four. The ACC is the only conference to win each of those four titles over that stretch.

6 – The ACC has placed at least six teams in the NCAA Tournament field each of the last 16 seasons.

8 – The ACC's eight teams in the 2019 NCAA Baseball Championship field were the second-most of any conference ... This marks the fourth time since 2010 that the ACC has placed at least eight teams in NCAA tournament.

10 – This marks the 10th consecutive season that the ACC has boasted two or more top-eight national seeds.

11 – Louisville competed against 11 of the other 63 teams in this year's NCAA Championship field during the regular season, going 17-10 against those teams.

14 – At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the past 14 years, and multiple ACC teams have reached the CWS nine times during that span.

17 – Florida State has reached the College World Series for the 17th time under head coach Mike Martin, which ties with Cliff Gustafson of Texas for the most for a single coach ... The Seminoles have also reached the Super Regionals 17 times in 21 seasons under the current NCAA baseball tournament format.

26 – The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the College World Series in the past 14 years, an average of just under two per season.

28 – This marks the 28th consecutive season that the ACC has had at least one player taken in the first round of the MLB Draft (NC State SS Will Wilson - 15th overall; Clemson SS Logan Davidson - 29th; North Carolina IF/OF Michael Busch - 31st).

30 – Of the eight teams competing in this year's College World Series, Louisville is the lone program to rank in the top 30 nationally in runs per game (13th), earned run average (18th) and fielding percentage (29th).

42 – Florida State's 42nd consecutive selection to the NCAA Baseball Championship field continued the longest active streak in the nation.

69 – The 69 ACC players selected in this year's Major League Draft were the third-most in league history, and it marked the sixth consecutive season that at least 60 conference players were chosen.

82 – Number of NCAA Tournament bids earned by ACC teams over the past 11 seasons.

96 – Combined number of College World Series appearances by the ACC's 14 baseball programs.

115 – Florida State's CJ Van Eyk (120 strikeouts on the year) and Drew Parrish (116) they join Texas A&M's Asa Lacy (130) and John Doxakis (115) as the only teammates with 115 strikeouts this season.

248 – The ACC closed the regular season with a 248-97 (.719) record against non-conference opposition.

600 – Louisville's win over Illinois State in NCAA Regional play June 2 marked head coach Dan McDonnell's 600th in 13 seasons at the school ... McDonnell will carry a 603-238 (.717) mark as the Cardinals' head coach into this year's College World Series

985 – Current ACC teams own a total of 985 wins in NCAA Tournament play while posting a winning percentage of .575.

2,028 – Number of wins for Florida State's Mike Martin, who will retire at the end of this season as the NCAA's all-time winningest coach in any sport.

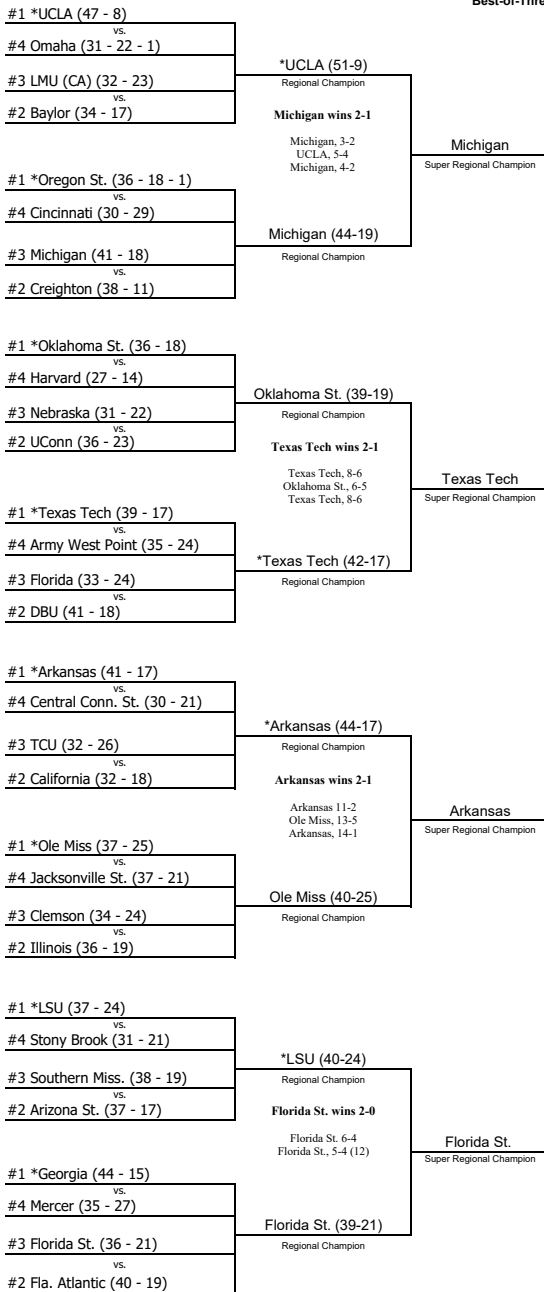

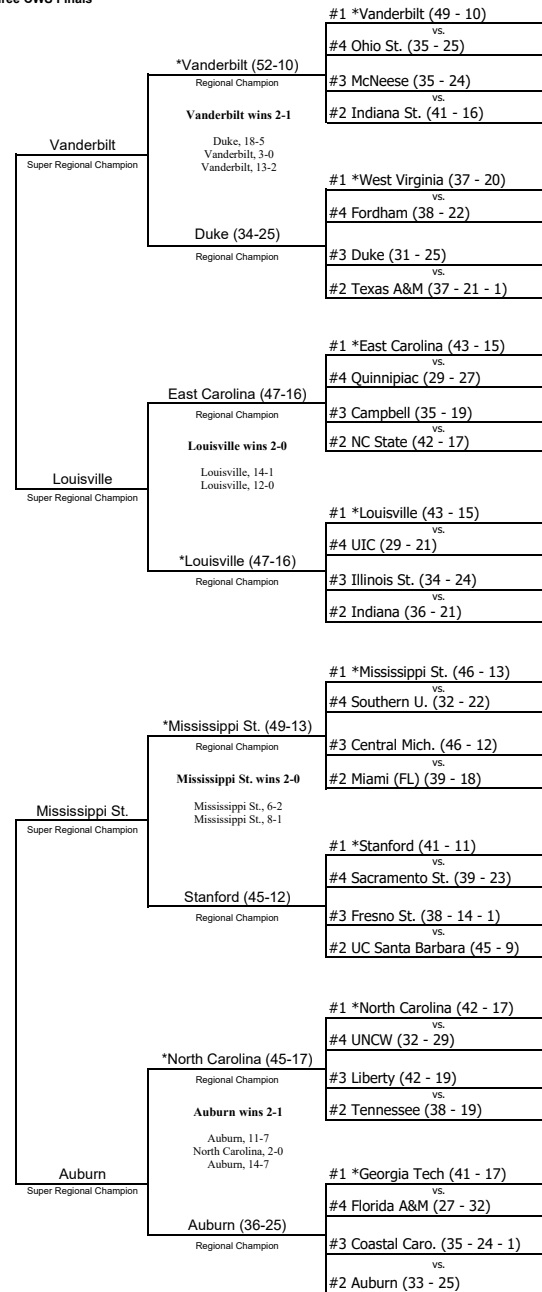
