AROUND THE ACC

- **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Returning to the floor this season after missing 676 days due to injuries in his freshman and sophomore seasons, junior guard Wynston Tabbs is averaging a team-high 15.3 ppg (14th in ACC).
- **CLEMSON:** With the Tigers playing at least 10 players in every game this season, Clemson's bench has produced 25 or more points in 6-of-7 games. Six players are averaging at least 5.0 ppg, led by Aamir Simms at 12.1 ppg.
- **DUKE:** Sophomore forward Matthew Hurt is one of four players in the ACC ranked in the league's top 10 for scoring (3rd, 18.8), rebounding (6th, 8.0) and field goal percentage (6th .522). He and Syracuse's Quincy Guerrier are the only two ranked in the top six in each.
- **FLORIDA STATE:** Four players are averaging in double figure scoring: M.J. Walker, 16.0 ppg; Anthony Polite, 11.5; Scottie Barnes, 10.7; Balsa Koprivica, 10.2. Nine players are averaging in double figure minutes played per game with four averaging more than 25 minutes per game.
- **GEORGIA TECH:** Six of Tech's top seven scorers have positive assist/turnover ratios. The Jackets rank second in the ACC and No. 38 nationally in assist/turnover ratio (1.39).
- **LOUISVILLE:** Graduate guard Carlík Jones scored a game-high 20 points Saturday against Kentucky, his season high. He has scored in double figures in all six of his games this season.
- **MIAMI:** With 664 career victories, head coach Jim Larrañaga is tied with John Wooden for No. 36 on the NCAA's all-time wins list. Larrañaga is one of 22 active coaches with at least 650 career wins, and one of 11 at the D1 level.
- **NORTH CAROLINA:** Sophomore C/F Armando Bacot scored a team-high 16 points at NC State and is averaging a team-best 12.0 ppg this year. In the last three games, Bacot is averaging 16.3 ppg and 8.3 rpg.
- **NC STATE:** Senior guard Devon Daniels has scored in double figures in five of six games this season, including a team-high 21 in the win over UNC. He leads the team in scoring and is sixth in the ACC at 17.0 ppg.
- **NOTRE DAME:** Junior guard Dane Goodwin has scored 52 points in Notre Dame's last two home games (25 points on 10-of-12 shooting, 27 on 8-of-10 shooting against Bellarmine. He is 18-of-22 (.818) from the floor in the last two Irish home games.
- **PITT:** Junior guard Xavier Johnson is one of two players in the ACC averaging at least 14.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg and 4.0 apg. For the season he is averaging 14.4 ppg, 4.3 rpg and 5.1 apg.
- **SYRACUSE:** Sophomore forward Quincy Guerrier joins Pitt's Justin Champagne as the lone ACC players currently averaging a double-double. Guerrier is fourth in the ACC in scoring (18.0) and second in rebounding (10.0). Guerrier owns an ACC-best four double-doubles this season.
- **VIRGINIA:** Junior point guard Kihei Clark racked up a career-high 19 points Saturday against top-ranked Gonzaga. He is averaging 9.2 ppg this season.
- **VIRGINIA TECH:** Sophomore guard Jalen Cone tied a career high with six 3-pointers in the Hokies' win over Longwood. He has hit 11 3-pointers in the last two games and is 15-for-39 (.385) this season behind the arc.
- **WAKE FOREST:** The Demon Deacons are scheduled to return to action this week after pausing their program because of COVID-19. Wake added a game with Catawba for New Year's Eve. Wake's last contest was on Nov. 27.

ACC QUICK HITS

- Four ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press poll: Florida State (18), Duke (20), Virginia (23) and Virginia Tech (24).
- Florida State and Miami each hit the road for the first time this season tonight. Wake Forest will be the final ACC team to play away from home; the Demon Deacons are scheduled to play Sunday at Georgia Tech.
- The ACC announced Monday that the Pitt-Duke game, slated for this evening, has been postponed following a positive test in the Pitt program, subsequent quarantining and contact tracing required for the Pitt team.
- The ACC announced last week that Syracuse's games Wake Forest (Dec. 30) and North Carolina (Jan. 2) have been postponed. The postponement follows positive tests in a recent SU opponent, subsequent quarantining and contact tracing required for the SU team.
- Louisville sophomore guard David Johnson was tabbed the ACC Player of the Week on Monday, while NC State guard Shakeel Moore was named ACC Freshman of the Week.
- Johnson averaged 17.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 3.0 apg last week in wins over Pitt and Kentucky. He was 13-of-22 (.591) from the field and 4-of-9 (from 3-point range). Johnson produced his first career double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds in the Cardinals' ACC opener at Pitt. He totaled 17 points, seven rebounds and four assists Saturday against rival Kentucky.
- Moore scored 17 points on 6-of-11 shooting (3-4 3FG) and recorded two steals in NC State's 79-76 win over UNC. It was his first career double-digit scoring outing. Moore entered the game with score tied at 15 and scored the next 10 points for NC State to spark a 10-2 run. The Wolfpack did not trail the rest of the way.
- Clemson ranks third nationally in scoring defense at 53.4 ppg. Wake Forest is seventh at 55.2 ppg.
- The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alums on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

• Seven ACC players were named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 Watch List: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark and Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt and Jalen Johnson (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

• The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

• A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

• Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

• Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.

• Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.

• Eight ACC players are on the watch list for the 2021 Naismith Trophy, tied for the most of any conference: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks and Caleb Love (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt, Jalen Johnson and Wendell Moore (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

• Ten of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

• For the second straight year, ACC teams will play 20-game conference schedules. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

• Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.

• Eight ACC players were selected in the 2020 NBA Draft on Nov. 18. Three were picked in the first round: FSU's Patrick Williams (4th, Chicago) and Devin Vassell (11th, San Antonio) and UNC's Cole Anthony (15th, Orlando). The ACC has had at least one first-round selection in 32 consecutive years (1989-2020).

• ACC programs this season welcomed 13 recruits in the top 50 and 20 overall in the 2020 ESPN Top 100, led by No. 5-ranked Scottie Barnes of Florida State. The rest of the ACC's top 50 recruits: Day'Ron Sharpe (12, UNC), Jalen Johnson (13, Duke), Walker Kessler (14, UNC), Caleb Love (18, UNC), Jeremy Roach (19, Duke), DJ Steward (25, Duke), Jaemyn Brakefield (31, Duke), Mark Williams (32, Duke), Earl Timberlake (37, Miami), Jabri Abdur-Rahim (38, Virginia), R.J. Davis (43, UNC) and P.J. Hall (48, Clemson).

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

• Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
• All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

• With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
• North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
• The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
• Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

• Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
• Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1).
• The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
• Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

• The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

• Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

• During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
• Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
• The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

• 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE

The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.



- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.
