AROUND THE ACC

• **BOSTON COLLEGE:** In his first action in two seasons, junior guard Wynston Tabbs has scored in double figures in all six games this season and is averaging a team-high 16.2 ppg. He is 13-of-34 (.382) from 3-point range.

• **CLEMSON:** Sophomore guard Al-Amir Dawes led all scorers with a season-high 18 points on 6-of-14 shooting Tuesday at Virginia Tech. Five of Dawes' six made field goals came from beyond the arc.

• **DUKE:** The Blue Devils put four players in double figures in the scoring column, including three freshmen: DJ Steward (16), Jeremy Roach (14) and Jaemyn Brakefield (10). Freshmen accounted for 44 of Duke's 75 points in the win.

• **FLORIDA STATE:** In his first ACC game Tuesday, freshman guard Scottie Barnes scored a team-high 16 points and pulled down six rebounds in the Seminoles' win over Georgia Tech.

• **GEORGIA TECH:** Junior guard Michael Devoe has bounced back from the first scoreless game of his career (0-6 FG vs. Kentucky) to score 12 at Nebraska and a game-high 21 at Florida State. He hit 11-of-24 shots from the floor combined in the last two games (4-12 3FG).

• **LOUISVILLE:** Graduate transfer guard Carlik Jones is off to a terrific start to the season. He is the only player in the ACC to rank among the top 15 in scoring (7th, 17.3 ppg), rebounding (14th, 7.0) and assists (3rd, 5.3).

• **MIAMI:** With the Canes down to just seven scholarship players because of injuries, sophomore Isaiah Wong stepped up again with 21 points Wednesday, his third 20-point outing of the season. He is averaging 17.8 ppg this year.

• **NORTH CAROLINA:** UNC begins a three-game swing away from home (Kentucky in Cleveland, at NC State on Tuesday and at Georgia Tech on Dec. 30). UNC is scheduled to play at home just twice in the first nine games for the first time since the 2007-08 season.

• **NC STATE:** In the Wolfpack's return to the court Thursday, sophomore center Manny Bates had a big night posting career highs in points (20) and blocked shots (8) while pulling down seven rebounds.

• **NOTRE DAME:** Junior guard Dane Goodwin hit 10-of-12 field goals en route to a career-high 25 points Wednesday against Duke. He was 4-of-6 from behind the arc and is shooting 47.1% (8-of-17) from 3-point range this season.

• **PITT:** Sophomore guard Ithiel Horton scored a season-high 18 points – all in the second half – in the Wednesday win at Miami. He was 6-of-8 from the field in the second half, including 4-of-5 from 3-point range, over the final 20 minutes of play.

• **SYRACUSE:** Sophomore forward Quincy Guerrier had a big day Wednesday versus Northeastern with 18 points and a career-best 16 rebounds. It also marked his third double-double in six games this season.

• **VIRGINIA:** In his first season at UVA, senior forward Sam Hauser leads the team in scoring (14.5) and rebounding (6.8) and is shooting 58.5% from the field and 43.8% from 3-point range (7 of 16).

• **VIRGINIA TECH:** Sophomore guard Tyrece Radford scored a team-high 15 points Tuesday in the win over Clemson. It was his fourth game in double figures this season. He is second on the team in scoring at 11.7 ppg.

• **WAKE FOREST:** Through two games, Wake has four players averaging in double figures in scoring, led by senior guard Jonah Antonio at 13.0 ppg.

ACC QUICK HITS

• Six ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press poll: Florida State (15), Virginia (17), North Carolina (21), Duke (22), Louisville (23) and Clemson (24). The ACC's streak of 461 straight polls with at least one AP Top 10 team – by far the longest by any conference ever – came to an end this week. The streak dated to the 1996 season.

• The previous record for the longest streak of consecutive polls with an AP Top 10 team was 190, also by the ACC. That streak was from 1978-89.

• Heading into the weekend, the ACC has played 69 of 86 scheduled men's basketball games (80.2%).

• The Louisville at Wisconsin game in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, originally scheduled for Dec. 9, has been rescheduled for Saturday at Noon.

• There were several non-conference schedule changes made Wednesday and Thursday:

• North Carolina now will play Kentucky instead of Ohio State Saturday in Cleveland.

• Virginia's Saturday game with Villanova in New York City has been canceled. The Cavaliers now will host William & Mary Tuesday in a rescheduled game. UVA also will play Gonzaga on Dec. 26 in Fort Worth, Texas.

• Clemson's Tuesday game with Morehead State was moved up to Monday.

• Boston College's Tuesday game with Cal was canceled and replaced by a game with Maine.

• Pitt sophomore forward Justin Champagnie was named the ACC Player of the Week on Monday. Florida State guard Scottie Barnes earned ACC Freshman of the Week honors.

• Champagnie recorded a pair of 20-point, 20-rebound games last week versus Northwestern and Gardner-Webb, averaging 22.0 ppg, 20.5 rpg and 2.5 apg in the wins. He became the first NCAA Division I player since Caleb Swanigan of Purdue (2016-17) to post consecutive 20-20 games and joined Swanigan and Oklahoma's Blake Griffin (2008-09) as the only players in the last 25 years to record back-to-back 20-20 games.

• Barnes averaged 13.0 ppg, 5.0 apg and 3.0 rpg and shot 50% (10 of 20) from the field in wins over Indiana and Florida last week. He scored the game-winning basket in the Seminoles' 69-67 overtime win over the Hoosiers in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.

- Seven ACC players were named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 Watch List: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark and Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt and Jalen Johnson (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

- The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

- A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

- Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

- Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.

- Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.

- Eight ACC players are on the watch list for the 2021 Naismith Trophy, tied for the most of any conference: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks and Caleb Love (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt, Jalen Johnson and Wendell Moore (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

- Ten of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

- For the second straight year, ACC teams will play 20-game conference schedules. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

- Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.

- Eight ACC players were selected in the 2020 NBA Draft on Nov. 18. Three were picked in the first round: FSU's Patrick Williams (4th, Chicago) and Devin Vassell (11th, San Antonio) and UNC's Cole Anthony (15th, Orlando). The ACC has had at least one first-round selection in 32 consecutive years (1989-2020).

- ACC programs this season welcomed 13 recruits in the top 50 and 20 overall in the 2020 ESPN Top 100, led by No. 5-ranked Scottie Barnes of Florida State. The rest of the ACC's top 50 recruits: Day Ron Sharpe (12, UNC), Jalen Johnson (13, Duke), Walker Kessler (14, UNC), Caleb Love (18, UNC), Jeremy Roach (19, Duke), DJ Steward (25, Duke), Jaemyn Brakefield (31, Duke), Mark Williams (32, Duke), Earl Timberlake (37, Miami), Jabri Abdur-Rahim (38, Virginia), R.J. Davis (43, UNC) and P.J. Hall (48, Clemson).

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE

The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.



- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness
