AROUND THE ACC

- **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Senior forward Steffon Mitchell recorded 16 points and 13 rebounds against Notre Dame. It was his second double-double of the season and the 16th of his career (most among active ACC players).
- **CLEMSON:** Senior forward Aamir Simms posted his sixth double-digit scoring game of the season with 19 points at Georgia Tech on Wednesday. He was 9-of-14 from the field. He also has two 20-point outings this season.
- **DUKE:** Freshman forward Jalen Johnson posted 24 points, 15 rebounds, seven assists and no turnovers Tuesday. He is the first Duke player all-time to score at least 20 points, have at least 15 rebounds, at least seven assists and no turnovers in a single game.
- **FLORIDA STATE:** Senior guard M.J. Walker is averaging a career-high 16.3 ppg this season. He has scored 933 career points and is on pace to become the 47th member of the Seminoles' 1,000 career point club.
- **GEORGIA TECH:** Guards Jose Alvarado, Michael Devoe and Bubba Parham have hit 36-of-78 collectively (46.2%) from 3-point range in Tech's last five games and are 26-of-58 (44.8%) against the ACC.
- **LOUISVILLE:** Freshman forward Jae'Lyn Withers has made 71.8% of his shots over his last six games (28-of-39). He is the Cardinals' rebounding leader and ranks second among ACC freshmen (7.3 rpg, ninth in the ACC).
- **MIAMI:** After missing seven of the past eight games with a hamstring injury, senior guard Kameron McGusty returned to action Tuesday. He scored nine points and passed the 1,000-career point mark (at Miami and Oklahoma).
- **NORTH CAROLINA:** UNC's first seven ACC games each have been decided by seven points or fewer. This is the first time in UNC history it has played seven consecutive ACC games decided by seven points or fewer.
- **NC STATE:** The Wolfpack leads the ACC in steals (9.3), turnovers forced (17.8) and turnover margin (+5.2). NC State has had 10 or more steals in four games this season.
- **NOTRE DAME:** Junior forward Nate Laszewski leads the ACC in field goal percentage at 64.1%, which leads the ACC, is third among major conference players and 11th in the NCAA (min 5 FGM/G, 5 GP).
- **PITT:** Coming off a 22-point effort versus Duke, junior forward Au'Diese Toney has scored in double figures in eight of his nine games played this season and 31 times in his career. The Panthers are 21-10 over the past three seasons when Toney scores 10 or more points.
- **SYRACUSE:** Guards Buddy Boeheim and Joseph Girard III each recorded 23 points Tuesday, a season high for both. They combined for 17-of-31 (54.8%) from the field, including 9-of-17 (52.9%) from 3-point distance.
- **VIRGINIA:** UVa has scored 70 or more points in eight games (7-1) and its 73.5 points per game are most under Tony Bennett, and best since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08. The Cavaliers scored 70 or more points twice last season.
- **VIRGINIA TECH:** Sophomore guard Jalen Cone leads the ACC with 30 3-pointers made this season (3.0/game), despite averaging just 19.3 minutes per game off the bench. He is shooting 39.0% from downtown.
- **WAKE FOREST:** Junior guard Daivien Williamson leads Wake in points per game (13.1), assists per game (3.1) and minutes per game (34.1). He recorded a career-high 27 points Wednesday at North Carolina.

ACC QUICK HITS

- Three ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll: Virginia (13), Virginia Tech (16) and Clemson (20). Florida State is No. 25 in the USA Today poll. Louisville is the first team outside the top 25 in both polls.
 - Home teams are 28-15 (.651) in conference play.
 - The ACC has played 127 of 159 scheduled men's basketball games (79.9%).
 - The teams with the two longest current winning streaks at five apiece – Georgia Tech and Virginia – square off Saturday night in Charlottesville. It also matches the two shooting teams in the ACC – UVa at 50.7% and Georgia Tech at 47.7%.
 - Pitt sophomore forward Justin Champagnie (20.3 ppg, 13.0 rpg) is the only player nationally to currently average at least 20 ppg and 13 rpg. He leads the ACC in both categories and ranks second nationally in rebounding.
 - North Carolina and Pitt are two of the top rebounding teams in the nation. UNC is second nationally in rebounding (43.5/game) and fourth in rebound margin (+11.4/game). Pitt ranks fifth nationally in rebounding (43.1/game).
 - Among the national leaders, Virginia ranks seventh nationally in scoring defense at 59.4 ppg. Pitt is sixth nationally in 3-point defense at 26.1%.
 - Florida State owns a 20-game ACC home win streak, tied for fourth longest in league history. The stretch dates to a Jan. 22, 2019, win over Clemson.

• Pitt's Justin Champagnie and Virginia Tech sophomore guard Tyrece Radford were named the ACC Co-Players of the Week on Monday. North Carolina guard RJ Davis was selected as the ACC Freshman of the Week.

• Champagnie scored 24 points and pulled down 16 rebounds Saturday in Pitt's 96-76 triumph over Syracuse. Returning to action for the first time since suffering a knee injury Dec. 20, he recorded his fourth double-double and fourth 20-10 game of the season.

• Radford led Virginia Tech in scoring in two wins last week, averaging 19.0 ppg, 8.0 rpg and 3.5 apg in victories over then-No. 19 Duke (74-67) and Wake Forest (64-60).

• Davis averaged 14.0 ppg and 2.0 apg per game as UNC defeated Syracuse (81-75) and fell at Florida State (82-75). He was 9-for-17 from the field, including 4-for-9 from 3-point range.

• Five ACC players were named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt (Duke) and Carlik Jones (UL). The ACC's total is second only to the Big Ten (6).

• The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

• The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

• A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

• Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

• Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.

• Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.

• Eight ACC players are on the watch list for the 2021 Naismith Trophy, tied for the most of any conference: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks and Caleb Love (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt, Jalen Johnson and Wendell Moore (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

• Ten of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

• For the second straight year, ACC teams will play 20-game conference schedules. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

• Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE



The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.

- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
