## AROUND THE ACC

- **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Senior forward Steffon Mitchell recorded 16 points and 13 rebounds against Notre Dame. It was his second double-double of the season and the 16th of his career (most among active ACC players).
- **CLEMSON:** Senior forward Amir Simms is 32 points shy of 1,000 for his career and is on pace to become just the fourth player in school history to amass 1,000 points, 550 rebounds, 75 steals and 75 blocks (Trevor Booker, 2006-10; Horace Grant, 1983-87; and Larry Nance, 1977-81).
- **DUKE:** Senior guard Jordan Goldwire, who is coming off a career-high-tying seven assists versus Georgia Tech, leads the ACC in assist/turnover ratio (+2.8) and ranks second in steals (2.5) and eighth in assists (3.8). He has 25 assists and five turnovers over the last six games.
- **FLORIDA STATE:** FSU has led four of its last five opponents by at least 20 points (Clemson by 38, NC State by 36, Louisville by 24 and Miami by 24) and is averaging an 18.6-point margin of victory in the last five games.
- **GEORGIA TECH:** Senior forward Moses Wright needs two rebounds to reach 500 for his career and six points to reach 900. He is within reach this season of becoming the 21st player in Tech history to score 1,000 points and grab 500 rebounds in a career.
- **LOUISVILLE:** Graduate guard Carlík Jones has scored in double figures in 36 consecutive games, including all 13 this season. He is fourth in the ACC in scoring (17.9 ppg), third in assists (4.6 apg) and eighth in assist/turnover ratio (1.9).
- **MIAMI:** Sophomore guard Isaiah Wong is fifth in the ACC in scoring (17.6), seventh in minutes (35.5), seventh in free-throw percentage (77.0) and 11th in field-goal percentage (44.4).
- **NORTH CAROLINA:** UNC shot 52.5% from the floor on Tuesday. It was the second time this season and second time in as many games that UNC shot 50%. UNC is 216-9 under Roy Williams when it shoots 50% from the floor.
- **NC STATE:** Senior guard Devon Daniels led the Wolfpack with 20 points Wednesday before leaving with an injury. He will miss the remainder of the season with a torn ACL. Daniels leads the team in scoring at 16.5 ppg (eighth in ACC).
- **NOTRE DAME:** The Fighting Irish are committing just 12.1 fouls per game, fewest in the nation. The Irish are ahead of Appalachian State (13.0) and Virginia (13.3) for the national lead.
- **PITT:** Sophomore forward Justin Champagnie is one of three players nationally averaging better than 20 points and 10 rebounds per game. He ranks second in the NCAA in rebounding (12.2 rpg) and third in defensive rebounds (8.8 drpg).
- **SYRACUSE:** Sophomore forward Quincy Guerrier recorded another strong outing Monday with a team-high 15 points and seven rebounds at UVa. He now is averaging 16.8 ppg and 9.4 rpg this season.
- **VIRGINIA:** Senior forward Jay Huff posted a career-high 21 points and 12 rebounds Monday for his sixth career double-double. UVa is now 35-1 under Tony Bennett when scoring at least 80 points.
- **VIRGINIA TECH:** The Hokies' 6-2 start in ACC play matches its best in program history (2006-07). Junior forwards Keve Aluma and Justyn Mutts each recorded double-doubles Wednesday in the win at Notre Dame.
- **WAKE FOREST:** Junior guard Davien Williamson scored 22 points (20 in second half) Wednesday at NC State. He is averaging 17.5 ppg over the last six ACC games.

## ACC QUICK HITS

- Four ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll: Virginia (8), Florida State (16), Virginia Tech (20) and Louisville (25).
  - ACC home teams are now 39-18 (68.4%) in conference play.
  - The ACC has played 141 of 175 scheduled men's basketball games (80.6%).
  - Boston College's Saturday game at Louisville has been postponed (positive tests, subsequent quarantining, and contact tracing within BC program).
  - The ACC announced that Georgia Tech will play at Louisville on Monday, Feb. 1 in a rescheduled game (from Jan. 9) that will tip at 2 p.m. on ACC Network.
  - The ACC announced Wednesday that Florida State will play at Pitt on Saturday, Feb. 6 in a rescheduled game (from Jan. 9). Tip time is 2 p.m. on RSN.
  - Among the national leaders, Virginia ranks eighth nationally in scoring defense at 59.6 ppg. UVa also ranks in the top 10 nationally in fewest turnovers (2nd, 8.2), free-throw percentage (3rd, 80.4%) and assist/turnover ratio (6th, 1.7).
  - North Carolina ranks third nationally in rebounding (43.1/game) and rebound margin (+11.3/game) and leads the country in offensive rebounding (12.1).
  - NC State stands No. 9 nationally in steals per game at 9.4. Georgia Tech is just behind in 11th at 9.1.
  - Florida State now owns a 22-game ACC home win streak, tied for second longest in league history. The stretch dates to a Jan. 22, 2019 win over Clemson.

- Pitt sophomore forward Justin Champagnie was named the ACC Player of the Week for the second consecutive week Monday. North Carolina guard Caleb Love earned ACC Freshman of the Week accolades.

- Champagne averaged 24.0 ppg, 11.0 rpg, 2.5 bpg and 3.5 steals in games against Duke and Wake Forest. He matched a career high with 31 points Tuesday against Duke, to go along with 14 rebounds and a career-best five blocks. He became the first player in program history to post at least 30 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks in a game.

- Love averaged 17.5 ppg, 3.0 rpg and 4.0 apg in wins over Wake Forest and NC State last week. He was 13-of-28 from the field in those contests. He directed an offense that scored 80-plus points in back-to-back games for the first time this season.

- FSU's Scottie Barnes and Louisville's Carlik Jones were selected as two of the top 10 candidates for the 2021 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

- Five ACC players were named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt (Duke) and Carlik Jones (UL). The ACC's total is second only to the Big Ten (6).

- The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

- The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

- A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

- Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

- Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.

- Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.

- Eight ACC players are on the watch list for the 2021 Naismith Trophy, tied for the most of any conference: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks and Caleb Love (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt, Jalen Johnson and Wendell Moore (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

- Eleven of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

- For the second straight year, ACC teams will play 20-game conference schedules. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

- Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.

- Eight ACC players were selected in the 2020 NBA Draft on Nov. 18. Three were picked in the first round: FSU's

## NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

### All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

### NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

### Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

### Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

### All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

### ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

### ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

## COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE

The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.



- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness
