AROUND THE ACC

- **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Freshman guard DeMarr Langford Jr. recorded season highs in back-to-back games with 12 points Tuesday at Duke and 14 Saturday vs. Virginia. His previous scoring high was eight.
- **CLEMSON:** Sophomore guard Nick Honor led the Tigers Tuesday with a season-high 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting, including the game-tying 3-pointer in the last minute of regulation to send the game to OT. He made 5-of-6 from 3.
- **DUKE:** Senior guard Jordan Goldwire leads the ACC in steals (2.71) and assist/turnover ratio (+2.55) and ranks sixth in assists (4.0). Duke is currently second in the ACC and ninth nationally in steals (9.57).
- **FLORIDA STATE:** Senior guard M.J. Walker leads the team in scoring at 15.3 ppg (13th in ACC). He also is the ACC's leader in free-throw shooting at 92.5% (37-of-40).
- **GEORGIA TECH:** GT has won four straight games, matching the longest winning streak by a Tech team under Josh Pastner. The Jackets finished the 2019-20 season with four straight wins and have won four in a row on three other occasions. Tech has not won as many as five in a row since the 2012-13 season (six straight in December of that season).
- **LOUISVILLE:** Freshman Jae'Lyn Withers finished with 16 points and 12 rebounds Wednesday for his first double-double. He is the first UofL freshman with at least 12 rebounds and at least 15 points versus a league foe since Pervis Ellison (21p, 13r) in a win over Memphis State in the Metro Conference Tournament Championship on March 9, 1986.
- **MIAMI:** Sophomore guard Isaiah Wong scored 24 points and grabbed nine rebounds Saturday in the win at NC State. Wong leads the team and is fourth in the ACC in scoring this season at 17.5 ppg.
- **NORTH CAROLINA:** UNC will become the first men's basketball program to play 1,000 regular-season ACC games with its next game on Tuesday. The Tar Heels are 707-292 in 999 regular-season ACC games. The 707 wins are also the most in ACC history.
- **NC STATE:** Senior forward D.J. Funderburk recorded his second career double-double Saturday with 12 points and a career-high tying 11 rebounds against Miami.
- **NOTRE DAME:** After going 21-of-26 at the free-throw line Sunday, the Fighting Irish are shooting an ACC-best 79.5% for the season at the charity stripe, just a fraction of a point better than second-place Virginia.
- **PITT:** Junior guard Xavier Johnson became the 47th player in program history to top the 1,000-point mark on Wednesday and is the 11th point guard in program history to score 1,000 career points. He currently has 1,010 points.
- **SYRACUSE:** The Orange had four players reach double figures Saturday in the win over Georgetown: Buddy Boheim led all scorers with 21 points, followed by Joseph Girard III (18), Quincy Guerrier (12) and Marek Dolezaj (11).
- **VIRGINIA:** With 17 points and 10 rebounds Saturday at BC, senior forward Sam Hauser has registered three straight double-doubles, most at Virginia since Mike Scott had five straight in 2010-11.
- **VIRGINIA TECH:** Sophomore guard Jalen Cone scored a team-high 18 points Sunday. In his last five games, Cone is averaging 17.8 ppg and shooting 23-of-61 (37.7%) from behind the arc.
- **WAKE FOREST:** Sophomore forward Ismael Massoud recorded career highs in points (17) and rebounds (8). He averaged 15 ppg in the Demon Deacons' games at Virginia and Duke this past week.

ACC QUICK HITS

- Five ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press poll: Clemson (12), Louisville (16), Virginia (18), Duke (19) and Virginia Tech (20).
- In all, 18 of the 26 ACC contests to this point have been decided by 10 or fewer points, including nine games by one possession.
- Heading into play Tuesday, the ACC has played 110 of 137 scheduled men's basketball games (80.3%).
- The Clemson at Syracuse game for Tuesday has been postponed (positive test, subsequent quarantining, and contact tracing within the CU program). In a makeup of a Jan. 2 game, Syracuse will travel to North Carolina on Tuesday at 9 p.m.
- The Pitt at Georgia Tech game on Wednesday has been postponed (positive test, subsequent quarantining, and contact tracing within the GT program).
- Originally scheduled for Jan. 2, the Notre Dame at Pitt game has been rescheduled for Jan. 30. North Carolina now will have a bye on Jan. 30.
- Duke swept the ACC's weekly awards this week, with sophomore forward Matthew Hurt claiming ACC Player of the Week honors and freshman guard DJ Steward earning ACC Freshman of the Week laurels.
- Hurt averaged 21.5 ppg and 8.5 rpg last week in wins over Boston College and Wake Forest. He was a team-best .567 (17-of-30) from the field and .538 (7-of-13) from 3-point range for the week. Hurt posted his second double-double this season Wednesday with 17 points and 11 rebounds against BC. Seven of his 17 points came in the game's final 5:15. He then poured in a career-high 26 points with six boards versus Wake Forest.
- Steward was Duke's second-leading scorer for the week, averaging 17.5 ppg and 7.0 rpg. He scored 14 points with eight boards, two blocks and three steals versus Boston College and followed it up with 21 points, six rebounds and two more blocks in 39 minutes against Wake Forest.
- Five ACC players were named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List, released Wednesday: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt (Duke) and Carlik Jones (UL). The ACC's total is second only to the Big Ten (6).

- The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

- The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

- A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

- Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

- Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.

- Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.

- Eight ACC players are on the watch list for the 2021 Naismith Trophy, tied for the most of any conference: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks and Caleb Love (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt, Jalen Johnson and Wendell Moore (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

- Ten of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

- For the second straight year, ACC teams will play 20-game conference schedules. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

- Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.

- Eight ACC players were selected in the 2020 NBA Draft on Nov. 18. Three were picked in the first round: FSU's Patrick Williams (4th, Chicago) and Devin Vassell (11th, San Antonio) and UNC's Cole Anthony (15th, Orlando). The ACC has had at least one first-round selection in 32 consecutive years (1989-2020).

- ACC programs this season welcomed 13 recruits in the top 50 and 20 overall in the 2020 ESPN Top 100, led by No. 5-ranked Scottie Barnes of Florida State. The rest of the ACC's top 50 recruits: Day'Ron Sharpe (12, UNC), Jalen Johnson (13, Duke), Walker Kessler (14, UNC), Caleb Love (18, UNC), Jeremy Roach (19, Duke), DJ Steward (25, Duke), Jaemyn Brakefield (31, Duke), Mark Williams (32, Duke), Earl Timberlake (37, Miami), Jabri Abdur-Rahim (38, Virginia), R.J. Davis (43, UNC) and P.J. Hall (48, Clemson).

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE



The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.

- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
