AROUND THE ACC

- **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Senior forward Steffon Mitchell recorded his third double-double of the season Saturday with 12 points and 10 boards. It was the 17th double-double of his career, most of any active ACC player.
- **CLEMSON:** Sophomore guard Nick Honor banked in the go-ahead 3-pointer with 1.1 seconds left Friday as the Tigers scored the game's final five points in the last 11 seconds to rally for the win. Honor scored 12 points in the victory.
- **DUKE:** Sophomore Matthew Hurt scored 24 points Saturday on 8-of-10 shooting, including 6-of-7 from 3-point range. He was two points shy of his career-high 26 points scored earlier this season vs. Wake Forest. It marked his 11th career 20-point game – seventh this season.
- **FLORIDA STATE:** FSU won its 11th consecutive overtime game Saturday, matching an NCAA record, set by Louisville (1968-75), UMass (1991-96) and Virginia (1991-96). The Seminoles have won each of their overtime decisions since a 101-90 2OT win over Syracuse on Jan. 13, 2018.
- **GEORGIA TECH:** Junior guard Michael Devoe scored 23 points Friday, his most in a game since going for 24 in the 4OT season opener. It was his fifth 20-point effort of the season. He was 8-for-8 from the free throw line and 7-of-12 from the floor and added six assists and five steals.
- **LOUISVILLE:** David Johnson (24 pts, 10 rebs) and Samuel Williamson (20 pts, 18 rebs) on Feb. 1 became the first pair of Louisville teammates with 20 points and 10 rebounds in the same game since Montrezl Harrell and Terry Rozier did it on Feb. 11, 2015, against Pitt.
- **MIAMI:** After averaging 7.7 ppg as a freshman, sophomore guard Isaiah Wong is posting 17.4 ppg this year, a 9.7-point increase – tops among all ACC players.
- **NORTH CAROLINA:** Freshman center Walker Kessler led UNC in scoring with a season-high nine points Saturday. It was the first time no Tar Heel scored in double figures since March 4, 1966, a 21-20 loss to Duke in the ACC Tournament in Raleigh.
- **NC STATE:** Freshman guard Shakeel Moore led the Wolfpack Saturday with 13 points and three steals. He scored all 13 of his points in the second half and finished the game shooting 5-of-8 from the field.
- **NOTRE DAME:** Senior forward Juwan Durham is averaging 13.4 points, 6.3 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game over the last seven games. In that stretch, he is shooting 70.7% from the field.
- **PITT:** Junior guard Xavier Johnson has recorded seven or more assists in seven of the past eight games and 10 times overall. He leads the ACC and ranks 12th nationally in assists (6.2 apg).
- **SYRACUSE:** In a balanced scoring effort in the Saturday victory over BC, the Orange had five players in double figures in scoring, led by Joseph Girard III with 16, all in the first half.
- **VIRGINIA:** With the Saturday win over UNC, Tony Bennett became just the third coach in ACC men's basketball history to lead his program to 10-straight winning conference seasons, joining Dean Smith and Mike Krzyzewski.
- **VIRGINIA TECH:** Junior forward Justyn Mutts had a strong all-around performance last Saturday in the overtime win at Miami with a season-high 22 points along with seven assists and nine rebounds.
- **WAKE FOREST:** Graduate forward Jonah Antonio had a big day Saturday with career highs in points (23) and 3-pointers (7). He was 7-of-8 from 3-point range and is the 12th player in program history to hit seven triples in a game.

ACC QUICK HITS

- Three ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll: Virginia (9), Florida State (17) and Virginia Tech (18). Louisville, North Carolina and Clemson are receiving votes.
- ACC home teams are 56-28 (66.7%) in conference play.
- The ACC has played 167 of 209 scheduled men's basketball games (79.9%).
- The Virginia Tech at North Carolina game on Tuesday has been postponed (positive test, subsequent quarantining, and contact tracing within the VT program).
- Jose Alvarado (GT), Justin Champagnie (Pitt) and Carlik Jones (UofL) were named to the Naismith Trophy's midseason list for Men's Player of the Year on Thursday.
- Florida State owns a 23-game ACC home win streak, tied for second longest in league history. The stretch dates to a Jan. 22, 2019 win over Clemson.

- UNC leads the nation in rebound margin (+10.8/game) and ranks second nationally in offensive rebounding (15.1) and fourth in total rebounding (42.5/game).
- Virginia ranks fourth nationally in scoring defense at 59.4 ppg. UVa also ranks in the top 10 nationally in fewest turnovers (3rd, 9.5.) 3-point percentage (4th, 39.9%) and free-throw percentage (5th, 80%).
- Syracuse is 10th nationally in steals per game (9.2), while Georgia Tech and NC State are tied for 13th (8.94).
- Pitt's Justin Champagnie stands third in the nation in rebounding (12.0/game) and 14th in double-doubles (9). NC State's Manny Bates ranks seventh nationally in blocks (3.0/game).
- Georgia Tech's Jose Alvarado is fourth nationally in steals per game (2.8/game), while Duke's Jordan Goldwire is eighth (2.5). Alvarado is on pace for the highest steals average by an ACC player since Maryland's Johnny Rhodes set a league record in 1996 with 3.7 per game.

• Notre Dame's Nate Lazewski is eighth nationally in field-goal percentage (64.6%), while UVA's Jay Huff is slightly behind in 10th at 62.7%.

• Virginia senior forward Sam Hauser was named the ACC Player of the Week Monday, while North Carolina guard Caleb Love notched ACC Freshman of the Week honors for the second time in three weeks.

• Hauser averaged 20.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg in wins over NC State and Pitt. He tallied a game-high 18 points and five rebounds in win over the Wolfpack and added a game-high 23 points and six rebounds in a victory against Pitt. He shot 13 of 20 from the field, 5-of-10 from 3-point range and 10 of 10 from the free throw line in the wins.

• Love averaged 17.0 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 4.0 apg in games against Clemson and Duke last week. He recorded a season-high 25 points and seven assists in UNC's win at Duke, becoming the first Tar Heel to ever score 25 points and have seven assists at Duke.

• Wabissa Bede (VT), Nysier Brooks (Miami) and Garrison Brooks (UNC) were selected as candidates for the 2021 Senior CLASS Award. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

• Pitt's Justin Champagnie and Louisville's Carlik Jones were named to the Wooden Award Late-Season Top 20 Watch List last week.

• The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

• The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

• A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

• Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

• Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.

• Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.

• Eleven of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

• Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.

• Eight ACC players were selected in the 2020 NBA Draft on Nov. 18. Three were picked in the first round: FSU's Patrick Williams (4th, Chicago) and Devin Vassell (11th, San Antonio) and UNC's Cole Anthony (15th, Orlando). The ACC has had at least one first-round selection in 32 consecutive years (1989-2020).

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE



The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.

- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness
