AROUND THE ACC

• **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Senior forward Steffon Mitchell recorded his third double-double of the season against Notre Dame with 12 points and 10 boards. It was the 17th double-double of his career, most of any active ACC player.

• **CLEMSON:** Senior forward Amir Simms currently leads the Tigers in points (13.3 ppg), rebounds (6.0 rpg) and assists (2.6) and is the only player in the ACC to currently lead his team in all three categories.

• **DUKE:** The Blue Devils finished with a season-high 27 assists on 34 made field goals Monday – their most in a game since 29 vs. Stetson (12/1/18) and tied for the second-most all-time by Duke in an ACC game (29 vs. Clemson, 1/29/89; 27 vs. Clemson, 1/7/01).

• **FLORIDA STATE:** Senior RaiQuan Gray continued his strong play Saturday by scoring 16 points, his eighth consecutive double-figure scoring output. He is averaging 16.4 ppg in that stretch.

• **GEORGIA TECH:** Tech captured its first road win in the ACC this season and did so in record fashion, posting the largest margin of victory in an ACC road game in program history, 27 points, eclipsing its 26-point win at Wake Forest on March 3, 2011.

• **LOUISVILLE:** Senior center Malik Williams made his season debut Saturday, scoring four points and grabbing three rebounds in 17 minutes of action. He missed the first 15 games due to an injury. The senior connected on 2-of-6 field goal attempts and was 0-of-2 from 3-point range.

• **MIAMI:** Senior guard Elijah Olaniyi paced Miami with 18 points and seven rebounds Saturday. He was 6-of-9 from the field. Olaniyi is averaging 15.8 ppg over the last five contests.

• **NORTH CAROLINA:** UNC's freshmen combined to score 71 points Saturday, setting a UNC record. The previous high was 58 vs. NC State on January 23. Day'Ron Sharpe led the rookies with 21 points and 11 rebounds.

• **NC STATE:** The Wolfpack has won three consecutive ACC road games for the first time since the last two road games of the 2002-03 season and first road game of the 2003-04 campaign. The last time NC State had won three straight ACC road games in the same season was the 2001-02 season.

• **NOTRE DAME:** ND is the only team in the nation with two players shooting over 60% from the field with at least 125 field goal attempts this season – junior Nate Laszewski (64.8%) and senior Jwan Durham (60.3%).

• **PITT:** Sophomore forward Justin Champagnie finished with 21 points and 10 rebounds Saturday for his ACC-leading 11th double-double. He recorded his seventh 20/10 game, sixth most in a season at Pitt.

• **SYRACUSE:** Junior guard Buddy Boeheim led the Orange with 21 points Monday, his second-consecutive 20-point performance. He is averaging 19.8 ppg over his last four games.

• **VIRGINIA:** Senior forward Jay Huff scored 20 points and pulled down a career-high 12 rebounds Saturday for his second double-double of the season. He also blocked two shots.

• **VIRGINIA TECH:** Prior to the Hokies' time off, junior forward Keve Aluma averaged 22.3 ppg and 9.5 rpg over the previous four games, going 30-for-54 (55.6%) from the field and 23-of-25 (92%) from the free-throw line.

• **WAKE FOREST:** Graduate guard Ian DuBose recorded 14 points Saturday, his fourth straight game in double figures since his return from illness. He is averaging 14.8 ppg since returning to the court.

ACC QUICK HITS

• Three ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll: Florida State (11), Virginia (15) and Virginia Tech (16). Clemson and North Carolina are receiving votes.

• ACC home teams are 63-33 (65.6%) in conference play.

• The ACC has played 180 of 223 scheduled men's basketball games (80.7%).

• Nine ACC teams rank among the top 60 in the Tuesday NET rankings – second most of any conference.

• Virginia tops all ACC teams in the NET at No. 9 and is followed by Florida State (12), North Carolina (33), Virginia Tech (36), Clemson (39), Duke (47), Georgia Tech (49), Louisville (53) and Syracuse (54).

• Duke sophomore forward Matthew Hurt was named the ACC Player of the Week. He averaged 22.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg in wins over Wake Forest and then-No. 7 Virginia last week. He was 16-of-22 (72.7%) from the field and 8-of-12 (66.7%) from 3-point range.

• UNC guard Kerwin Walton was tabbed ACC Freshman of the Week. He averaged 16.5 ppg last week, going 12-of-20 from the field, including 8-of-14 from 3-point range in wins over Northeastern and Louisville. He matched his season-high with 14 points versus Northeastern, then topped it with 19 against UofL.

• Florida State's Leonard Hamilton and Virginia Tech's Mike Young were named to the Naismith Men's College Coach of the Year Late Season Watch List on Friday. They are two of 15 coaches on the list.

• Florida State owns a 24-game ACC home win streak, second longest in league history. The stretch dates to a Jan. 22, 2019 win over Clemson.

• UNC leads the nation in rebound margin (+11.0/game) and ranks second nationally in offensive rebounding (15.1) and third in total rebounding (42.9/game).

• Virginia (40%) and Florida State (39.4%) rank fifth and 11th, respectively, in 3-point field goal percentage nationally.

- UVA also ranks seventh nationally in scoring defense at 60.3 ppg.
- Notre Dame (11.8), Virginia (12.8) and Miami (12.8) rank 1-2-3 nationally in fewest fouls per game.
- Syracuse is 10th nationally in steals per game (9.2), while Georgia Tech is 13th (9.0) and NC State 15th (8.9).
- Pitt's Justin Champagnie stands sixth in the nation in rebounding (11.4/game) and seventh in double-doubles (11). NC State's Manny Bates ranks eighth nationally in blocks (2.9/game).
- Georgia Tech's Jose Alvarado is third nationally in steals per game (2.8/game), while Duke's Jordan Goldwire is ninth (2.6).
- Notre Dame's Nate Laszewski is eighth nationally in field-goal percentage (64.8%), while UVA's Jay Huff is 12th at 61.3%.
- Jose Alvarado (GT), Justin Champagnie (Pitt) and Carl Jones (UofL) were named to the Naismith Trophy's midseason list for Men's Player of the Year. Champagnie and Jones also were named to the Wooden Award Late-Season Top 20 Watch List.
- Wabissa Bede (VT), Nysier Brooks (Miami) and Garrison Brooks (UNC) were selected as candidates for the 2021 Senior CLASS Award. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.
- The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.
- The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.
- A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.
- Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.
- Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.
- Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.
- Ten of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.
- Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.
- Eight ACC players were selected in the 2020 NBA Draft on Nov. 18. Three were picked in the first round: FSU's Patrick Williams (4th, Chicago) and Devin Vassell (11th, San Antonio) and UNC's Cole Anthony (15th, Orlando). The ACC has had at least one first-round selection in 32 consecutive years (1989-2020).

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE



The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.

- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness
