AROUND THE ACC

- **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Senior forward Steffon Mitchell recorded 16 points and 13 rebounds against Notre Dame. It was his second double-double of the season and the 16th of his career (most among active ACC players).
- **CLEMSON:** After scoring 19 points Saturday, senior Aamir Simms is 13 shy of 1,000 for his career and on pace to become the fourth player in school history to amass 1,000 points, 550 rebounds, 75 steals and 75 blocks (Trevor Booker, 2006-10; Horace Grant, 1983-87; Larry Nance, 1977-81).
- **DUKE:** Senior guard Jordan Goldwire, who leads the ACC in assist/turnover ratio this season (+3.13), has posted a +6.0 ratio over the last seven games with 30 assists against just five turnovers.
- **FLORIDA STATE:** Junior guard RaiQuan Gray matched a career high with 19 points Saturday. It marked his fifth straight game in double figures (15.2 ppg in that stretch). He scored 17 of his 19 points in the second half.
- **GEORGIA TECH:** Senior forward Moses Wright put up a monster game Monday at Louisville with 15 points, 16 rebounds and a career-high seven blocked shots.
- **LOUISVILLE:** David Johnson (24 pts, 10 rebs) and Samuel Williamson (20 pts, 18 rebs) on Monday became the first pair of Louisville teammates with 20 points and 10 rebounds in the same game since Montrezl Harrell and Terry Rozier did it on Feb. 11, 2015, against Pitt.
- **MIAMI:** Sophomore guard Isaiah Wong is fifth in the ACC in scoring (17.4), seventh in minutes (35.7), eighth in free-throw percentage (77.0) and 12th in field-goal percentage (43.6).
- **NORTH CAROLINA:** UNC shot 52.5% from the floor on Tuesday. It was the second time this season and second time in as many games that UNC shot 50%. UNC is 216-9 under Roy Williams when it shoots 50% from the floor.
- **NC STATE:** Sophomore center Manny Bates recorded his second career double-double and first this season with 17 points and a career-high 14 rebounds Sunday. He also swatted four shots and has an ACC-best 41 blocks this year.
- **NOTRE DAME:** The Fighting Irish had one of its best shooting displays of the season Saturday, shooting 56.1% (32-of-57) from the field and a season-high 54.2% (13-of-24) from 3-point range.
- **PITT:** Sophomore forward Justin Champagnie recorded his ACC-leading seventh double-double (19 pts, 11 rebs) of the season Saturday. He is one of three players nationally averaging better than 20 points and 10 rebounds per game and ranks fifth in the NCAA in rebounding (12.1 rpg).
- **SYRACUSE:** Sophomore forward Quincy Guerrier recorded his seventh double-double of the season on Sunday to match Champagnie for the conference lead. He scored 10 points and racked up 10 rebounds.
- **VIRGINIA:** The Cavaliers had their 15-game ACC win streak snapped Saturday. The streak, which matched a school record from the 2017-18 seasons, dated to an eight-game stretch to conclude the 2020 regular season.
- **VIRGINIA TECH:** Junior forward Keve Aluma scored a career-high 29 points and pulled down 10 rebounds Saturday. It marked his second straight double-double, as he had 14 points and 12 boards Wednesday at Notre Dame.
- **WAKE FOREST:** Junior guard Davien Williamson recorded a team-high 16 points Saturday as he continued his solid play in the ACC. He is averaging 17.3 ppg over the last seven ACC games.

ACC QUICK HITS

- Three ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll: Virginia (14), Virginia Tech (16) and Florida State (20). Louisville, North Carolina and Georgia Tech are receiving votes.
- After Louisville's Monday afternoon home victory, ACC home teams are 45-19 (70.3%) in conference play. That is on pace to be the highest win percentage for ACC home teams in a season since 2003 (53-19, 73.6%).
- The ACC has played 148 of 182 scheduled men's basketball games (81.3%).
- The ACC announced that Florida State will play at Pitt on Saturday, Feb. 6 in a rescheduled game (from Jan. 9). Tip time is 2 p.m. on RSN.
- North Carolina leads the nation in rebounding (43.1/game), rebound margin (+11.3/game) and offensive rebounding (15.7).
- Virginia ranks eighth nationally in scoring defense at 59.9 ppg. UVa also ranks in the top 10 nationally in fewest turnovers (2nd, 8.6), free-throw percentage (3rd, 80.4%) and assist/turnover ratio (6th, 1.7).
- Georgia Tech ranks eighth nationally in steals per game (9.5). NC State is 11th at 9.2.
- Virginia Tech junior forward Keve Aluma was named the ACC Player of the Week Monday, while Duke forward Jalen Johnson earned ACC Freshman of the Week honors.
- Aluma averaged 21.5 ppg, 11.0 rpg, 2.0 apg and 2.0 bpg in two Hokies' wins while recording back-to-back double-doubles. He shot 15-of-25 (60%) from the field and 11-of-12 (91.7%) from the free-throw line in those games.
- Johnson averaged 13.5 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 3.5 apg and 2.5 spg in home victories over Georgia Tech (75-68) and Clemson (79-53). He shot 10-of-18 (.556) from the field and 7-of-10 (.700) at the free-throw line.

• Florida State owns a 22-game ACC home win streak, tied for second longest in league history. The stretch dates to a Jan. 22, 2019 win over Clemson.

• Five ACC players were named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt (Duke) and Carlík Jones (UL). The ACC's total is second only to the Big Ten (6).

• The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

• The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

• A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

• Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

• Brooks was named the ACC's Preseason Player of the Year, while Florida State's Scottie Barnes was tabbed the ACC Freshman of the Year.

• Following a vote of the league's media, Virginia was chosen as the preseason favorite to capture the 2021 ACC Championship. This is just the second time UVA was picked in the preseason to win the title (1982). Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville rounded out the ACC's preseason top five.

• Eight ACC players are on the watch list for the 2021 Naismith Trophy, tied for the most of any conference: Scottie Barnes (FSU), Garrison Brooks and Caleb Love (UNC), Sam Hauser (UVA), Matthew Hurt, Jalen Johnson and Wendell Moore (Duke) and David Johnson (Louisville).

• Eleven of the current ACC men's basketball head coaches have 300 or more career wins.

• For the second straight year, ACC teams will play 20-game conference schedules. As part of this schedule, each team plays six opponents twice as well as eight teams once apiece (four home only/four road only).

• Eight ACC men's basketball teams earned higher than the Division I basketball GSR average, tying for the most among Power 5 conferences. Clemson, Duke, Miami, Virginia and Wake Forest posted GSR scores of 100. The five ACC men's basketball teams with perfect scores also match the most of any Power 5 conference.

• Eight ACC players were selected in the 2020 NBA Draft on Nov. 18. Three were picked in the first round: FSU's Patrick Williams (4th, Chicago) and Devin Vassell (11th, San Antonio) and UNC's Cole Anthony (15th, Orlando). The ACC has had at least one first-round selection in 32 consecutive years (1989-2020).

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE

The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.



- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness
