NOTING ACC BASEBALL

- With Miami taking two of three on the road at top-ranked Florida and six teams going a combined 16-0 against their opponents, ACC teams captured each of the 13 non-conference series in which they competed opening weekend. ACC teams emerged with a combined 30-7 record (.818), including a 21-4 mark at home.

- ACC teams were 141-48 (.746) versus non-conference opponents in the abbreviated 2020 season, including a 102-19 mark at home.

- Miami recorded its first series win over Florida since taking two-of-three in 2014 and its first series victory in Gainesville since sweeping the Gators in 2009. The Hurricanes moved up in every national poll and leapt from No. 6 to No. 1 in this week's Collegiate Baseball rankings. Miami's series win came in the inaugural series of the new Florida Ballpark in Gainesville.

- This week's Baseball America poll features four ACC teams among the top 10 – No. 2 Virginia, No. 3 Miami, No. 5 Louisville and No. 9 Florida State. Duke checks in at No. 11. Nine ACC teams are ranked among then nation's top 25 this week in at least one major poll.

- The midweek slate features nine more non-conference games before ACC play will begins with six conference series this weekend. Each ACC team is scheduled to play 12 three-game conference series this season for a total of 36 league games – two more series and six more ACC games than in recent years.

- At least one opening ACC series is slated to start earlier than planned. Due to forecasted inclement weather in the Chapel Hill area this weekend, North Carolina's three game set against No. 2 Virginia originally scheduled to begin Friday (Feb. 26) will now start on Thursday (Feb. 25) and is scheduled to run through Saturday.

- Non-conference action this weekend features Clemson's annual series vs. rival South Carolina at three different sites (Clemson on Friday, Greenville on Saturday and Columbia on Sunday).

- The 2021 ACC Baseball Championship is scheduled for May 25-30 at a site to be determined and announced in the near future. The 15-game tournament will again include 12 teams and feature a pool play format, leading into a four-team, single-elimination bracket to determine the league champion.

Outfielders **Christian Del Castillo of Miami** and **Cameron Masterman of Louisville** have been named the first Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Co-Players of the Week of the 2021 season, while **North Carolina right-hander Austin Love** was named the ACC Pitcher of the Week.

ACC baseball weekly honors are determined by a vote of a select media panel and announced on Mondays throughout the regular season.

Del Castillo made a huge impact in Miami's season-opening series win at then No. 1 Florida, as the Hurricanes took two of three from the Gators to take over the top spot in this week's Collegiate Baseball rankings. The older brother of Hurricanes' preseason All-American Adrian Del Castillo, Christian Del Castillo hit .333 for the weekend and drove in six runs in the three-game road series in Gainesville. The left-handed hitting transfer from Seton Hall helped the Hurricanes earn a series win over the Gators for the first time since 2014. The series victory was also Miami's first in Gainesville since 2009.

Louisville's Masterman put up big offensive numbers to lead the second-ranked Cardinals to a three-game sweep of visiting Bellarmine. Masterman, a junior from Prospect, Kentucky, went 6-for-11 (.545) at the plate while hitting a home run in all three games of the series. He ended the weekend as the ACC's early leader in home runs (3) and total bases (15). He is tied for the lead in hits (6) and ranks second in RBI (6).

North Carolina's Love made his first career start on the mound in Friday's opener versus visiting James Madison and held the Dukes hitless before he departed after working six full innings. Love, a sophomore from Salisbury, North Carolina, struck out a career-high tying nine batters while walking two, helping the Tar Heels present Scott Forbes with an 8-1 win in his head coaching debut.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.718) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.709).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,283) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,115), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
