## AROUND THE ACC

• **BOSTON COLLEGE:** BC named Earl Grant its new head coach on March 15. Grant spent the previous six seasons as head coach at College of Charleston.

• **CLEMSON:** Senior forward Aamir Simms led the team in points, rebounds, assists and blocks for the second straight year. Last year he was the first player in Clemson history to accomplish that feat.

• **DUKE:** Freshman Mark Williams recorded a career-high 23 points and 19 rebounds in the ACC quarters. The 19 rebounds were the most by a freshman in the ACC Tournament, surpassing 18 by Virginia's Ralph Sampson vs. Clemson in the 1980 quarters.

• **FLORIDA STATE:** FSU is one of three teams that has advanced to the Sweet 16 of each of the last three NCAA Tournaments. The Seminoles are joined by Gonzaga and Michigan as the three teams who have advanced at least as far as the Sweet 16 in 2018, 2019 and 2021).

• **GEORGIA TECH:** Tech's 34 wins over the past two seasons are the most for the program over two seasons since 2009-10 and 2010-11 (36). The Yellow Jackets' 17-9 record marked their highest winning percentage for a season since the 2004 Final Four team (28-10).

• **LOUISVILLE:** Graduate guard Carlik Jones is the only player in the ACC to rank among the top six in scoring (16.8 ppg, 6th), assists (4.5 apg, 4th), assists/turnovers ratio (2.18, 4th) and free throw percentage (.815, 3rd).

• **MIAMI:** Sophomore guard Isaiah Wong (+9.4 ppg in 2020-21) posted the second-highest scoring increase of any player in the ACC over the past three seasons (Louisville's Jordan Nwora, +11.3 in 2018-19).

• **NORTH CAROLINA:** With their appearance this season, the Tar Heels rank second in NCAA Tournament history in appearances (51), games (174), wins (126) and winning percentage (.724).

• **NC STATE:** Senior guard Braxton Beverly scored his 1,000th career point during the Syracuse game. Beverly and Engin Atsur (2004-07) are the only players in NC State history to score 1,000 career points, pass out 300 career assists, hit 200 3-pointers and record over 100 career steals.

• **NOTRE DAME:** Junior guard Prentiss Hubb ranks 10th nationally in total assists (152) and 14th in assists per game (5.8).

• **PITT:** Sophomore forward Justin Champagnie leads the ACC with 14 double-doubles, including eight games with 20 or more points and 10 or more rebounds. He is the only major conference player averaging a double-double this season.

• **SYRACUSE:** Junior guard Buddy Boeheim is averaging 26.0 ppg this month, the most of any player in the country. He is shooting 49% (32-of-66) from 3-point range in that span.

• **VIRGINIA:** Graduate guard Sam Hauser finished his career with 1,682 points (400 in one season at Virginia). He reached double figures in scoring in 23 of 25 games this season.

• **VIRGINIA TECH:** For the first time in program history, the Hokies made their fourth straight visit to the NCAA Tournament. It was their 12th appearance in the NCAA Tournament, including the first under Mike Young.

• **WAKE FOREST:** Junior guard Daivien Williamson led the Demon Deacons in scoring, minutes per game, assists and steals. He was the only player on the team averaging 32 or more minutes and 12 or more points per game.

## ACC QUICK HITS

• Syracuse and Florida State have reached the Sweet 16 in the NCAA Tournament. At least one ACC team has advanced to the Sweet 16 in 41 straight NCAA Tournaments, which is by far the longest in the history of the NCAA Tournament. No other conference has a streak longer than 22.

• In the modern era (since 1985) nearly half of the ACC teams which earned NCAA Tournament bids have reached the Sweet 16 (97 of 199).

• Florida State is playing in its third straight Sweet 16 for the first time in program history.

• Seven ACC teams earned NCAA Tournament bids. This marks the seventh time – and the fifth straight tournament – the ACC has placed at least seven teams in the NCAA Tournament field (nine in 2017 and 2018, seven in 2007, 2009, 2016, 2019, 2021).

• The ACC is the winningest conference in NCAA Tournament history with a 65.1% winning percentage and is the only conference that has not had a losing record in NCAA Tournament play since 1987.

• Teams currently in the ACC have combined to win 17 NCAA Championships, including three of the last five (Duke 2015, North Carolina 2017, Virginia 2019).

• Georgia Tech defeated Florida State, 80-75, in the ACC Championship game, claiming its fourth ACC Tournament championship and its first since 1993.

• Georgia Tech junior guard Michael Devoe earned the ACC Tournament's Everett Case Award (Most Valuable Player) after averaging 16.5 ppg, 5.0 apg and 2.0 spg in the tournament.

• Nine ACC teams ranked among the top 60 in the final NET rankings – second most of any conference.

• Virginia led all ACC teams in the NET at No. 12 and is followed by Florida State (25), North Carolina (32), Georgia Tech (34), Syracuse (40), Clemson (41), Virginia Tech (48), Duke (49) and Louisville (56).

• Three ACC teams were ranked nationally in the final Associated Press Top 25 poll: Florida State (14), Virginia (15) and Virginia Tech (25). Clemson and Georgia Tech received votes.

• Virginia won its fifth ACC regular-season championship in the last eight years and was the No. 1 seed in the ACC Tournament for the sixth time.

- Georgia Tech forward Moses Wright was named the ACC Player of the Year, becoming just the second Yellow Jacket to win the award (Dennis Scott, 1990).

- Florida State guard Scottie Barnes was named ACC Freshman and Sixth Man of the Year. Barnes is just the second player in FSU history to be named the ACC Freshman of the Year joining Bob Sura (1992).

- Virginia Tech head coach Mike Young earned ACC Coach of the Year. He now has eight conference Coach of the Year honors in his career, with seven in the So-Con (four from coaches' vote, three from media vote).

- Georgia Tech's Jose Alvarado ranks second nationally in steals per game (2.85/game), while Duke's Jordan Goldwire is 14th (2.25).

- Alvarado recorded the highest steals average by an ACC player since Maryland's Johnny Rhodes set the ACC record average of 3.7 in 1996.

- With 226 career steals, Alvarado ranks 20th in ACC history. Alvarado's career average of 2.13 steals per game is tied for 16th best in the ACC annals.

- Pitt's Justin Champagnie stands eighth in the nation in rebounding (11.1/game) and seventh in double-doubles (14).

- NC State's Manny Bates ranks 10th nationally in blocks (2.7/game).

- UNC leads the nation in offensive rebounding (15.8), is second rebound margin (+10.4/game) and third in total rebounding (42.9/game).

- UVa ranks sixth nationally in scoring defense at 60.5 ppg, while Clemson is 12th (61.9).

- Georgia Tech stands eighth nationally in steals at 9.1 per game and ninth in turnover margin (+4.6).

- Miami (12.3), Notre Dame (12.8) and Virginia (12.9) rank 1-2-3 nationally in fewest fouls per game.

- The ACC played 206 of 251 scheduled men's basketball games (82.1%) in the regular season.

- After winning 17 of the last 21 games, ACC home teams finished 80-41 (65.8%) in conference play.

- Florida State concluded its home slate with a 25-game ACC home win streak, second longest in league history. The stretch dates to a Jan. 22, 2019 win over Clemson.

- North Carolina head coach Roy Williams won his 900th career game on Feb. 27. Fourth in all-time wins, he won his 900th game in fewer games (1,161) and seasons (33) than any coach in college basketball history.

- Wabissa Bede (VT), Nysier Brooks (Miami) and Garrison Brooks (UNC) were selected as candidates for the 2021 Senior CLASS Award. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

- The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

- A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

## NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

### All-Time Success

- Entering postseason play, current league members have won 24,796 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.

- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

### NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.

- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).

- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.

- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

### Elite Coaches

- The ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,188 career victories and 10 national championships.

- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1).

- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.

- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

### Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 of the last 61 seasons.

### All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 22.6 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 230).

### ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.

- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.

- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

### ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 12 of the 57 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Jerami Grant (Syracuse), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee, Jayson Tatum and Zion Williamson (Duke).

### COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE



The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.

- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness

## ACC DOMINANCE OVER THE LAST FIVE TOURNAMENTS

- The ACC was 74-35 (.679) in NCAA Tournament play over the previous five tournaments (2015-19). The 74 wins are 24 more than any other conference.
- Over this five-year span, ACC teams were 68-29 (.701) against non-conference opposition, while league teams met head-to-head six times.

## ACC IS SWEET 16 FRIENDLY

- In the modern era (since 1985) nearly half of the ACC teams which earned NCAA Tournament bids have reached the Sweet 16 (97 of 199).
- Over the last six tournaments, 23 of 45 (.511) ACC NCAA tourney teams have reached the Sweet 16, including an NCAA league-record six in 2016 and five in 2019.
- With five ACC teams reaching the Sweet 16 in 2019, it marked the fourth time in the last five tournaments that at least four ACC teams advanced to the NCAA regional semifinals.

## ACC'S NCAA CHAMPIONS

- Teams currently in the ACC have combined to win 17 NCAA Championships.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles, followed by Duke with five, Louisville two, NC State two, Syracuse one and Virginia one.
- The 2019 Cavaliers were the 46th team to represent the ACC in the NCAA Final Four. The ACC has had at least one Final Four team in 31 of the last 43 tournaments.

## ACC TEAMS AMONG NCAA TOURNAMENT WIN LEADERS

- North Carolina ranks second all-time in NCAA Tournament history with 126 wins.
- Duke (114), Syracuse (70) and Louisville (61) rank third, sixth and 10th respectively.
