AROUND THE ACC

• **BOSTON COLLEGE:** Sophomore guard Jay Heath poured in a career-high 28 points Wednesday at FSU. He hit eight 3-pointers, one off the school single-game record. It tied for the most by an ACC player this season (Ismael Massoud, Wake Forest, 1/23 vs. Pitt).

• **CLEMSON:** Senior forward Aamir Simms leads the team in points, rebounds, assists and blocks and is on pace to lead the team in those four categories for the second straight year. Last year he was the first player in Clemson history to accomplish that feat.

• **DUKE:** Freshman center Mark Williams scored a career-high 20 points Tuesday on 9-of-9 shooting from the field in a career-high 25 minutes. Over the last three games, he is averaging 15.3 ppg and shooting 78.6% from the field (22-of-28).

• **FLORIDA STATE:** Junior forward RaiQuan Gray scored in double figures for the 11th straight game Wednesday with 16 points (7-7 FG). In ACC play he leads the team in scoring (13.5 ppg), rebounding (6.8 rpg) and steals (1.4 spg).

• **GEORGIA TECH:** Moses Wright is averaging 18.0 ppg, 8.3 rpg, 2.3 apg and 1.7 bpg this season. Since 1992, the only other ACC player to record such a line in a season is Tim Duncan.

• **LOUISVILLE:** Graduate guard Carlik Jones equaled his career best with 25 points on 9-of-18 shooting from the floor Saturday. It is the fifth time he has scored 20 or more points this season.

• **MIAMI:** Sophomore guard Isaiah Wong is on pace to become just the 10th ACC underclassman in the last 20 years to average at least 17.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg and 2.0 apg. He would be the eighth from that group to also average at least 1.0 steal per contest.

• **NORTH CAROLINA:** UNC outrebounded Syracuse, 53-33, Monday, including a 26-13 advantage on the offensive boards that led to 25 second-chance points for the Tar Heels. For the second game in a row UNC had more offensive rebounds than its opponent had defensive.

• **NC STATE:** The Wolfpack wrapped up the regular season with five consecutive ACC wins, the first five-game ACC win streak for the Pack since the 2003-04 season. NC State also has won five straight ACC road games, the most consecutive road wins for the program since the 1973-74 season.

• **NOTRE DAME:** Junior guard Prentiss Hubb scored a team-high 14 points Wednesday and leads the team in scoring (14.3 ppg) this season. He also owns an ACC-best 140 assists (6.1 per game).

• **PITT:** Sophomore forward Justin Champagnie posted 20 points and 13 rebounds Tuesday for his ACC-leading 13th double-double and eighth 20/10 game. He added two assists and two blocked shots.

• **SYRACUSE:** Junior guard Alan Griffin posted a double-double Wednesday with 22 points and 10 boards. In ACC play, he is averaging 15.6 ppg and 6.5 rpg, both second on the team.

• **VIRGINIA:** Senior forward Sam Hauser scored a team-high 18 points Monday in the Cavaliers' home finale. He now has reached double figures in 20 games this season.

• **VIRGINIA TECH:** The Hokies' 38-point win last Saturday marked the largest margin of victory in an ACC game for Tech, topping the previous high of 29 points (Wake Forest; Jan. 15, 2011).

• **WAKE FOREST:** Junior guard Daivien Williamson leads the Demon Deacons in scoring, minutes per game, assists and steals. He is the only player on the team averaging 32 or more minutes and 12 or more points per game.

ACC QUICK HITS

• Three ACC teams are ranked nationally in the latest Associated Press Top 25 poll: Florida State (11), Virginia (21) and Virginia Tech (22). Clemson, North Carolina and Louisville are receiving votes.

• Nine ACC teams rank among the top 60 in the latest NET rankings – second most of any conference.

• Florida State leads all ACC teams in the NET at No. 13 and is followed by Virginia (21), Clemson (36), Georgia Tech (38), North Carolina (44), Virginia Tech (46), Louisville (50), Syracuse (51) and Duke (58).

• After winning 13 of the last 15 games, ACC home teams are 76-39 (66.1%) in conference play.

• The ACC has played 200 of 244 scheduled men's basketball games (82%).

• The 2021 New York Life ACC Tournament begins Tuesday, March 9, at Greensboro Coliseum and runs through Saturday, March 13.

• Seeding in the ACC Tournament will be based on conference winning percentage. Heading into the final weekend of regular-season play, Florida State, Virginia and Virginia Tech have locked up double byes.

• Virginia Tech's Saturday game at NC State has been canceled following quarantining and a contract tracing review within the Virginia Tech program.

• Florida State concluded its home slate with a 25-game ACC home win streak, second longest in league history. The stretch dates to a Jan. 22, 2019 win over Clemson.

• Georgia Tech senior forward Moses Wright was named the ACC Player of the Week. He averaged 28.5 ppg and 13 rpg and recorded double-doubles in wins against No. 16 Virginia Tech, 69-53, on the road and Syracuse, 84-77, at home.

• North Carolina center Walker Kessler and Louisville forward Jae'Lyn Withers shared ACC Freshman of the Week laurels.

- Kessler averaged 15.0 ppg and 6.0 rpg last week in games against Marquette and No. 11 Florida State. UNC is the first program to ever have five players pick up ACC Freshman of the Week honors in the same season.

- Withers averaged 14.0 points and 11.0 rebounds in wins over Notre Dame and Duke. He was 11-of-21 and shot 52.4% from the field in the two wins.

- Georgia Tech's Jose Alvarado is fourth nationally in steals per game (2.8/game), while Duke's Jordan Goldwire is 16th (2.3).

- Alvarado (2.82 steals per game) is on pace for the highest steals average by an ACC player since Tim Pickett in 2003 (2.827 per game).

- Pitt's Justin Champagnie stands seventh in the nation in rebounding (11.5/game) and sixth in double-doubles (13). NC State's Manny Bates ranks fifth nationally in blocks (2.95/game).

- UNC leads the nation in offensive rebounding (15.7) and ranks second nationally in rebound margin (+10.8/game) and third in total rebounding (43.0/game).

- Virginia (39.2%) and Florida State (38.7%) rank seventh and 14th, respectively, in 3-point field goal percentage nationally.

- UVa ranks fifth nationally in scoring defense at 60.2 ppg, while Clemson is 11th (61.6).

- Notre Dame (12.4), Miami (12.4) and Virginia (12.9) rank 1-2-3 nationally in fewest fouls per game.

- Syracuse is eighth nationally in steals per game (9.3), while Georgia Tech is 12th (9.0) and NC State 17th (8.7).

- Virginia senior forward Sam Hauser was named one of five national finalists for the 2021 Julius Erving Award (top small forward).

- Florida State's Leonard Hamilton and Virginia Tech's Mike Young were named to the Naismith Men's College Coach of the Year Late Season Watch List. They are two of 15 coaches on the list.

- North Carolina head coach Roy Williams won his 900th career game on Feb. 27. Fourth in all-time wins, he won his 900th game in fewer games (1,161) and seasons (33) than any coach in college basketball history.

- Wabissa Bede (VT), Nysier Brooks (Miami) and Garrison Brooks (UNC) were selected as candidates for the 2021 Senior CLASS Award. The award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

- The ACC announced that the 2020 ACC Tournament will be played in Greensboro, N.C., moving from Washington, D.C., because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2024 tournament now will be played in Washington, D.C.

- The ACC led all conferences with 84 alumni on opening day NBA rosters. Duke led ACC schools with 26 alumni on opening day rosters, while UNC had 12. Florida State and Virginia each had eight.

- A pair of former ACC players were named to the 2021 Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame Class on Nov. 29: Antawn Jamison (UNC) and Len Bias (Maryland). Bias was the 1985 and 1986 ACC Player of the Year, while Jamison was the 1998 ACC Player of the Year.

- Garrison Brooks (UNC), Kihei Clark (Virginia), Jose Alvarado (GT) and Aamir Simms (Clemson) are the lone returning members of the 2020 All-ACC Team. Brooks was a second-team pick, while Clark, Alvarado and Simms were third-team honorees.

NOTING ACC MEN'S BASKETBALL

All-Time Success

- Entering the regular season, current league members had won 24,600 games and have had 796 NBA Draft picks, including 282 first-round selections.
- All 15 league members have 1,000 or more all-time wins, including eight schools with 1,500 or more victories.

NCAA Tournament Success

- With Virginia's title in 2019, the ACC has won three of the last five NCAA National Championships, eight of the last 19 crowns, and 17 overall.
- North Carolina leads the way with six national titles. Duke is next with five, followed by Louisville (2), NC State (2), Syracuse (1) and Virginia (1).
- The ACC has combined to win a record 74 NCAA Tournament games the last five years, eclipsing the previous mark of 65 set by the ACC from 1989-93 and 2014-18.
- Over the last five tournaments, 36 ACC teams made an NCAA tournament appearance, the most of any conference. During that time, the ACC had eight No. 1 seeds, twice as many as the next-closest conference (Big East).

Elite Coaches

- Entering the 2020-21 season, the ACC's 15 head coaches combined for 7,151 career victories and 10 national championships.
- Four current league coaches have won national titles – Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (5), North Carolina's Roy Williams (3), Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (1) and Virginia's Tony Bennett (1)
- The ACC features three active coaches that are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame – Krzyzewski, Williams and Jim Boeheim. That is the most of any conference.
- Four ACC coaches currently have more than 650 career wins, also the most of any conference – Krzyzewski, Boeheim, Williams and Miami's Jim Larrañaga.

Top of the Polls

- The ACC has had at least one team ranked in the top 10 of the final AP poll for 60 consecutive seasons.

All-Americans

- Since 1981, the ACC has produced 52 consensus All-Americans – more than any other conference – and has accounted for 24 percent of the nation's consensus All-Americans (52 of 215).

ACC and the NBA

- During the 2019-20 season, 88 players from ACC schools earned spots on NBA rosters, most of any conference.
- Over the past 12 years, 125 ACC players have made their NBA debuts, including an all-time high 19 during the 2019-20 season.
- The ACC is the only conference to have had at least three first-round picks in each of the past 12 NBA Drafts.

ACC and the U.S. Olympic Team

- 10 of the 44 finalists for the 2020 U.S. Olympic Men's Basketball Team are alumni of ACC programs: Harrison Barnes (UNC), Malcolm Brogdon and Joe Harris (UVA), Montrezl Harrell and Donovan Mitchell (Louisville), Chris Paul (Wake Forest) and Brandon Ingram, Kyrie Irving, Mason Plumlee and Jayson Tatum (Duke).

COMMITTEE FOR RACIAL & SOCIAL JUSTICE



The ACC's Committee for Racial and Social Justice (CORE - Champions of Racial Equity) announced three initiatives in conjunction with its member institutions on Sept. 3.

- Mandatory diversity and inclusion training for student-athletes, athletic department and conference staff
- Creation of ACC Unity Symbol as a visual representation of solidarity among the ACC's 15 institutions
- ACC Unity Statement to be read prior to every league contest

Student-athletes, athletic department and conference office staff will be required to attend annual diversity and inclusion training. The initiative was unanimously approved by the conference athletic directors. The focus of this year's training will be anti-racism.

The ACC's unity symbol – "UNITE" – will be displayed in venues and on video boards throughout the league, as well as at ACC Championship events and on social media.

CORE also has introduced a Unity Statement, which will be read at all ACC events: "We, the ACC, are committed to seeing each other as equals, supporting each other, and treating each other with respect and dignity at all times, recognizing that our differences don't divide us, but they make us stronger."

CORE's work is ongoing and guided by its mission statement, which is "to promote and encourage racial equity and social justice through education, partnerships, engagement and advocacy."

Among CORE's actions to date: the ACC Office's recognition of Juneteenth as a holiday; working with its institutions to increase voter education and vote, with some ACC schools serving as polling places; engaging in conversations and education throughout the conference with staff and student-athletes and initiating partnerships with local organizations and community groups; empowering students and student-athletes to engage with fans around the topic of social justice to minimize misunderstandings.

CORE's central values and goals:

- Create meaningful, lasting change by improving systems, organizational structures, policies, practices and attitudes
- Have representation at all levels that is reflective of the make-up of the student-athlete population
- Inclusion and empowerment of diverse individuals
- Accountability for hiring practices
- Integrity
- Fairness
