NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• With eight teams ranked among the nation's top 25 by at least one major poll, the ACC is set for a midweek schedule that includes Florida State welcoming fifth-ranked rival Florida for a 7 p.m. game Tuesday night. The game will broadcast on the ACC Network, with Jason Benetti and Kyle Peterson on the call.

• Florida State won last season's game in Gainesville 2-0 behind a dominant pitching performance from Antonio Velez and Parker Messick. Both players set career-highs at the time with seven strikeouts. The win snapped an 11-game losing streak for FSU in the series and was the first time that Mike Martin, Jr. faced the Gators as head coach. At the time, Florida was No. 1 in the country and the last remaining undefeated team in the nation. The season was canceled due to COVID-19 three days later.

• Another Tuesday game is set for coverage on ACC Network as Wake Forest welcomes Charlotte at 4 p.m. The game open a four-game homestand for the Demon Deacons, who have an ACC series versus visiting Georgia Tech on tap for this weekend. Georgia Tech is also set for a midweek telecast on ACC Network when the Yellow Jackets play host to Georgia Southern on Wednesday at 6 p.m.

• Each of the ACC's 14 teams have been ranked nationally in multiple national polls at some point during the current baseball season. That includes Pitt, which is among the top-25 nationally for the first time since May 13, 2013 with selections in the polls by DIBaseball.com (No. 18) and Baseball America (No. 19). The rankings are the first since joining the ACC for the 2014 season.

• Notre Dame continues to win move up in the rankings following last weekend's three-game road sweep of Virginia and is now preparing to play host to Duke this weekend in what will be the first home games for the Fighting Irish since May of 2019. Notre Dame has found the road to its liking under head coach Link Jarrett, compiling an 18-4 cumulative record in a little over one season under his watch. The Irish will carry a five-game winning streak into the Duke series.

North Carolina junior third baseman **Clemente Inclan** has been selected the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week for March 15, while Miami freshman right-hander **Alejandro Rosario** earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

ACC Baseball Players and Pitchers of the Week are chosen by a vote of a select media panel and announced on Mondays throughout the regular season.

Inclan became the first Tar Heel to homer in four straight games since Michael Busch accomplished the feat April 12-16, 2019, leading UNC to a 3-1 week that included a three-game ACC weekend sweep of Clemson. The Jacksonville, Florida, native hit .364 with eight RBIs in the four games and scored six runs to help the Tar Heels grab a share of first place in the still-early ACC Coastal Division standings.

Miami's Rosario dominated over seven shutout innings, leading the No. 5 Hurricanes to a 10-0 victory over visiting Wake Forest. The freshman earned his second win on the Mark Light Field mound, allowing just one hit while tying his career high with seven strikeouts. A Miami native, Rosario improved to 2-0 on the season, while lowering his ERA to 1.96.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.717) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.706).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,290) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,117), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
