NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• The ACC's midweek non-conference slate features 11 games, including a Tuesday evening ACC Network meeting between ranked in-state rivals when North Carolina plays host to East Carolina at 6 p.m. The Tar Heels hold the No. 11 spot in the latest Baseball America poll, while ECU is up to No. 8. ACC Network plans to be in Tallahassee on Wednesday night at 6 p.m. as Florida State -- ranked as high as No. 15 following last week's 4-0 showing versus Florida and Miami -- plays host to UCF.

• Louisville, alone atop the Atlantic Division following last weekend's road sweep of NC State, is ranked as high as No. 6 this week and is one of eight ACC teams that appears in at least one national poll. Florida State leapt back into every national ranking after four wins versus top-10 in-state opponents. Following last Tuesday's 10-2 win over visiting Florida, the Seminoles totaled 34 runs while allowing just two against Miami in three road games in Coral Gables. ACC Player of the Week Robby Martin finished the week hitting .550 with three home runs, three doubles and 12 RBI in the four games.

• Each of the ACC's 14 teams have been ranked nationally in multiple national polls at some point during the 2021 baseball season. The list includes Pitt and Notre Dame, which were both picked for last-place finishes in their divisions in preseason but are currently consensus top 25 teams. Pitt remains the only ACC team that has yet to play a home game, but that is scheduled to change on Wednesday, when the Panthers are set to play host to Bucknell in a 3 p.m. contest at Cost Field.

• Henry Davis has been the most consistent hitter for Louisville through 19 games, picking up at least one hit in every game so far. With a hit in all three games during last weekend's ACC series at NC State, Davis is now tied for the second-longest hitting streak in program history at 21 games. The sophomore is currently hitting .412 and ranks second in the ACC with 28 hits and third with 23 RBI. The catcher also ranks second in the conference with eight stolen bases after having just one through his first two seasons at Louisville.

Florida State sophomore rightfielder **Robby Martin** has been selected ACC Baseball Player of the Week, while Louisville junior left-hander **Michael Kirian** earned ACC Pitcher of the Week honors.

ACC baseball weekly awards are determined by a vote of a select media panel and announced on Mondays throughout the regular season.

Martin hit .550 and slugged 1.150 for the week with three home runs, three doubles and 12 RBI as Florida State swept four games versus top-10 in-state rivals Florida and Miami. In addition to going 11-for-20 at the plate, Martin scored nine runs.

Martin homered twice and drove in five runs in last Tuesday night's win over the fifth-ranked Gators. In the Seminoles' ACC series road sweep at Miami, the Tampa, Florida, native was 8-for-15 with three doubles and a home run as FSU outscored the Hurricanes by a combined 34-2 in the three games.

Louisville's Kirian took a no-hitter into the eighth inning of Friday night's 13-1 win at NC State, finishing with one run allowed on two hits in 7.1 innings with a career-best 13 strikeouts.

Kirian, of New Riegel, Ohio, retired the first 11 batters he faced and did not allow an extra-base hit, as he remained unbeaten on the mound this season with his fourth victory.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.717) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.705).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,292) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,117), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
