NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• The ACC prepares for a busy Tuesday non-conference slate following a weekend in which three teams posted series sweeps on the road to create mild shake-ups in the division standings. While Clemson took three straight at Boston College, Virginia Tech swept its three-game series at Pitt to take over second place in the Coastal Division. NC State won three in a row on the road versus rival North Carolina, marking the Wolfpack's first three-game series sweep in Chapel Hill since April 23-25, 1992.

• Tuesday's schedule finds Clemson – winner of five consecutive games and seven of its last eight – playing host to No. 23 Georgia at 6 p.m. on ACC Network. The game will be the 237th between the teams in a series that was first played in 1900. Georgia owns a 126-108-2 all-time series lead, but the Tigers are 57-51-2 at home versus the Bulldogs. Clemson enters tonight's game having scored at least one run in 144 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak nationally behind Eastern Kentucky (198).

• Other Tuesday action involving ACC teams includes No. 20 North Carolina's road trip to No. 11 East Carolina. The Tar Heels hope to rebound from the series sweep by NC State by defeating the Pirates for the second time in a week. UNC defeated ECU 8-1 when the teams met in Chapel Hill on March 23.

• With the Easter holiday approaching, three ACC series are scheduled to be played Thursday through Saturday this week – Notre Dame at Pitt, Boston College at Virginia Tech, and Virginia at Georgia Tech.

• After splitting two games at Notre Dame last weekend (the third game of the series was rained out), Louisville owns 119 conference wins since joining the ACC in 2015, the most conference wins during that time of any Power Five school.

• Louisville, ranked as high as No. 5 this week, is again one of eight ACC teams that appears in at least one national poll. The Cardinals are a consensus top-10 team this week, and Georgia Tech is ranked among the top 10 in four of the six major polls (as high as No. 6 by D1Baseball). Each of the ACC's 14 teams have been ranked nationally in multiple national polls at some point during the 2021 baseball season. No. 11 Notre Dame leads nine ACC teams currently listed among the top 50 of the latest NCAA RPI.

Clemson first baseman **Caden Grice** has been recognized as the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week, while Georgia Tech right-hander **Andy Archer** earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

Grice led the Tigers to a 4-0 record last week – all wins away from home – that included a three-game ACC road sweep at Boston College. The Greer, South Carolina, freshman was 9-for-18 (.500) with three doubles, one triple, one homer, 13 RBIs, five runs, a .944 slugging percentage and .571 on-base percentage in the four wins.

Following a three-run homer in Tuesday's win over Georgia Southern, Grice went 8-for-14 (.571) with three doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs and four runs in the Boston College series. In the first game, he went 4-for-6 with seven RBIs. In the second game, he totaled three RBIs. In the series finale, he went 3-for-5. For the season, Grice is hitting .343 with six homers, one triple, four doubles, 25 RBIs, 18 runs, a .701 slugging percentage and .451 on-base percentage in 20 games.

Georgia Tech's Archer delivered a career-best performance on the mound in a 3-0 shutout at Duke on Saturday that clinched the Yellow Jackets' 14th series win in their last 15 (since 2019). The Duluth, Georgia, junior worked a career-long 8.0 innings on 109 pitches, surrendering just six hits and two walks.

Archer, who fanned a career-high-tying nine hitters, faced just one full count. He struck out four straight during one stretch and retired eight straight during another while winning his fourth-straight decision. Archer has now gone 18 consecutive innings without allowing a run.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.717) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.703).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,294) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,121), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
