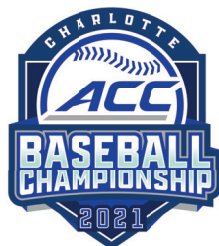
NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• Six ACC weekend series are on tap Friday through Sunday, five of which involve at least one ranked team. Included is a three-game set in Atlanta between Louisville (ranked No. 1 by Perfect Game) and Georgia Tech (ranked No. 10). Two teams that made their entries into the nation's Top 25 just this week will square off in Blacksburg, as North Carolina travels to face Virginia Tech. Louisville and Clemson (versus Notre Dame) will be seeing their first conference action of the season.

• No. 18 Boston College will visit No. 25 Auburn for a three-game non-conference series at Plainsman Park. The Eagles' ACC series at Wake Forest was postponed due to the Demon Deacons' program being paused following recent Covid-19 tests results. The Tigers hosted BC for a three-game series in 2004, with the Eagles claiming game two of the set. Auburn leads the all-time series, 3-1, following a 10-inning decision in 2010.

• With the entry of Boston College, North Carolina, Pitt and Virginia Tech into several national polls this week, each of the 14 Atlantic Coast Conference baseball teams has already been ranked nationally in preseason and/or during the opening two weeks of the 2021 season. Nine ACC teams appear this week in at least one of the six major polls, led by Louisville's No. 1 ranking by Perfect Game. Georgia Tech, Miami and Virginia are also ranked among the nation's top 10 by at least one publication.

•The ACC and the Charlotte Knights announced Feb. 25 that the 2021 ACC Baseball Championship will be held at Truist Field in Charlotte, North Carolina, May 25-30.

Georgia Tech freshman catcher **Kevin Parada** has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week, while Pitt's **Mitch Myers** earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

ACC baseball weekly honors are determined a vote of a media panel and are announced on Monday throughout the regular season.

Parada went a blistering 10-for-16 at the plate to lead Georgia Tech to a 4-0 week, including a three-game road sweep of No. 8 NC State in the opening ACC series for both teams. Parada began the week 8-for-8 at the plate. Of his 10 hits, five were for extra bases (two doubles, one triple and two home runs), and he fell one hit shy of the cycle versus the Wolfpack in his first career ACC game.

A native of Pasadena, California, Parada also drew three walks, slugged 1.250 and registered a .684 on-base percentage in the Yellow Jackets' four wins. Through six games of 2021, Parada leads all ACC freshmen and is second overall in hitting (.524), is second overall in RBI (10), slugging (1.048) and on-base percentage (.615).

Pitt's **Myers** struck out a career-high 13 batters in six shutout innings while yielding just two hits and two walks as the Panthers blanked No. 9 Florida State, 1-0, in the teams' ACC opener Friday night in Tallahassee.

Neither of the two hits Myers allowed went for extra-bases as the Lanette, Alabama, junior registered his first career ACC win and keyed the visiting Panthers (6-1, 3-0) to their initial victory in what wound up being a weekend sweep of the Seminoles.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.717) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.709).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,287) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,116), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
