NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• Georgia Tech holds a narrow lead in the early Coastal Division standings following last weekend's impressive series win over then-No. 1 Louisville. After falling to the Cardinals 13-6 in Friday night's opener, the Yellow Jackets stormed back to score a total of 32 runs while winning the next two games. Georgia Tech has captured 12 consecutive ACC series dating back to March of 2019, and the 5-1 start in conference play by Coach Danny Hall's squad this season is the program's best since 2011.

• By winning two of three at Clemson, Notre Dame captured its third consecutive ACC series and has taken six of the last eight series versus conference opposition dating back to 2019. Pollsters have taken notice, with Notre Dame entering at No. 25 this week in both the USA Today Coaches and D1Baseball rankings.

• Virginia Tech – ranked nationally for the first time since 2013 – responded by winning its first-ever series win over North Carolina. The Hokies now rank as high as No. 12 (Baseball America) after winning series against both UNC and Miami in the early going.

• Boston College's hastily arranged road trip to No. 25 Auburn produced an epic finale as the Eagles scored eight runs with two outs in the bottom of the ninth to tie Sunday's game at 9-9, then pushed across a pair of runs in the 10th for a series-clinching 11-9 win. ACC Player of the Week Sal Frelick's three-run homer capped the tying rally in the ninth for Eagles, who are among the nation's top 20 in four of this week's major polls.

• Each of the 14 ACC baseball teams has already been ranked nationally at some point the opening three weeks of the 2021 season. Eight ACC teams appear this week in at least one of the six major polls, led by Miami's No. 5 ranking by Baseball America. Georgia Tech and Louisville are also ranked among the nation's top 10 by at least one publication.

• Nine ACC teams are scheduled to host a combined 11 games versus non-conference opponents in midweek action Tuesday and Wednesday.

Boston College junior outfielder Sal Frelick has been voted the ACC Baseball Player of the Week, and Florida State freshman left-hander Parker Messick received the nod as ACC Pitcher of the Week for March 8.

Frelick hit a team-best .500 (5-for-10) in the No. 18 Eagles' road series win at No. 25 Auburn. His weekend included a three-run, game-tying home run that capped an epic comeback as Boston College rallied from eight runs down with two outs in the ninth to tie the score and then win 11-9 in extra innings.

For the Auburn series, he totaled a 2.005 OPS with three home runs and five RBI, including a pair of home runs in Friday night's 8-2 win in the series opener. Frelick was 3-for-4 in an earlier win over Rhode Island and wound up batting .571 for the week with five extra-base hits, six runs scored, seven RBI and a 1.375 slugging percentage.

Florida State's Messick pitched a career-high 8.0 innings Friday and struck out a career-high 11 batters as FSU beat No. 16 Virginia, 2-0, at Dick Howser Stadium.

Messick's 11 strikeouts were the most for a Seminole since CJ Van Eyk struck out 11 in during the 2019 ACC Baseball Championship against NC State. His 8.0 innings pitched were the most for an FSU hurler since Drew Parish pitched the same number in the College World Series against Arkansas later in the 2019 season.

Messick, who allowed three hits and did not issue a walk, registered perfect innings with four total strikeouts over the seventh and eighth frames. The Plant City, Florida, native threw 114 pitches on the night.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.716) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.708).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,289) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,117), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
