NOTING ACC BASEBALL

- This weekend's slate of ACC series includes Florida State's road trip to rival Miami. ACC Network will be on hand for the first two games of on Friday and Saturday, with first pitch set for 7 p.m. each night. The fifth-ranked Hurricanes carry a six-game winning streak into the series. Florida State has won two straight and five of the last seven, including Tuesday night's 10-2 win over Florida.

- Robby Martin homered twice and drove in five runs to lead the Seminoles against the visiting Gators, who entered the contest ranked as high as fifth nationally. FSU's 10 runs scored in Tuesday night's game are its most against Florida since 2010, and it was the largest margin of victory for FSU in the series since 2008, also a 10-2 win ... The Seminoles win over Florida highlighted a 7-3 mid-week for ACC teams versus non-conference opposition

- Each of the ACC's 14 teams have been ranked nationally in multiple national polls at some point during the 2021 baseball season. That list includes Pitt and Notre Dame, which were both picked for last-place finishes in the ACC Coaches' Preseason Poll but are currently listed among the nation's best heading into the ACC's fourth weekend of conference competition.

- Pitt is among the nation's top 25 for the first time since May 13, 2013 with selections in the polls by DIBaseball.com (No. 18) and Baseball America (No. 19). The rankings are the first for the Panthers since joining the ACC for the 2014 season.

- Notre Dame continues to move up in the rankings following a three-game road sweep of Virginia and is now preparing to play host to Duke this weekend in what will be the first home games for the Fighting Irish since May of 2019. Notre Dame has found the road to its liking under head coach Link Jarrett, compiling an 18-4 cumulative record in a little over one season under his watch. The Irish will carry a five-game winning streak into the Duke series.

- Miami (as high as No. 5) and Louisville (as high as No. 7) continue to lead ACC ranked teams. In addition to the Miami, Louisville, Notre Dame and Pitt, other league teams ranked nationally include Boston College, Georgia Tech, North Carolina and Virginia Tech.

North Carolina junior third baseman **Clemente Inclan** has been selected the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week for March 15, while Miami freshman right-hander **Alejandro Rosario** earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

ACC Baseball Players and Pitchers of the Week are chosen by a vote of a select media panel and announced on Mondays throughout the regular season.

Inclan became the first Tar Heel to homer in four straight games since Michael Busch accomplished the feat April 12-16, 2019, leading UNC to a 3-1 week that included a three-game ACC weekend sweep of Clemson. The Jacksonville, Florida, native hit .364 with eight RBIs in the four games and scored six runs to help the Tar Heels grab a share of first place in the still-early ACC Coastal Division standings.

Miami's Rosario dominated over seven shutout innings, leading the No. 5 Hurricanes to a 10-0 victory over visiting Wake Forest. The freshman earned his second win on the Mark Light Field mound, allowing just one hit while tying his career high with seven strikeouts. A Miami native, Rosario improved to 2-0 on the season, while lowering his ERA to 1.96.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.716) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.707).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,290) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,117), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
