NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• The midway point of the ACC regular season finds tight races in both divisions. Louisville continues to lead the Atlantic Division by percentage points over second-place Notre Dame, while a half-game separates Virginia Tech, Georgia Tech and Miami in the Coastal Division. With three wins over Duke, Miami was the only team to sweep an Easter weekend series and carries the conference's longest current active winning streak (five games) into Wednesday night's home game versus FIU.

• Non-conference rivalries are a big part of Tuesday's 10-game slate for ACC teams with Pitt playing host to West Virginia, Louisville welcoming Kentucky (6 p.m., ACCN) and North Carolina facing South Carolina at Charlotte's Truist Field, the site of this year's ACC Baseball Championship. Crosstown matchups include Boston College at Northeastern and NC Central at Duke.

• Louisville, ranked as high as No. 5 this week, is one of seven ACC teams that appears in at least one national poll. The Cardinals are again a consensus top-10 team this week. Each of the ACC's 14 teams have been ranked nationally in multiple national polls at some point during the 2021 baseball season. No. 12 Notre Dame leads six ACC teams currently listed among the top 45 of the latest NCAA RPI.

• With Monday's series-clinching 11-5 win at Pitt, Notre Dame won its fifth straight conference series on the road dating back to the 2020 season. It is the first time since the 2001-02 seasons the Irish have won five consecutive conference road series. The Irish hit four home runs in Monday's game, marking the squad's first four-homer game since 2018 (versus Western Michigan).

• All-session ticket books and weekend passes for the 2021 Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Championship, scheduled for May 25-30 at Truist Field in Charlotte, North Carolina, are now on sale. Ticket books for the full tournament are available for \$225 on the club level and \$170 for field box seats, which includes tickets to all 15 tournament games, including the championship game on Sunday. Weekend passes are also available for \$70 on the club level and \$50 for field box seats, which includes tickets to Saturday's semifinal games and Sunday's championship game. Single-session tickets, if available, will go on sale at a later date. Packages are now available by visiting CharlotteKnights.com or by calling the Knights Ticket Office at 704-274-8282. In order to accommodate physical distancing requirements per local and state guidelines, tickets will be sold in groups of at least two, with additional grouping options available for larger parties.

Miami catcher **Adrian Del Castillo** has been recognized as the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week, while NC State left-hander **Chris Villaman** earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

ACC baseball weekly honors are determined by a vote of a select media panel and are announced on Mondays throughout the regular season.

Del Castillo batted .471 (8-for-17) with three doubles, seven RBI and six runs scored to lead Miami to a 4-0 week that included an ACC series sweep of Duke. Del Castillo was 2-for-4 with three runs scored and a career-high four RBI in Miami's 21-2 rout of FIU, and he keyed Miami's series-clinching win over the Blue Devils on Saturday with a 3-for-5 effort that included a pair of RBI and two runs scored. He went 2-for-4 and drove in another run in Sunday's win.

NC State's Villaman tossed his first career complete game while allowing just one hit in Tuesday's 3-0 road win at UNC Greensboro. The High Point, North Carolina, freshman allowed just four batters to reach base and tallied a career-best nine strikeouts. Villaman became the first Wolfpack pitcher since Feb. 15, 1997 (Brett Black at Charleston Southern) to throw a one-hit, complete game shutout and the first NC State hurler to throw a complete game shutout of any kind since March 30, 2019 (Reid Johnston vs. Virginia).

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.716) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.703).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,295) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,123), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
