NOTING ACC BASEBALL

- Louisville, ranked as high as No. 5, is one of seven ACC teams that appears in at least one national poll. The Cardinals are again a consensus top-10 team this week. Florida State, Georgia Tech, Miami, Notre Dame, Pitt and Virginia Tech are each ranked among the nation's top 25 in at least one of the six major college baseball national rankings.
- As it prepares to welcome No. 17 Florida State this weekend, Louisville owns 121 conference wins since joining the ACC in 2015, the most conference wins during that time of any Power Five school. The Cardinals have won 42 of their 56 ACC series (two series ended 1-1) since joining the league. Louisville has won 21 of its 27 ACC series at home (one ended 1-1) since debuting in the conference.
- Other ACC matchups this weekend involving at least one ranked team include Miami at Pitt, Georgia Tech at Notre Dame, and Virginia Tech at Wake Forest.
- ACCN will be on hand to televise the second game of the Virginia-Clemson series on Saturday, as well as NC State's road game at Boston College on Friday, Friday's FSU-Louisville series opener, and the final two games of the Duke-UNC rivalry series on Saturday and Sunday. ESPN2 plans coverage of Sunday afternoon's Virginia-Clemson series finale at 1 p.m., while Florida State at Louisville at 4 p.m. is slated to be carried live by ESPNU.
- Six of the 30 NCAA baseball student-athletes selected as candidates for the 2021 Senior CLASS Award hail from the ACC, tied for the most of any conference. Georgia Tech's Austin Wilhite, Louisville's Luke Smith, Miami's Alex Toral and Ben Wanger, and Notre Dame's Daniel Jung and Christian Scaford were selected as candidates. Miami and Notre Dame were two of just three schools to have more than one player recognized. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.
- The ACC boasts the NCBWA National Hitter of the Week for the third week in a row as Miami sophomore catcher Adrian Del Castillo was recognized on Tuesday. Del Castillo's selection follows that of Florida State sophomore Robby Martin on March 22 and Clemson freshman Caden Grice last week. Del Castillo batted .471 (8-for-17) with three doubles, seven RBI and six runs scored to lead Miami to a 4-0 week that included an ACC series sweep of Duke. Adrian Del Castillo (April 5) and Christian Del Castillo (Feb. 22) are the first brothers to be named ACC Baseball Players of the Week during the same season.

Miami catcher **Adrian Del Castillo** has been recognized as the Atlantic Coast Conference Baseball Player of the Week, while NC State left-hander **Chris Villaman** earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

ACC baseball weekly honors are determined by a vote of a select media panel and are announced on Mondays throughout the regular season.

Del Castillo batted .471 (8-for-17) with three doubles, seven RBI and six runs scored to lead Miami to a 4-0 week that included an ACC series sweep of Duke. Del Castillo was 2-for-4 with three runs scored and a career-high four RBI in Miami's 21-2 rout of FIU, and he keyed Miami's series-clinching win over the Blue Devils on Saturday with a 3-for-5 effort that included a pair of RBI and two runs scored. He went 2-for-4 and drove in another run in Sunday's win.

NC State's Villaman tossed his first career complete game while allowing just one hit in Tuesday's 3-0 road win at UNC Greensboro. The High Point, North Carolina, freshman allowed just four batters to reach base and tallied a career-best nine strikeouts. Villaman became the first Wolfpack pitcher since Feb. 15, 1997 (Brett Black at Charleston Southern) to throw a one-hit, complete game shutout and the first NC State hurler to throw a complete game shutout of any kind since March 30, 2019 (Reid Johnston vs. Virginia).

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.715) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.704).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,295) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,124), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
