## NOTING ACC BASEBALL

• A full slate of ACC weekend action includes a matchup of two of the conference's hottest teams in South Bend, Indiana, as NC State travels to face No. 7 Notre Dame. After a slow start to the 2021 season, the visiting Wolfpack has won six consecutive games, 10 of its last 12, and is 8-0 in road games this season. Notre Dame has won six conference series, the most by any ACC team so far this season. The Irish are the only ACC team to not drop a conference series in 2021. With its 14-6 record in ACC games, Notre Dame is off to its best start in conference play since joining the league in 2014.

• The NC State-Notre Dame series will also pit family members on opposite sides with starting Wolfpack outfielder J.T. Jarrett matched against his father, second-year Irish head coach Link Jarrett. The three-game set will also showcase the nation's two best fielding teams, with Notre Dame's .988 fielding percentage just a shade above NC State's current .986 mark.

• Other weekend series include No. 12 Virginia Tech playing host to No. 21 Georgia Tech. The Hokies currently hold a two-game lead over the Yellow Jackets and Pitt in the Coastal Division standings. Clemson travels to Miami, where Friday night's and Sunday afternoon's games are both set to be televised by ACC Network. Boston College heads South to Florida State, Wake Forest plays at Duke, No. 2 Louisville is at Virginia and North Carolina visits No. 17 Pitt.

• Louisville, ranked as high as No. 2 (Baseball America) and No. 4 (Perfect Game) remains a consensus Top 10 team and leads six ACC teams that are ranked nationally in at least one of the six major polls.

• Seven ACC teams are represented on the midseason watch list for the Golden Spikes Award, which is given annually to the nation's top amateur player. Boston College outfielder Sal Frelick, Clemson first baseman/pitcher Caden Grice, Florida State pitcher Parker Messick, Georgia Tech catcher Kevin Parada, Louisville catcher Henry Davis, Miami catcher Adrian Del Castillo and Notre Dame first baseman Niko Kavadas were among those on the 45-man list announced Wednesday by USA Baseball. The Golden Spikes Award Advisory Board will continue to maintain a rolling list of athletes, allowing players to play themselves into consideration for the award before announcing the semifinalists on June 8.

A pair of standout freshmen earned weekly honors, as Virginia Tech outfielder **Gavin Cross** has been recognized as the ACC Player of the Week, and NC State right-hander **Matt Willadsen** is the Pitcher of the Week.

Cross turned in a stellar week for the Hokies, as he hit .500 (10-for-20) with nine RBI, seven runs, three home runs, two doubles and a triple. In Tuesday's 15-5 win against ETSU, he hit for the cycle and went 4-for-6 with seven RBI. Cross had at least one hit in each game of the weekend series at Wake Forest, as Virginia Tech earned its second conference sweep of the year.

The Bristol, Tennessee, native was 3-for-5 on Friday and 2-for-5 on Saturday, hitting a home run in both games. Cross scored twice in Sunday's game and doubled to record an extra-base hit in all four games last week.

For the second consecutive week, the ACC Pitcher of the Week hails from NC State as Matt Willadsen threw a two-hit shutout to lift the Wolfpack to a 7-0 win to complete the series sweep against Boston College on Sunday. It also marks the second straight week that the honor has been awarded to a Pack freshman, as classmate Chris Villaman was recognized on April 5.

Hailing from Holly Springs, North Carolina, Willadsen logged his first career complete game, allowing just two hits with five strikeouts. He retired 15 consecutive batters spanning from the first through the sixth innings and did not allow an extra-base hit. Willadsen is the third NC State pitcher this season to go the distance on the mound, and the Wolfpack is the only ACC program to have more than one pitcher throw a complete game this season.

ACC BY THE NUMBERS

2 - The ACC boasts the two leading active NCAA D-1 coaches in terms of winning percentage -- Louisville's Dan McDonnell (.715) and Virginia's Brian O'Connor (.704).

3 - Three ACC teams rank in the top five nationally for most all-time NCAA tournament appearances: No. 2 Florida State (57), No. 3 Miami (46), and No. 5 Clemson (44).

6 - The Atlantic Coast Conference has placed at least six teams in each of the last 16 NCAA tournaments.

10 - At least two ACC baseball teams have earned national seeds in each of the last 10 NCAA tournaments.

14 - At least one ACC team has reached the College World Series in Omaha each of the previous 14 years in which it has been held, and multiple ACC teams reached the CWS nine times during that span.

26 - The ACC has placed a total of 26 teams in the past 14 College World Series, an average of just under two per season.

82 - Eighty-two (82) ACC teams have earned NCAA bids in the last 11 tournament years.

96 - The 14 current ACC teams have a combined 96 College World Series appearances.

1,100 (plus) - In Georgia Tech's Danny Hall (1,296) and NC State's Elliott Avent (1,128), the ACC claims the NCAA Division I's No. 4 and No. 7 active coaches in terms of total victories.
