NUMBERS OF NOTE

- 0 In her last 11 singles matches, Vic Allen has 0 losses (9 wins).
- 2 FSU was the No. 2 seed in the ACC tournament. That was the highest seed in the program's history.
- 2 This is the second trip for FSU women's tennis to the NCAA Quarterfinals in the last three NCAA Tournaments.
- 3 Giulia Pairone has been named first team all-conference in 3 Power Five conferences (ACC, Big10 & SEC)
- 4 The Seminoles recorded 4 wins over teams that were Top 16 seeds in the NCAA Tournament.
- 4 Vic Allen is currently 5th on the FSU all-time list for singles career win percentage. She is 32-13 for win a win percentage of 71.1.
- 6 Andrea Garcia and Nandini Das rank 6th all-time at FSU for wins by a doubles team. They are two away from moving into a tie for 5th.
- 7 Giulia Pairone and Petra Hule have now won 7 straight doubles matches.
- 8 FSU women's tennis is one eight programs to advance to the NCAA Quarterfinals in two of the last three NCAA Tournaments.
- 9 Both Petra Hule and Vic Allen come into the Quarterfinals with an 9 match win streak in singles.
- 21 FSU has been ranked in the top 10 of 21 straight ITA polls.
- 39 Andrea Garcia has 39 combined wins this season.
- 100 Andrea Garcia just won the 100th singles match of her career. She is just the 6th Seminole to ever record 100 singles wins.
- 200 Andrea Garcia is the all-time wins leader at FSU and the first to ever reach the 200 win mark.

Jennifer Hyde is in her 17th season at the helm of the Florida State program as FSU's winningest women's tennis coach. Hyde surpassed Anne Davis (1980-86) with her 142nd career win on March 22, 2014, against NC State.

Hyde has led the Seminoles to NCAA appearances in 13 of 17 seasons (no tournament in 2020), leading the program to its first-ever Elite 8 appearance in 2018 and then a second this year. With an exceptional list of accomplishments and milestones from her career at FSU, including an honor of ITA South Region Coach of the Year in both 2007 and 2011 and 2018 ITA Southeast Region Coach of the Year. Hyde has also coached two All-Americans and 10 ITA award winners. Hyde has cemented her place in program history.

This season the Seminoles have been ranked in the Top 10 of every ITA poll and FSU recorded its highest finish ever in ACC play. The Seminoles were 11-2 in conference and finished second. FSU has also advanced to the Elite 8 for the second time in the last three NCAA Tournaments after only advancing that far once before in program history.

Hyde, an FSU alumnae, posted an impressive career with the Seminoles establishing herself as a four-year letter winner, NCAA Tournament participant (1994) and ACC flight champion in doubles alongside teammate Jenny Graf. Hyde captained the 1994 Seminole squad whose No. 17 ranking previously stood for sixteen years as the highest year-end ranking until 2010's No. 14 finish. Hyde earned a Masters Degree from Florida State in Sport Management in 2011.

HISTORIC RUN

Under Head Coach Jennifer Hyde, the Seminoles are in the midst of an historic run of success especially over the last four seasons. In 2018, Hyde guided the Seminoles to the NCAA Quarterfinals for the first time in the history of the program. After an earlier than hoped exit in the second round of the 2019 NCAA Tournament, the Seminoles rose to No. 2 in the rankings in a COVID-shortened 2020 season. It was the highest ranking in the history of the program. This season, FSU has spent every week ranked in the Top 10 and posted a program-best ACC mark of 11-2. On top of that, Hyde has guided FSU into the NCAA Quarterfinals for the second time in the last three opportunities. Her Seminoles have now been ranked in the top 10 of 21 straight polls.

BATTLE TESTED

Playing women's tennis in the ACC means you will always enter the NCAA Tournament tested and ready to face the nation's best. In 2021, FSU has now played 17 matches versus NCAA Tournament teams. On top of facing North Carolina, Syracuse, Miami (twice), Duke, Georgia Tech, NC State, Virginia and Wake Forest in conference, FSU also faced Old Dominion, UCF, North Florida, Florida, Georgia, Auburn, Texas A&M and Alabama State. Florida State is 12-5 in matches against the NCAA field. Of those 17 matches, eight came against teams seeded in the Top 16 of the tournament and FSU posted a 5-3 mark in those matches. Of the 8 teams remaining in the tournament, FSU posted a 1-3 record with a win over NC State. The losses came to UNC, Georgia and Duke.

DEPTH HAS BEEN THE KEY TO SUCCESS

While FSU has had excellent play in the top three spots of the lineup, they have excelled on courts 4-6. When Petra Hule is on four, Vic Allen is on five and Andrea Garcia is on six, those three have posted a combined record of 33-2. Both Hule and Allen are undefeated in those spots. Hule has posted a 7-0 record on four and Allen a 10-0 record on five. Garcia, who has played on six most of the year, is 16-2 on that line.

CLINCH TIME

Of FSU's 19 wins this season, 18 of the clinching points have come at the hands of four players. Giulia Pairone and Petra Hule are tied with five. Hule has come through in the clutch especially as of late clinching a 4-3 win over No. 22 Miami and then clinching the victory over No. 19 Auburn to send FSU to the Round of 16 and over No. 10 Texas A&M to send FSU to the quarterfinals. Hule and Andrea Garcia are tied for the team lead in clinches versus ranked opponents with three. Garcia clinched wins over No. 12 GT, No. 47 Notre Dame and No. 50 Syracuse this season.

DOUBLES TURNING POINT

It took a little while and a few different combinations to find the right mix for FSU in doubles but the Seminoles have now hit on the right combination. Versus Boston College March 12, Vic Allen and Emmanuelle Salas paired together to move to court one and Giulia Pairone and Petra Hule teamed together on court three. Those two pairs surrounded Nandini Das and Andrea Garcia who were already solidified and are entering the Quarterfinals with an 18-4 mark. After dropping their match to BC, Allen and Salas have gone 7-2 and have risen to No. 30 in the ITA rankings. Hule and Pairone are now ranked 89th and have posted a 8-1 record over that same stretch, including seven straight wins. Since March 14, FSU's doubles lineup has been identical and the pairs have combined to post a 26-4 record and FSU has dropped just one doubles point in the last 11 matches.

QUEEN OF THE COURTS

On April 4, Andrea Garcia became the first FSU women's tennis player to ever reach the 200 win career milestone. The redshirt-senior is the all-time wins leader at FSU in doubles with 104 wins and she has now reached 100 singles wins in her career as well. She is the only player at FSU ever to reach 100 wins in singles and doubles and she is one of just three players in program history to be in the Top 6 for career wins in singles and doubles.

- Emmanuelle Salas:** Currently ranked 44th. Upset nation's No. 73 player in winning 1 of 3 points vs. UGA
- Nandini Das:** Tenth all-time at FSU with 85 career singles wins. Eighth all-time with 79 doubles wins.
- Petra Hule:** Posted the best record on the team in ACC singles play (9-1). Clinched 3 Top 25 wins (UM, AUB, TXAM)
- Vic Allen:** Undefeated on line five. Clinched the win over fellow Round of 16 opponent Virginia in a 3-3 match
- Andrea Garcia:** Leads the team in singles wins (20) and doubles wins (18). Clinched wins over 3 ranked teams
