KNIGHTS KNOWLEDGE

- **Gephry Pena** had himself an impressive week at the plate, posting a .444 average at the plate. He collected one extra base hit and drove in six RBI's. **Pena** also tallied three runs and was able to swipe seven bases to double his season total to 14. The 56 stolen bases sits just outside of the top-10 in program history, needing 12 to eclipse that milestone.

- **Will Saxton** had a career day on the mound Sunday afternoon, working four innings, striking out six and earning his first save of the season and his career. The lefty entered the game in the sixth and allowed one hit over those four innings. It was the first time since joining the **Knights** that **Saxton** had an outing without allowing a single walk.

- **UCF Baseball** and Florida State both had crazy weekends at home. After beating Miami on Wednesday, **UCF** hosted UNC Greensboro for a weekend series. The **Knights** and Spartans had their Friday game suspended in the fourth due to rain and lightning in the area. **UCF** started the resumption hot, before having the lead slowly dwindled away to drop the opening set. The Spartans would knock off **UCF** in the second game, to give the Knight their first loss after a win this season. FSU had their own fun this weekend, playing two games on Sunday to cap off a series with NC State. In game one, NC State blew the Noles out of the water, before the marathon began in game two. FSU and NCST would play 17 innings in game two, before Jaime Ferrer called game with a solo shot to right center field.

- The **Knights** will not leave the Sunshine State in the month of March, playing all 19 games in the state of Florida. **UCF** will only hit the road two more times, traveling to Tallahassee, Florida to face off against Florida State.

- Head Coach **Greg Lovelady** is chasing his 300th career win this season, posting a career record of 294-161. **Lovelady** has collected 170 wins at **UCF** and has won 35+ games in three of the four full seasons he has been in Orlando.

- **UCF Baseball** lost a key piece to their infield last week, as **Nick Romano** was lost for the foreseeable future due to a torn ACL. The first basemen had generated 11 RBIs, blasting three home runs and scoring 9 runs himself. He produced two doubles and a triple.

- **UCF** will put its perfect midweek record on the line on Tuesday and Wednesday as they travel to Tallahassee, Florida to take on the No. 7 Florida State. **UCF** saw it's perfect record after losses this season come to an end in game two of the modified weekend schedule.

- **UCF Baseball** holds an impressive streak in their program history, never being no-hit by an opponent in program history. The **Knights** currently have posted 2,770 straight games recording a hit.

- Every Saturday at home this season is **Citronaut Saturday** for **UCF Baseball**. So what is a **Citronaut**? We are glad you asked. The **Citronaut** was the first mascot of Florida Technological University (FTU), which later became the **University of Central Florida (UCF)**. The mascot appeared on the first student handbook in 1968-1969. After one year, the students petitioned the student government to establish a new mascot. In 1970, students approved "**Knights of the Pegasus**" as the second official university mascot, which remains to this day. The space themed uniforms and constellation named streets around campus remember the times when FTU was founded to provide personnel to support NASA at the Kennedy Space Center and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station.

- Florida State will go with right-hander Carson Montgomery on Tuesday evening in Tallahassee. Montgomery posts a 2-0 record on the mound, allowing 10 runs in his four outings. He has walked nine batters in his 18.2 innings, while recording 14 strikeouts.

PREVIOUS OUTING

- The **Knights** dropped their second straight series on Saturday, falling to UNCG in the conclusion of game one, before having their comeback bid fall short in game two. On Sunday, **UCF** salvaged the series with a huge 3-2 win behind four strong innings from **William Saxton**. **Gephry Pena** drove in two of the three runs for the **Knights** and later scored the eventual game winner, stealing second and third, scoring on an error in the third.

- **UCF Baseball** improved to 5-0 in midweek games, as well as 5-0 after a loss on Wednesday night in Orlando, defeating Miami 10-5 at **John Euliano Park**. The bats came alive, scoring 10 runs on eight hits, producing seven two-out RBIs in the fifth and sixth innings. **Michael Brooks** hit his first home run at home and second of the season, while **Josten** homered for the second time this season at home.

- The **Knights** stumbled this past weekend falling to 11-5 on the season, after dropping the weekend series against North Florida. **UCF** took the middle of three games behind an impressive performance by **Connor Staine** and only needed four runs to blank the Osprey.
