▶ NOTES

TAR HEEL HITTERS ON A TEAR

▶ Junior shortstop Danny Serretti is one of the Diamond Heels' hottest hitters. He has hit safely in 24 consecutive games, batting .483 (42x97) with two home runs and 18 RBIs during his streak. He collected 11 total hits in five games last week, batting .579. At the end of the Miami series on March 27, Serretti was hitting .296. In the 26 games that have followed, he has raised his batting average 70 points to .366. Serretti has also drawn 19 walks during his current streak.

▶ Sophomore Mac Horvath has hit safely in 11 of the last 13 games, batting .372 (19x51) with 18 runs scored and 12 RBIs during that time frame. Twelve of his 15 home runs this season have come in the last 25 games. At the end of March he was batting .189 and has raised his average 70 points the last 25 games, hitting .320 with an OPS of 1.214.

▶ Freshman Vance Honeycutt was inserted into the No. 4 spot in the lineup of the rubber games against NC State and has hit from that position in each of the last six games. During those three games as the cleanup hitter, he is 11-for-22 with four home runs, two doubles and a triple. He also drove in 10 runs, scored 10 and stole four bases.

▶ Sophomore designated hitter Alberto Osuna has driven in a run in 15 of the last 21 games and has 26 total RBIs in those games after collecting 17 RBIs in the first 29 games of the season.

▶ Since the start of the 2020 season, Angel Zarate has reached base safely in 111 of 119 games played. He has hit safely in 43 of 50 games this season with a team-high 24 multi-hit games.

UNC CLOSING REGULAR SEASON AGAINST FSU

▶ North Carolina will close out the regular season this weekend against No. 20 Florida State. The Seminoles have won each of the last two series against UNC, taking two of three in Tallahassee last season and two of three in Chapel in 2018. Carolina's last series victory was a 2017 sweep at Dick Howser Stadium.

▶ Carolina and FSU have each won their last two ACC series with the Heels taking two of three from NC State and Wake Forest, while the Noles captured series against Boston College and Miami.

▶ UNC had its midweek game against UNCW canceled due to travel difficulties for the Seahawks, while the Seminoles lost to Florida on Tuesday night in Gainesville.

▶ The Diamond Heels are 7-2 since the calendar flipped to May, while Florida State is 6-4 this month.

UNC TO HONOR COACH FOX

▶ North Carolina will honor its former head baseball coach Mike Fox prior to game two of the Florida State series on May 20. The ceremony will begin at approximately 5:30 p.m. and will include a video and a special presentation from Chancellor Kevin Guskiewicz and Director of Athletics Bubba Cunningham.

▶ A 1978 UNC graduate, Fox concluded his 37-year head coaching career with a 1,487-547-5 record, a winning percentage of .731. He is the winningest coach in Carolina Baseball history and led UNC to seven of its 11 CWS appearances. His Tar Heel teams went 948-406-1, won ACC championships.

SENIOR SERIES

▶ Seniors Gage Gillian, Clemente Inclan, Mikey Madej, Caden O'Brien and graduate Shaddon Peavyhouse are each playing their final series at Boshamer Stadium this weekend and will be recognized in a pregame ceremony on Saturday.

▶ Juniors Connor Ollio, Nik Pry, Will Sandy, Danny Serretti and Angel Zarate along with sophomore Davis Palermo, each earned their bachelor's degrees this spring and will also be recognized as part of the pregame ceremony.

HONEYCUTT NAMED ACC CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

▶ North Carolina freshman outfielder Vance Honeycutt has been named ACC Co-Player of the Week along Wake Forest designated hitter Jake Reinisch, league officials announced Monday.

▶ Honeycutt, a native of Salisbury, led UNC to a 4-1 week that included wins over Gardner-Webb and Charleston Southern and a 2-1 series win over Wake Forest to earn the first weekly accolade of his career.

▶ Honeycutt hit .474 (9-for-19) over the five-game stretch and homered in each of the first three contests. Five of his nine hits went for extra bases as he closed the week with seven RBI and six runs scored. He recorded career highs with four hits and three stolen bases versus Gardner-Webb; he has 15 total home runs and 27 stolen bases on the year.

LAST AT BAT WINS

▶ The Diamond Heels scored the game-winning run in their final at-bat in two of their last four wins. Tomas Frick hit a walk-off double against Charlotte in the 10th inning on May 3 and Mac Horvath lifted a sacrifice fly that plated the winning run in the top of the ninth against NC State on Saturday. Reece Holbrook was the base runner in both instances.

▶ In addition to its walk-off win over Charlotte, Carolina has two walk-off victories over Coastal Carolina and another over Pittsburgh.

HOME SCHOOLED

▶ The Diamond Heels went 19-1 at Boshamer Stadium against non-conference opponents this season. UNC won its first 14 games outside the ACC at home before sustaining the first blemish on its schedule. Carolina finished its home non-conference slate by winning its final five games (Campbell, Liberty, Charlotte, Gardner-Webb, Charleston Southern).

PALERMO ON STOPPERS WATCH LIST

▶ Sophomore right-hander Davis Palermo has been named to the NCBWA Stopper-of-the-Year Midseason Watch List. The midseason watch list features 62 of the sport's top relief pitchers. Relievers who are not on the midseason list still have an opportunity to be named a finalist for the award.

▶ Palermo ranks 16th in the nation in appearances with 28 and leads the Diamond Heels with a 2.24 ERA and is averaging 11.4 strikeouts per nine innings with a 3.1 strikeout-to-walk ratio. Opposing batters are hitting a mere .162 against him.

▶ He owns a 1-1 record this season with four saves. His 44.0 innings pitched are the most of any player on the team without a start and fifth-most overall. Palermo has the lowest WHIP (1.07) on the team and has allowed the fewest earned runs (11) of any Carolina pitcher with at least 10.0 innings pitched.

HEELS POWERING UP

▶ The Diamond Heels have hit 40 home runs in their last 25 games, including 20 of the last 22, during the months of April and May. Mac Horvath blasted 12 round trippers and Alberto Osuna circled the bases nine times.

▶ UNC has hit multiple home runs in 13 of the last 23 games, including four versus Georgia Tech on April 15 and three against North Carolina A&T (4/12), Gardner-Webb (5/10), and Charleston Southern (5/11).

▶ Carolina has recorded 99 extra base hits since the beginning of April, including 51 doubles and 40. Horvath leads the way with 18 extra base hits (9 doubles, 9 home runs) and Osuna has 15 (11 home runs, 4 doubles).

SPEED AND POWER

► The Tar Heels are one of five teams in the conference with 50 home runs and 50 stolen bases this season along with Louisville (78/86), Miami (68/50), Notre Dame (52/59), Virginia (65/62), and Virginia Tech (91/66). Carolina is tied for eighth in the conference with 71 homers and ranks fifth with 58 stolen bases.

► Freshman Vance Honeycutt is the only player in the country with 10 home runs and 20 stolen bases this season.

► Sophomore Mac Horvath and Honeycutt are two of four players in the ACC with 10 home runs and 10 stolen bases this season. Horvath and Honeycutt have hit 14 home runs each, while Honeycutt has stolen 27 bases and Horvath has swiped 17.

► Honeycutt has homered and stolen a base in a game six times this season, while Horvath has done it twice.

► Honeycutt is one of eight players in school history with a 10-20 season for a total of 11 times.

► Freshman Vance Honeycutt enters the weekend ranked second in the ACC with 27 stolen bases, which is second-most among NCAA Division I freshman behind Jacob Humphrey of UMass-Lowell (41).

► Honeycutt's 27 stolen bases are the most by a Tar Heel freshman since 2000 when Adam Greenberg stole 28 and Russ Adams swiped 20. He is currently alone in third place on the school's freshmen stolen base list.

HONEYCUTT & HORVATH HOMERS IN FOUR STRAIGHT

► Mac Horvath matched the program's record for most consecutive games with a home run during the Super Regional Era by homering in four straight games from April 10 - 16, stretching from the Louisville series finale through game two of the Georgia Tech series.

► One month later, freshman Vance Honeycutt duplicated the feat and became the first player in to homer in four consecutive games against four different teams.

OSUNA FLIPS THE POWER SWITCH AT LOUISVILLE

► Alberto Osuna went 8-for-16 with three home runs, two doubles and 10 RBIs during the Heels' three game series at Louisville. He slugged 1.188 and collected 19 total bases.

► Osuna hit two home runs in the series opener at Louisville and posted career-highs for hits (4) and RBIs (6); it was his second two homer game of the season (at Duke, 3/18).

► He became the first Tar Heel to have two homers and six RBIs in a game since Colin Moran against Wake Forest in 2013, while also becoming the first to collect four hits, two homers and six RBIs in a game since Seth Baldwin versus Princeton in 2009.

► Osuna drove in 10 runs during the Louisville series and became the first Tar Heel since Danny Serretti against Boston College in 2019 to have 10 RBIs in a series.

ZARATE'S ON BASE STREAK ENDS AT 50

► Junior outfielder Angel Zarate's consecutive games reaching base streak ended at 50 games on April 3 at home against Virginia Tech. It was the first time he didn't reach base since the streak

began on April 4, 2021. He reached safely in the final 23 games of the 2021 campaign and first 27 of this season.

► His previous longest streak was 39 games beginning with the final game of the 2019 campaign and ending March 23, 2021.

► Zarate is one of two Tar Heels in the Super Regional era, joining Dustin Ackley who reached safely 59 consecutive games during the 2009 season.

SHOWING OFF THE ARM

Junior outfielder Angel Zarate recorded his 12th outfield assist on the season against Charleston Southern. It's the most outfield assists by a Tar Heel since Sean Farrell had 10 during the 2001 season. Four of those assists have been thrown runners out at home plate.

WINNING AT HOME

► UNC is 26-6 at home this season and has outscored its opponents by 104 runs (234-110). Diamond Heel hurlers have 322 strikeouts in 290.0 innings at home with an ERA of 3.35.

► Carolina has won 29 of its last 35 games at The Bosh dating back to the final four home games of 2021.

► UNC won 21 consecutive games at home until Virginia Tech ended the streak on April 1. It was the program's most consecutive home wins since winning 26 straight between the end of the 2018 season (18) and start of the 2019 campaign (8).

BUSTER POSEY AWARD WATCH

Sophomore Tomas Frick was named to the Buster Posey Award is given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher. The watch list will be narrowed down to the semifinalists, whom will be announced May 19, 2022. Ballots will be sent to the national voting committee at the end of May for a vote to determine the three finalists. The finalists will be announced June 7, 2022. A final vote among the national committee will occur during the College World Series. All finalists will be brought to Wichita and the winner will be announced on June 29, 2022.

TAR HEELS PICKED FIFTH IN ACC COASTAL

The Tar Heels were picked fifth in the ACC's Coastal Division by the league's 14 coaches. Carolina finished third in the division last season and has won it seven times, most of any team in the division.
