## FOOTBALL

### FINAL: #14 NC STATE 19, FSU 17

» FSU ran for 206 yards against the Wolfpack. Entering Saturday, NC State was allowing just 94.4 rush yards per game, and the most rushing yards NC State had allowed in a game all season was 145 vs. No. 5 Clemson.

» Quarterback **Jordan Travis** passed for 181 yards and ran for a season-high 108 yards, his fifth career 100-yard rushing game. He broke a 71-yard run in the second quarter, followed on the next play by a 14-yard touchdown pass to **Mycah Pittman**. It was the second-longest run in Travis's career (88 vs. Pitt in 2020) and the longest for Florida State this season; it ties a Dalvin Cook run in the 2016 Orange Bowl for the sixth-longest non-touchdown run in school history.

» Travis completed a 37-yard pass to **Ontaria Wilson** in the first quarter, pushing him past 4,000 yards for his career. In FSU history, Travis now ranks tied for 16th in completions with 298; 17th with 4,081 passing yards; and 18th with 30 passing touchdowns. He leads all FSU quarterbacks in yards (1,475) and rushing touchdowns (18).

» Including his 40 rushing yards and 71 passing yards at Louisville in 2018, Travis is one of 10 active players with 4,000 passing yards and 1,500 rushing yards (4,152 and 1,515).

» Pittman is tied for the team lead with three touchdown catches, all in the past two games. Before last week, Pittman had two TD catches in 25 career games.

» Running back **Lawrance Toafili** capped a 7-play, 72-yard drive in the second quarter with a 12-yard touchdown run. He leads FSU with four rushing touchdowns this season.

» Wilson added a 51-yard punt return late in the first half, the longest for a Seminole since a 74-yard return vs. Miami in 2018.

» Kicker **Ryan Fitzgerald** turned Wilson's punt return into a 47-yard field goal, his longest of the season. He was perfect on three kicks.

» Florida State entered Saturday leading the country with 38 plays of 20+ yards and added seven more against NC State - 22- and 71-yard runs from Travis; a 39-yard run from **Treshaun Ward** and a 26-yard run by **Trey Benson**; and Travis connected with **Ontaria Wilson** for 37 yards and **Johnny Wilson** for 29 and 31 yards.

» Linebacker **Tatum Bethune** recorded 14 tackles, the most for a Seminole this season. It was his ninth career double-digit tackle game and second at Florida State (10 at Louisville). He had 2.5 tackles for loss.

» **Miscellaneous:** Defensive tackle **Malcolm Ray** made his third start of the season and tallied his second career solo sack on NC State's second offensive play...defensive end **Patrick Payton** set a career high with six tackles, including three tackles and a pass breakup on one drive in the second quarter...safety **Jammie Robinson** nabbed his first interception of the season and team-high fifth in his Seminole career (seventh overall)... FSU's two-play, 85-yard drive was its shortest touchdown drive (by plays) of the season... **DJ Lundy** now has 103 career tackles after recording a season-high five Saturday night.

» FSU outscored NC State 17-0 in the second quarter, outgaining the Wolfpack 216-97 in the quarter. NC State was 0-for-4 on third down and 0-for-1 on fourth down in the period. For the season, FSU is now outscoring opponents 102-48 in the first half.

» FSU's defense is holding opponents to an average of 148.0 yards of total offense in the first half, with an average of 65.2 rushing yards and 82.8 passing yards in the first half of games this season. NC State had 133 total yards in the first 30 minutes (58 rushing, 75 passing).
